Dear Attorney Fernandez:

On or about August 5, 2019, the Riviera Beach Police Department contacted your office requesting review of an arrest. Your office was provided copies of the reports, memos and a thumb drive with copies of Dash Cam Videos and Body Worn Camera Videos in reference to case number 19-50518. Specifically, at issue was whether an officer struck the arrestee unnecessarily and excessively. Your office reviewed the video and could not determine if anyone struck the arrestee, also stating no criminality could be seen.

On Monday, March 23, 2020, during our telephone conference, I shared with you some of my concerns as noted:

- 1. From the beginning of contact in the back yard to when the BWC's were turned off, the suspect was compliant.
- 2. Captain Foster's illegal command to turn off the Body Worn Cameras:
 - a. The command to "Go dead" can be heard on the BWC belonging to Officer B. Smith, Officer Louden, Captain Foster and Officer Javares Harvey. This command was given at least seven (7) times.
- 3. Captain Foster's BWC:
 - a. At 4:49, Sergeant Jackson can be heard describing the suspect as, "Alternative lifestyle type dude." This was repeated on more than one occasion.
 - b. At 7:57, Captain Foster can be heard saying, "We want teeth on him dawg, we want teeth, fuck."
 - c. At 9:25, Captain Foster can be heard saying, "I need teeth."
 - d. At 10:09, Captain Foster can be heard saying, "Go dead, go dead, take away, we got (unintelligible), go dead."
- 4. Officer Orlanzo Douglas' BWC:

- a. At 18:26, Officer Douglas' comment to the Sheriff Deputy, "Skinny black dude, he a little punk. Gay looking dude."
- b. At 22:50, Officer Orlanzo Douglas' in car comment, "I wanna get this motherfucker."
- 5. Images captured on the BWC's of the victim's face prior to, and after the arrest.

Considering all these factors, I am respectfully requesting your office conduct another internal review of this matter. As such, enclosed please find the Internal Affairs file, along with all relevant body worn camera videos, and in car videos.

Per our discussion today, this email will serve as an update regarding the referenced incident occurring on June 21, 2019.

You originally brought this incident to my attention when I was the interim chief. I believe our discussion was approximately 2 weeks ago. Based on that discussion you were going to have the preliminary information gathered and that you would make a recommendation.

Today, I received three use of force forms in my mailbox that were connected to the Incident. Upon watching the video footage from several body cameras, I had some concerns with the handling of the Incident. I confirmed with Walker and Lewis that no preliminary investigation had started.

As of today, Lewis has been asked to look into the matter (by gathering all reports/documents and looking at all body camera footage). He will provide a recommendation upon the conclusion of his review

On July 17th, 2019, I was contacted by Assistant Chief Michael Madden to conduct a preliminary investigation in reference to the circumstances surrounding the arrest of Anthony Goldwire for Aggravated Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer, Riviera Beach Police Department (RBPD) Case #19-50518.

Synopsis

- A traffic stop was conducted by Sergeant Brian Jackson, who was in a marked police vehicle, for an alleged traffic offense. The vehicle being stopped was a black in color Lincoln.
- During the traffic stop, the driver, without being prompted, exited his vehicle and began walking towards Sergeant Jackson. Sergeant Jackson lawfully ordered the suspect to return to his vehicle; the driver complied and re-entered his vehicle.
- The vehicle was then observed driving forward and turned his vehicle around, driving in the direction of Sergeant Jackson, who was outside his marked patrol vehicle. Body worn camera, which was utilized during this traffic stop, captured the vehicle's path of travel but did not capture the vehicle striking Sergeant Jackson.
- Sergeant Jackson immediately broadcasted over the police radio the chain of events which took place and that the vehicle had struck him. Immediately, Captain Foster, the on duty shift commander, instructed all Officers to respond to specific areas, in an effort to locate the vehicle.
- A short while later, Officers located the vehicle, and an extensive search of the area was conducted in an effort to locate the suspect. K9 officers also responded to the area to assist in the search.
- Officers were able to locate the suspect during the search. The suspect took flight, and was eventually apprehended.
- The suspect, who sustained injuries at some time during this incident, was transported to St. Mary's Hospital to be medically cleared for transport to the Palm Beach County Jail.

• The suspect, who was later identified as Anthony Goldwire, was charged with Aggravated Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer, Fleeing to Elude, Criminal Mischief, and Resisting an Officer in Riviera Beach Police Department case #19-50518.

