NARRATIVE:

On Saturday, September 04, 2021, at approximately 22:40 hours, Rachel Raynor (W/F, 05/26/1998) contacted the Martin County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) to report her friend Perrin Damron (W/F, 01/27/1998) missing.

Raynor stated the following: Damron has been out of touch with her family and friends for over a day which is uncharacteristic of her. Damron's last known contact was with Eric Westergard (W/M, 04/04/1976) who supposedly dropped Damron off at her house (5854 SE Mitzi Lane, Stuart) at approximately 2330 hours on September 03, 20221. Westergard is the boyfriend of Damron's mother, Tammie Damron (W/F, 05/12/1971.) Attempts to call Damron's phone have been unsuccessful. Upon going to Damron's residence she found the back sliding glass door to be unsecured. Damron was not at the residence. Damron's vehicle was parked in the driveway of the residence, unsecured.

Contact was made with the father of Damron's child, Steven Martin (W/M, 06/13/1989,) who advised the following: he last saw Damron on September 03, at approximately 1800 hours, when he drove to her residence to retrieve their son, Maverick. He has not seen her since. He and Damron had plans later that evening to meet, however, he was unable to get into contact with her.

A RING camera, at a neighbor's residence across the street from Damron's residence captured the following (note: the camera is motion triggered, not continuously recorded) on September 03: at approximately 1635 hours Damron's vehicle pulled into

the driveway of her residence. At that time, Westergard's vehicle was already parked in Damron's driveway. Westergard and Damron exited the vehicle. At 1716 hours Westergard's vehicle was no longer in the driveway. At 1800 hours, Westergard's vehicle was back parked in the driveway of Damron's residence. At approximately 1840 hours, Martin's vehicle parked in the driveway of Damron's residence. Martin is seen standing outside his vehicle. At approximately 1853 hours Martin's vehicle was no longer in the driveway. Westergard and Damron entered Westergard's vehicle. The same RING camera, at a neighbor's residence across the street from Damron's residence captured the following (note: the camera is motion triggered, not continuously recorded) on September 04: at approximately 1204 hours an unknown vehicle (unidentifiable) was parked in the driveway of Damron's residence. An unknown subject, large in stature consistent with a male, was standing in the front doorway of Damron's residence. At approximately 0114 hours the same vehicle exited the driveway of Damron's residence.

Damron's mother, Tammie, was on scene at Damron's residence with Deputies. At which time, Westergard made contact her via phone. Westergard advised her the following: he and Damron were together the night of Friday, September 03. Damron was at his house (15273 101st Trail N, Jupiter) in the late night hours "smoking two dabs." After smoking they travelled to iHop to eat. He then drove Damron back to her residence, in Stuart, around approximately 2230 hours. Upon arriving at Damron's residence, she exited his vehicle and walked inside the residence.

Later, Westergard contacted Damron's mother again. Westergard advised the following: he was "high" at the time he dropped Damron off at her residence. He was not sure of an exact timeline of when he dropped her off. He was not at Damron's residence for a long period and did not go inside. He was currently not feeling well and was extremely nauseous.

Fixed surveillance assets in the area of Interstate 95/ Indiantown Road (Jupiter) observed Westergard's silver in color Chevrolet SUV at approximately 2220 hours. Additional assets, in the area of Interstate 95/ SW Kanner Highway (Stuart,) observed the same vehicle at approximately 2353 hours.

A search of Damron's historical phone records revealed the following cell tower timeline: from approximately 1930 hours until 2218 hours, her phone was located at Westergard's residence. At approximately 2244 hours, it travelled a short distance away and immediately travelled back at Westergard's residence. At approximately 2340 hours, her phone travelled away from Westergard's residence towards Interstate 95. Her phone travelled northbound, along Interstate 95, towards Stuart. At approximately 0004 hours, her phone's location was at her residence in Stuart. The phone continued to remain at her residence until approximately 0115 hours. At approximately 0130 hours, the phone's location began travelling away from her

residence, towards Interstate 95 southbound. The phone's location travelled south bound, along Interstate 95, until it arrived back at Westergard's residence at approximately 0150 hours. The phone's location continued showing at Westergard's residence until approximately 0353 hours, until it ceased communicating with surrounding cell towers.

At the time of the initial report, all attempts to make contact with Damron's phone yielded negative results. All voice calls went straight to voicemail. Attempts to locate Damron's phone, via cell towers, yielded negative results indicating the phone was shut off.

