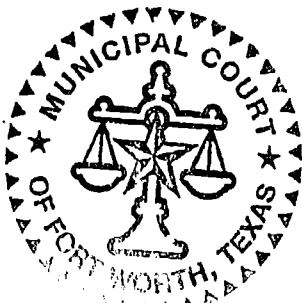

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared the undersigned affiant, who after being duly sworn on oath deposes and says; My name is **Detective L. Dickerson # 3772, FORT WORTH POLICE DEPARTMENT**, and I have good reason to believe and do believe that on or about the 26th day of October, 2021, in Tarrant County, Texas, **Stanley Frank Szeliga, a white male, date of birth 04/06/1967**, did commit the offense Murder §19.02 PC – F1 by then and there intentionally or knowingly causing the death of an individual, Abigail Saldana, by shooting her multiple times with a firearm.

My belief is based upon the following facts and information:

On Tuesday, October 26th, 2021, at approximately 2040 hours Fort Worth Police Officers were dispatched to the area of 131 HWY 183 EB International Parkway in regards to a silver sedan off the shoulder of the road in the grass. The 911 caller stated that she witnessed the vehicle speeding before driving off the exit ramp and into the grassy area, adjacent to the roadway. The 911 caller approached vehicle and stated that it appears to have bullet holes to the passenger side and the occupant is not moving and unresponsive. Officer R. Smith # 3801 made the scene where he observed a silver Hyundai sedan [REDACTED] with apparent bullet holes and a single female occupant that appeared to be deceased. The female was pronounced deceased at the scene due to apparent gunshot wounds by medical responders. The female was tentatively identified by a passport in the vehicle as, Saldana, Abigail 02/04/1999. I, Detective L. Dickerson # 3772 with the Homicide Unit, was notified of the offense and assumed control of the investigation. Upon arrival, I noted that the vehicle appeared to have three gunshots. Detective Galloway and I located three shell casing and broken glass at the intersection of Amon Carter Blvd and State HWY 183, which is believed to be where the victim was shot prior to entering the freeway as witnessed by the 911 caller.

I, along with additional homicide detectives, noted that the victim had clothing items in her vehicle consistent with those worn by exotic dancers. Within view of the victim's vehicle was a sexually oriented business named "Rick's". Detective Galloway and I went to "Ricks" see if the victim worked for them. The manager at Rick's did find record of an employee with the same name as that noted on the passport, Abigail Saldana, but said that she had not worked on this date. The manager went on to explain that the Abigail had recently been harassed by a customer of Rick's that the manager knew only as Stan. The manager knew Stan to be a veteran of the military, but could not provide much else about him. The manager showed me a post that Abigail had put on Instagram on October 14<sup>th</sup>, 2021, in which she had found a tracker that Stan had hidden on her car in an effort to follow her. The manager indicated that Abigail was frightened of Stan because he was stalking and harassing her. The manager showed me several Instagram posts indicating that Stan was recently irritated with Abigail and that he was going to report her for prostitution. At approximately 20:46 hours, as I looked on the manager's phone, I saw a post from Stan marked as being sent 3 hours prior. The post appeared to be a screen shot indicating that Stan had paid Abigail \$3000 at some point, and Stan was posting this as proof of his prostitution allegations. Contained within that snapshot post, Stan provided his address as [REDACTED]. The manager showed me a phone number for Stan as [REDACTED]. Further research verified that [REDACTED] does register to Stan Szeliga, through AT&T Mobility.

Research on Stanley Szeliga, now referred to as suspect, indicated that he owns a red 2015 Ford F150 registered under Texas license plate # [REDACTED]. Homicide Sgt. J. Loughman drove to [REDACTED] and saw the red 2015 F150 displaying Texas license plates [REDACTED] backed into a parking space inside the parking garage.

WARRANT NO: 2021 FW 003171

On October 27<sup>th</sup>, 2021 The Tarrant County Medical Examiner's Office officially identified the victim as being Abigail Saldana, a Hispanic female, dob: 02/04/1999. The victim's family contacted the Fort Worth Police Homicide Office after being notified of the victim's death. They also indicated that the victim had voiced fear of Stan because of his stalking and harassment.

A license plate reader database reported that the red Ford F150 with Texas license plate [REDACTED] was photographed at Midway Rd and McEwen Rd on 10/26/2021 at 20:22:40 hours.

The victim's residence was [REDACTED] which is nearby where the suspect's vehicle was spotted by the license plate reader. The victim's license plate Texas [REDACTED] is seen by the same license plate reader entering this intersection at 20:44:24, just seconds before the suspect's vehicle, indicating the suspect's vehicle was closely following the victim's vehicle. This is approximately 17 minutes before the 911 call was made to police reporting this incident. The intersection of McEwen Rd at Midway Rd is approximately 17 miles from the crime scene.

Along with the above-mentioned license plate reader record, the suspect's vehicle is noted as being in that same intersection on 10/13/2021 at 14:55:37 hours, 10/23/2021 at 20:09:46 hours, 10/24/2021 at 20:21:51 hours, 10/25/2021 at 13:26:36 hours and 15:01:59 hours, all of which indicate that he may have been stalking the victim as alleged.

I called and spoke with Stanley Szeliga asking to meet with him. He agreed to meet at my office on 10/27/2021 at 17:30. Stanley called me at approximately 17:15 hours and told me that he had been notified of a death in the family, but he agreed to keep our meeting. Stanley did not show up for our interview.

I obtained a search warrant signed by District Judge Westfall granting us permission to enter Stanley's residence located at [REDACTED] On 10/27/2021 at approximately 2337 hours, Fort Worth SWAT, executed the warrant. Upon execution Stanley refused to exit the residence and ultimately caused a self-inflicted wound to his neck that required medical attention.

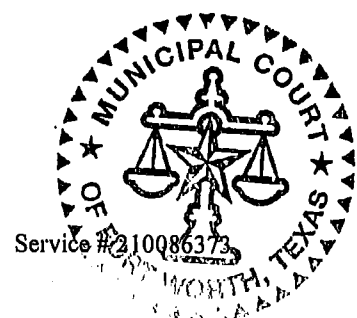
That based on the above facts and information being related to her, and as a result of this investigation, your affiant has reason to believe and does believe that probable cause does exist for the arrest of, **Stanley Frank Szeliga, white male, date of birth 04/06/1967**, for the offense of **Murder** against the State of Texas as set forth in the Penal Code.

WHEREFORE, I request that an arrest warrant issue for the suspect hereinbefore designated according to the laws of this State.