Conclusions

- Various body worn camera (BWC) footage from multiple Officers of this incident was reviewed.
- Several Officers on scene were found to not have activated their BWC, a violation of Riviera Beach Police Department's General Order 2018-3. The General Order states in Section "B" that Operation and Use of the BWC is mandatory while working any uniformed assignments, and in Section 1.8, states that the BWC will be activated by all officers involved in various incidents, to include during physical arrests. Some of these Officers include, but are not limited to, are:
 - > Sergeant Brian Jackson (during physical arrest)
 - > Officer Hayles (during physical arrest)
 - > Officer Westcarth (during physical arrest)
 - > Detective Morgan (during physical arrest)
- As Officers were moving in to physically place the suspect under arrest, Captain Foster was heard stating, "Go Dead", several times. This was captured on his BWC at 10:10 of the camera footage. This was also captured on Officer B. Smith's BWC at 5:43 of the camera footage and on Officer Harvey's BWC at 19:41.
- After Captain Foster's directive, it appears two Officers reached to their BWC's located on their vest/uniform; it is unknown what actions were being taken. The BWC footage for all of the above three Officers terminated after this directive.
- BWC footage from Officer Nance captured the suspect being placed under arrest. While
 placing the suspect under arrest, several Officers were heard ordering the suspect to stop
 resisting and to stop fighting.
- BWC footage from Officer Rodriguez captured the suspect being lifted up off the ground. At 0.48 of the BWC footage, the suspect, while in handcuffs, is lifted off the ground and begins to walk with Officers. At this time, it appears the arrestee may have been struck by what appeared to be a hand, which caused Officers and the arrestee to fall to the ground. The BWC footage ended at that time.
- Hospital pictures were obtained from the suspect. The suspect sustained numerous facial
 injuries, to include at least one laceration and had swelling throughout his face. There
 was no BWC footage seen which would have provided an explanation as to how the
 suspect sustained these injuries.

• Sergeant Jackson and Officer Louden each completed a Use of Countermeasures form which indicated they used a fist or hands during this incident.

Recommendation

There were several Officers who committed policy violations, namely, the BWC General Order. However, the suspect sustained various injuries in this incident which were not captured on any Officer's BWC. It is also possible that an unknown Officer struck the suspect while handcuffed. There may be viable and lawful reasons for this, but due to the lack of video footage available, I am unable to determine the critical facts which would be necessary to determine if any Officer actions were justified or in violation of department policies/laws. To determine this, a more indepth investigation should take place which would allow for the discovery of critical information which is relevant to properly complete this investigation. As such, I am recommending this case be assigned to the Internal Affairs Division for further investigation.

On 06-21-2019 at approximately 2322 hours, I left my off duty detail and responded to the PSA 21 area, in regards to a Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer (Sgt. Jackson).

Upon arrival, I responded to the 1500 Block of West 36th Street along the K-9 Unit.

K-9 Officer B. Smith and canine Vox tracked the suspect south towards 35th Street behind a wooden fence.

I observed the suspect who was later identified as, Anthony L. Goldwire (B/M 02-26-97), run northbound back onto the 1500 block of West 36th Street.

I observed Mr. Goldwire in the front yard of 1540 West and I immediately deployed my Taser (No contact).

Mr. Goldwire continued to run eastbound from officers behind the residence of 1540 and then to the next house east of 1540. I saw Mr. Goldwire behind 1516 West 36th Street on the west side of the residence.

I then saw a medium brown dog going towards canine Vox. In fear that Vox going was going to be attacked and hurt, I immediately deployed my Taser on the dog.

I jumped the fence and detained Mr. Goldwire. Mr. Goldwire resisted me by pulling his hands away from me, refusing to put his hands behind his back. I repeatedly yelled for Mr. Goldwire to "Stop resisting". Mr. Goldwire continued pull his hands away from officers. Mr. Goldwire eventually was placed in handcuffs.

Officer Spearow transported Mr. Goldwire to St. Mary's Medical Center for a medical clearance (I followed).

While at St. Mary's Medical Center I did the following:

Medical staff inspected Mr. Goldwire for any Taser prongs. The nurse told me that no prongs made contact with him.

I went back to 1516 to recover any prongs. I made contact with the owner of the dog (Dingo). One prong was removed from the dog. I canvassed the backyard and was unsuccessful locating the second prong. Information was given to the owner of the dog including a case number.

I then canvassed 1540 West 36th Street for any prongs. I observed two prongs (wires connected) in contact with a green Waste Management trash can. Photographs was taken and uploaded to Evidence.com

While at the station:

I placed the three (3) prongs including wires and the two (2) Taser cartridges into evidence. This concludes my involvement.

The following occurred in the City of Riviera Beach, Palm Beach County, Florida.