On September 05, 2021 at approximately 1019 hours Verizon Wireless conducted a "ping" on Damron's phone to gather location information. Damron's phone location showed on the property of Westergard's residence at 15273 101st Trail N, Jupiter. Damron's phone continued to show in the same location, at Westergard's residence, until approximately 1321 hours. At that time, Damron's phone ceased communication with surrounding cell towers. The last recorded location was at approximately 1315 hours, at Westergard's residence.

Additionally, Damron's mother attempted to locate Damron's phone via the 'Find My iPhone' application. At approximately 1045 AM, on September 05, Damron's phone location showed at Westergard's residence. The location shows in the area of Westergard's driveway in the front of the property. Damron's phone continued showing the same location until approximately 1236 hours, at which time, it displayed a location inside Westergard's residence. At that time, Damron's phone stopped communicating with the 'Find My iPhone' application.

Contact was made with Martin's parents, Michael and Suzzane Taylor. Both subjects advised it is very uncharacteristic for Damron to be without her phone. When the Taylor's have custody of Damron's son, Maverick, she constantly communicates with them for updates on Maverick. They as well have not had any communication with Damron since Friday, September 03., 2021

At approximately 1040 hours Martin County Sheriff's Office Detective McCarthy and Detective Sgt. Maltese attempted to make contact with Westergard for a consensual interview. Before contact was made Westergard backed out of his driveway in his silver in color Chevrolet SUV (FL tag: Y32VXQ). Mobile surveillance was conducted on Westergard's vehicle. Westergard was the sole occupant of the vehicle. Westergard travelled to a gas station located at 10050 W Indiantown Road, Jupiter. Westergard exited the vehicle and entered the business. A short time later Westergard exited the business and returned to his vehicle carrying a clear gallon of water. Westergard then travelled to the area behind the business of Duffys Bar & Grille, located at 6791 W

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Indiantown Road, Jupiter. Westergard parked his vehicle along a waterway and heavily wooded area. Westergard exited the driver seat of the vehicle and walked back to the trunk cargo area. Westergard opened the rear lift gate to obtain access to the trunk/cargo area. Westergard leaned into the cargo area. A short time later Westergard exited the cargo area and closed the lift gate. Westergard returned to the driver seat. A short time later, Westergard again exited the driver seat and returned to the rear trunk/cargo area of the vehicle. Westergard opened the rear lift gate and leaned back into the cargo area. Westergard then appeared to be cleaning the cargo area, wiping down the interior of the cargo area with white in color paper towels. Westergard then exited the cargo area and closed the lift gate. Westergard returned to the driver seat, at which point, Detective McCarthy and Detective Sgt. Maltese made contact with him. Note that at the time Westergard's vehicle initially went mobile, leaving his residence, Damron's phone appeared to have turned back on and began communicating with surrounding cell towers, as well as, the 'Find My iPhone' application. Damron's phone location, as referenced above, showed in the area of Westergard's residence and never left.

Westergard exited the vehicle and stood with detectives. Westergard was not placed in restraints and stood free in close proximity to his vehicle in a shaded area.

During a cursory walk around Westergard's vehicle the following was observed, in plain view, in the trunk/cargo area: a plastic 'Publix' style bag containing numerous white in color paper towels and baby wipes. All the wipes were covered in a dark red substance, consistent with the color of blood. A large roll of paper towels and an open package of baby wipes were located in the immediate vicinity of the plastic 'Publix' style bag. The cargo area floor mat was disturbed, partially pulled up, out of place, in the far front right corner. There were numerous dark red stains on the floor mat, consistent with the color of blood. In the front passenger seat, in plain view, was a non-descript unlabeled spray bottle containing a yellow in color liquid substance. At this time the Martin County Sheriff's Office made contact with the Palm Beach County Sheriff's Office to request assistance from the Homicide Unit. Detective Chiquito-Rodriguez (ID 18334) responded to the area behind the Duffys Bar & Grille where Westergard was located.

While standing by, Westergard's demeanor was calm and cooperative. Westergard appeared ill, fidgeting his body and repeatedly dropping to his knees and bending over, as if he was going to throw up. Westergard advised he was not feeling well and asked if he could have a drink of water. Detectives on scene provided Westergard with a cold bottle of unopened water, which he drank from.

Detective Chiquito-Rodriguez and Detective McCarthy made contact with Westergard for a consensual interview. Detective McCarthy read Westergard his Miranda Rights, from his agency issued Miranda card, at which time Westergard stated he understood.

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Detective McCarthy explained to Westergard he was free to leave and was not detained. Westergard advised he was willing to cooperate and provide a statement regarding the incident surrounding Damron's disappearance.

