Good Morning,

I am writing to follow up with both DHS and ICE regarding the status of Earthjustice's FOIA request to DHS, number 2019-HQFO-01115, which was transferred to ICE and assigned case number 2020-ICFO-01444. We submitted the FOIA request to DHS on July 26, 2019, and on August 9, 2019, DHS transferred the request to ICE. To date, we have not received a determination in response to our FOIA request from either agency. We are requesting a final determination as soon as possible. Please accept this email as a good-faith attempt to resolve this matter without litigation.

Separately, please be advised that per the attached document, the rights to this FOIA request were transferred from the nonprofit organization **WeCount!** to the nonprofit organization **American Friends Service Committee** in October 2020. This took place after the employee for WeCount! pursuing this FOIA request with Earthjustice changed her employment and moved to American Friends Service Committee. **ASSIGNMENT OF FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT  
RIGHTS AND INTERESTS**

COMES NOW WeCount! and hereby assigns to American Friends Service Committee (AFSC) all of its rights, benefits, and interests in and derived from the following Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) requests, effective immediately:

- FOIA Request No. 2019-04651-F to the United States Department of Defense / Department of the Air Force, dated July 26, 2019;
- FOIA Request No. 2019-01126-FOIA-OS to the Department of Health and Human Services, dated July 26, 2019; transferred to the Administration for Children and Families on July 29, 2019 with the same request number, and on June 29, 2020, given the Request No. 20-F-0202;
- FOIA Request No. 2019-HQFO-01115 to the Department of Homeland Security, dated July 26, 2019; transferred to Immigration and Customs Enforcement on August 9, 2019 and given the Request No. 2020-ICFO-01444;
- FOIA Request No. 882562 to the Department of Labor, dated July 26, 2019.

WeCount! transfers to AFSC the ability and right to pursue any administrative or legal options and methods at its disposal under the law in relation to these FOIA requests, and WeCount! surrenders any claims it may have with regard to these FOIA requests.

In support thereof, WeCount! and AFSC state the following:

1. WeCount! is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization whose mission and focus is to defend immigrants' rights and advocate for the immigrant community.
2. AFSC is also a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, and one of its key programmatic goals is to also defend immigrants' rights and advocate for the immigrant community.
3. Guadalupe de la Cruz was an employee of WeCount! at the time these FOIA requests were filed and was integral to the filing of said requests regarding the Homestead Detention Center as part of her immigrants' rights advocacy work with WeCount!.
4. Ms. de la Cruz is now an employee of AFSC, where she is continuing her advocacy work surrounding the Homestead Detention Center site with AFSC's Florida Immigrant Rights Program.