Aggravated Assault W/Vehicle on LEO

I responded to the area of West 32nd Street and Avenue O, Riviera Beach, Fl. in regards to an Aggravated Battery with a motor vehicle against Sergeant B. Jackson #5430. Upon my arrival, a perimeter was set up and the suspect was eventually apprehended a short time later. Upon being assigned as the lead investigator of this incident, I discovered that the following occurred: Sergeant Jackson noticed a black 2006 Lincoln Zephr, Florida tag #JPRT71 traveling Southbound in the 3700 block of Avenue O. Sergeant Jackson estimated the vehicle's speed to be approximately 40 M.P.H. in the 25 M.P.H residential zone. As Sergeant Jackson positioned himself behind the vehicle in his fully marked police vehicle, he observed the target vehicle run a stop sign at the intersection of Avenue O and West 32nd Street. As the vehicle made a left turn onto West 32nd Street, Sergeant Jackson activated his blue lights and sirens in order to conduct a traffic stop. The vehicle then stopped in front of the residence of 1224 West 32nd Street. The vehicle was facing Eastbound along the roadway. Immediately after, a black male, who was later identified as Anthony Goldwire, exited the driver seat of the vehicle and began to question Sergeant Jackson about the reason for the traffic stop.

Upon receiving multiple verbal commands from Sergeant Jackson for Goldwire to get back inside of his vehicle, Goldwire reluctantly complied. It was at that time, that Goldwire suddenly and without warning, placed his vehicle in drive and proceeded to maneuver a 3-point turn in the middle of the roadway. It was at that point Goldwire had positioned his vehicles front bumper to front bumper with Sergeant Jackson's police vehicle. Goldwire then accelerated towards Sergeant Jackson's police vehicle. In fear of being struck, Sergeant Jackson braced himself with his back up against the exterior of his police vehicle. Goldwire drove his vehicle into Sergeant Jackson's driver's side door, causing the door to slam on Sergeant Jackson's right hand.

Without hesitation, Goldwire fled the area in his vehicle. As a result of the incident, multiple officers including myself, responded and saturated the area. Officer K. Jones #5888 located Goldwire's vehicle parked in front of 1473 West 37th Street. (Sergeant Jackson responded to the vehicle and confirmed that it was Goldwire's vehicle). K-9 Officer Ben Smith and other Officers located Goldwire hiding in the alleyway directly in front of where he had parked his vehicle. When Goldwire observed the Officers, he began to flee on foot and refused their lawful commands for him to stop running. Goldwire was subsequently cornered and apprehended in the rear of 1516 West 36th Street.

During this incident, Goldwire caused approximately \$500.00 worth of damage to Sergeant Jackson's police vehicle. Sergeant Jackson received lacerations to his right hand and was treated at Saint Mary's Medical center. photos were later placed into

After Goldwire was transported to St. Mary's Medical Center for medical clearance, he was captured on my body camera admitting to his actions listed in the report.

Upon the conclusion of this investigation, it was determined that Goldwire in fact intentionally struck Sergeant Jackson with his vehicle, intentionally caused criminal mischief to a police vehicle, used his vehicle to flee from law enforcement, and obstructed Officers in their lawful duty by fleeing from them on foot.

Upon Goldwire's release from the hospital, he was turned over to the Palm Beach County Jail for the above listed charges along with multiple corresponding Uniform Traffic Citations.

Goldwire's vehicle was towed by Garden's Towing and transported to Riviera Beach evidence warehouse as evidence.

Sergeant Jackson noticed a black 2006 Lincoln Zephr, Florida tag #JPRT71 traveling Southbound in the 3700 block of Avenue O. Sergeant Jackson estimated the vehicle's speed to be approximately 40 M.P.H. in the 25 M.P.H residential zone. As Sergeant Jackson positioned himself behind the vehicle in his fully marked police vehicle, he observed the target vehicle run a stop sign at the intersection of Avenue O and West 32nd Street. As the vehicle made a left turn onto West 32nd Street, Sergeant Jackson activated his blue lights and sirens in order to conduct a traffic stop. The vehicle then stopped in front of the residence of 1224 West 32nd Street. The vehicle was facing Eastbound along the roadway. Immediately after, a black male, who was later identified as Anthony Goldwire, exited the driver seat of the vehicle and began to question Sergeant Jackson about the reason for the traffic

Upon receiving multiple verbal commands from Sergeant Jackson for Goldwire to get back inside of his vehicle, Goldwire reluctantly complied. It was at that time, that Goldwire suddenly and without warning, placed his vehicle in drive and proceeded to maneuver a 3-point turn in the middle of the roadway. It was at that point Goldwire had positioned his vehicles front bumper to front bumper with Sergeant Jackson's police vehicle. Goldwire then accelerated towards Sergeant Jackson's police vehicle. In fear of being struck, Sergeant Jackson braced himself with his back up against the exterior of his police vehicle. Goldwire drove his vehicle into Sergeant Jackson's driver's side door, causing the door to slam on Sergeant Jackson's right hand.