Damron advised the following: on Friday, September 03, 2021 in the afternoon we, Damron, and her son Maverick, attended a doctors appointment for an injury Damron sustained to her eye from an accident with Maverick. The doctors office was located in Port St Lucie, FL. They travelled in Damron's vehicle, because of Maverick's child restraint system. Upon their return to the residence Damron bathed Maverick and got him ready to be picked up by his father, Martin. At that time, Westergard travelled to a nearby Walgreens Pharmacy to pick up Damron's eye drop prescription. Westergard returned to Damron's residence. Between the hours of 1830 and 1900 Martin arrived at Damron's residence to pick up Maverick. Martin was at the residence for a short period of time, until he left with Maverick. Damron and Westergard then left Damron's residence, in Westergard's vehicle, and travelled to Westergard's residence in Jupiter, FL. They remained at Westergard's residence, accompanied by Westergard's cousin, Scott Giffith. The three subjects stayed at Westergard's residence, smoking marijuana, until approximately 2330 hours. Westergard then drove Damron back to her residence, in Stuart, in his vehicle. At approximately 0015 hours, they arrived at Damron's residence and both went inside to continue smoking marijuana. At approximately 0130 hours, he left Damron's residence and travelled back to his residence in Jupiter, FL. Westergard has not had any communication with Damron since.

Westergard advised he was unaware of Damron's supposed disappearance until contact by her mother, Tammie the night of Saturday, September 04.

When asked about the blood like stains in his vehicle Westergard advised he "had an incident." Westergard would not elaborate any further, and ceased answering further questions.

Detective McCarthy and Detective Chiquito-Rodriguez relocated to Westergard's residence and made contact with Scott Griffith. Detective McCarthy read Griffith his Miranda Rights, from his agency issued Miranda card, at which time he stated he understood. Griffith advised he wished to cooperate and provide a statement. Griffith provided a statement similar to Westergard's confirming his stated timeline. He remembered Westergard and Damron leaving Westergard's residence at approximately 2330 hours, in Westergard's vehicle to take Damron back home. At approximately 0030 hours he heard what he believed to be Westergard returning to the residence and coming inside.

In summary, Westergard admitted to being with Damron the night she was last seen. However, Damron's phone location contradicts Westergard's exact account the night as it relates to Damron staying the night at her own residence. Furthermore, all of Damron's friends and family advise it is not usual for her to go with Scott or

without communication or contact with her son, Maverick, for extended periods of time. Westergard refused to elaborate or explain the potential blood evidence visually observed in his vehicle.

The last known location of Damron was at Westergard's residence. Damron's phone last location was Westergard's residence on September 05, 2021 at 1319 hours.

During the lawful execution of a search warrant on Westergard's residence blood like substance was located on his property in a dump trailer. The missing hatchback items from Westergard's vehicle were also discovered next to the trailer. Westergard broke down while seated at the home and became emotional with heavy breathing. Westergard re-initiated conversation about the investigation after LT. Romero (MCSO) told Westergard that he needed to want to talk to us. Westergard wanted to speak to his cousin, Scott William Griffith, WM, 05/20/1970. After speaking to Griffith, Westergard said that he waived his right to an attorney and described the events that took place earlier in the day to Detectives.



Westergard stated that he and Damron have been in an intimate relationship for several weeks. On Saturday morning, September 4 just past midnight he and Damron had sex at her apartment. They returned to his home and were in his room the whole day. After Griffith went to bed, Westergard and Damron went skinny dipping in the pool. Damron fell while on the property and cut her head on a hand truck. Westergard said he went to get paper towels and a blanket. Returning to Damron she was unconscious and gurgling. Damron stopped gurgling and Westergard stayed there for 10 minutes or so. Then he grabbed two, 65 gallon bags, tape, and rope, and a cinderblock. Damron was transported in the rear compartment of his Equinox to the Beeline and Kanner Highway. Westergard then tossed Damron over the bridge into the water. He returned home and attempted to clean the scene.

Westergard took Detectives to the area where he threw Damron off the bridge. Martin County Marine Unit was able to pull Damron from the water on September 5, 2021 at about 1124PM. The body was wrapped in trashbags, taped, and with the rope and cinderblock like Westergard said he prepared Damron's body to dispose of it.

The area where Westergard stated the incident took place was processed by Palm Beach County Crime Scene Investigators. The area showed that the injury did not appear to be consistent with the mechanism of injury as described in his statement. At no time did Westergard attempt to get Damron any medical attention even though he was in possession of his cell phone. The only effort that Westergard performed was to attempt to conceal the discovery of Damron and hide the evidence of the crime from authorities.

Based on the investigation I find probable cause to charge Westergard with violation of Florida Statute, 782.04.