Without hesitation, Goldwire fled the area in his vehicle. As a result of the incident, multiple officers including myself, responded and saturated the area. Officer K. Jones #5888 located Goldwire's vehicle parked in front of 1473 West 37th Street. (Sergeant Jackson responded to the vehicle and confirmed that it was Goldwire's vehicle). K-9 Officer Ben Smith and other Officers located Goldwire hiding in the alleyway directly in front of where he had parked his vehicle. When Goldwire observed the Officers, he began to flee on foot and refused their lawful commands for him to stop running.

Goldwire was subsequently cornered in the rear of 1516 West 36th Street inside the fence of the residence. Sergeant Jackson was one of the first officers in contact with Goldwire. While attempting to restrain Goldwire in handcuffs, he was attempting to remove an unknown object from his pants pocket. Fearing that Goldwire was retrieving a weapon, Sergeant Jackson ordered him to stop. Sergeant Jackson's orders were followed by several distractionary closed hand strikes to Goldwire's head. After additional officers arrived, Goldwire was able to be restrained. The object was later discovered to be his cell phone.

During this incident, Goldwire caused approximately \$500.00 worth of damage to Sergeant Jackson's police vehicle. Sergeant Jackson received lacerations to his right hand and was treated at Saint Mary's Medical center. photos were later placed into evidence.

After Goldwire was transported to St. Mary's Medical Center for medical clearance, he was captured on my body camera admitting to his actions listed in the report.

Upon the conclusion of this investigation, it was determined that Goldwire in fact intentionally struck Sergeant Jackson with his vehicle, intentionally caused criminal mischief to a police vehicle, used his vehicle to flee from law enforcement, and obstructed Officers in their lawful duty by fleeing from them on foot.

Upon Goldwire's release from the hospital, he was turned over to the Palm Beach County Jail for the above listed charges along with multiple corresponding Uniform Traffic Citations. Goldwire's vehicle was towed by Garden's Towing and transported to Riviera Beach evidence warehouse as evidence.

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On 6/21/19 at approximately 2323 hours Sgt. B. Jackson advised he conducted a traffic stop on a black Lincoln sedan. Sgt. B. Jackson then advised the vehicle struck him while he was outside of his marked Police vehicle and fled the scene. I then responded to the 1500 block of West 36th Street where a witness advised they observed a black male matching the description of the driver running southbound while removing clothing from his persons.

Jackson). Upon arrival, I responded to the 1500 Block of West 36th Street along the K-9 Unit. K-9 Officer B. Smith and canine Vox tracked the suspect south towards 35th Street behind a wooden fence. I observed the suspect who was later identified as, Anthony L. Goldwire (B/M 02-26-97), run northbound back onto the 1500 block

of West 36th Street.

I observed Mr. Goldwire in the front yard of 1540 West and I immediately deployed my Taser (No contact).

Mr. Goldwire continued to run eastbound from officers behind the residence of 1540 and then to the next house east of 1540. I saw Mr. Goldwire behind 1516 West 36th Street on the west side of the residence.

I then saw a medium brown dog going towards canine Vox. In fear that Vox going was going to be attacked and hurt, I immediately deployed my Taser on the dog.

I jumped the fence and detained Mr. Goldwire. Mr. Goldwire resisted me by pulling his hands away from me, refusing to put his hands behind his back. I repeatedly yelled for Mr. Goldwire to "Stop resisting". Mr. Goldwire continued pull his hands away from officers. Mr. Goldwire eventually was placed in handcuffs.

Officer Spearow transported Mr. Goldwire to St. Mary's Medical Center for a medical clearance (I followed).

While at St. Mary's Medical Center I did the following:

Medical staff inspected Mr. Goldwire for any Taser prongs. The nurse told me that no prongs made contact with him.

I went back to 1516 to recover any prongs. I made contact with the owner of the dog (Dingo). One prong was removed from the dog. I canvassed the backyard and was unsuccessful locating the second prong. Information was given to the owner of the dog including a case number.

I then canvassed 1540 West 36th Street for any prongs. I observed two prongs (wires connected) in contact with a green Waste Management trash can. Photographs was taken and uploaded to Evidence.com

While at the station:

I placed the three (3) prongs including wires and the two (2) Taser cartridges into evidence. This concludes my involvement.

Jackson advised via police radio that a vehicle that he had conducted a traffic stop on, struck him while he was outside of his patrol vehicle. The vehicle then fled the scene immediately there after. I responded to the area and started to canvass for the suspect vehicle, which was described as a black older model Lincoln style sedan. At some point, Captain Foster advised that a witness observed a black male, matching the description of the suspect, running southbound from West 36th Street. At this time, I went to the area and located the suspect vehicle in the 1500 block of West 37th Street, which was unoccupied. Captain Foster requested that I along with the other K-9 unit respond to the 1500 block of 36th Street to conduct an area search with one of our K-9's. Once there, I assisted K-9 Officer B. Smith, who deployed his K-9 partner Vox. K-9 Vox brought us to an empty lot located in the 1500 block of West 35th Street, where he pulled into a row of bushes that ran parallel along a 6' wooden fence. Aggravated. Battery with a Motor Vehicle

Sergeant Jackson noticed a black 2006 Lincoln Zephr, Florida tag #JPRT71 traveling Southbound in the 3700 block of Avenue O. Sergeant Jackson estimated the vehicle's speed to be approximately 40 M.P.H. in the 25 M.P.H residential zone. As Sergeant Jackson positioned himself behind the vehicle in his fully marked police vehicle, he observed the target vehicle run a stop sign at the intersection of Avenue O and West 32nd Street. As the vehicle made a left turn onto West 32nd Street, Sergeant Jackson activated his blue lights and sirens in order to conduct a traffic stop. The vehicle then stopped in front of the residence of 1224 West 32nd Street. The vehicle was facing Eastbound along the roadway. Immediately after, a black male, who was later identified as Anthony Goldwire, exited the driver seat of the vehicle and began to question Sergeant Jackson about the reason for the traffic

Upon receiving multiple verbal commands from Sergeant Jackson for Goldwire to get back inside of his vehicle, Goldwire reluctantly complied. It was at that time, that Goldwire suddenly and without warning, placed his vehicle in drive and proceeded to maneuver a 3-point turn in the middle of the roadway. It was at that point Goldwire had positioned his vehicles front bumper to front bumper with Sergeant Jackson's police vehicle. Goldwire then accelerated towards Sergeant Jackson's police vehicle. In fear of being struck, Sergeant Jackson braced himself with his back up against the exterior of his police vehicle. Goldwire drove his vehicle into Sergeant Jackson's driver's side door, causing the door to slam on Sergeant Jackson's right hand.

Without hesitation, Goldwire fled the area in his vehicle. As a result of the incident, multiple officers including myself, responded and saturated the area. Officer K. Jones #5888 located Goldwire's vehicle parked in front of 1473 West 37th Street. (Sergeant Jackson responded to the vehicle and confirmed that it was Goldwire's vehicle). K-9 Officer Ben Smith and other Officers located Goldwire hiding in the alleyway directly in front of where he had parked his vehicle. When Goldwire observed the Officers, he began to flee on foot and refused their lawful commands for him to stop running.

Goldwire was subsequently cornered in the rear of 1516 West 36th Street inside the fence of the residence. Sergeant Jackson was one of the first officers in contact with Goldwire. While attempting to restrain Goldwire in handcuffs, he was attempting to remove an unknown object from his pants pocket. Fearing that Goldwire was retrieving a weapon, Sergeant Jackson ordered him to stop. Sergeant Jackson's orders were followed by several distractionary closed hand strikes to Goldwire's head. After additional officers arrived, Goldwire was able to be restrained. The object was later discovered to be his cell phone.

During this incident, Goldwire caused approximately \$500.00 worth of damage to Sergeant Jackson's police vehicle. Sergeant Jackson received lacerations to his right hand and was treated at Saint Mary's Medical center. photos were later placed into evidence.

After Goldwire was transported to St. Mary's Medical Center for medical clearance, he was captured on my body camera admitting to his actions listed in the report.

Upon the conclusion of this investigation, it was determined that Goldwire in fact intentionally struck Sergeant Jackson with his vehicle, intentionally caused criminal mischief to a police vehicle, used his vehicle to flee from law enforcement, and obstructed Officers in their lawful duty by fleeing from them on foot.

Upon Goldwire's release from the hospital, he was turned over to the Palm Beach County Jail for the above listed charges along with multiple corresponding Uniform Traffic Citations. Goldwire's vehicle was towed by Garden's Towing and transported to Riviera Beach evidence warehouse as evidence.


