COVID-19 AND FLU PRECAUTIONS REMINDER

Due to the recent spike in the spread of the coronavirus, employees are reminded that they are required to wear a mask in all city facilities (e.g., IMPD Roll Calls, City-County Building, Riverside Garage, etc.) unless alone in an enclosed office. Additionally, employees should wear a mask, when feasible, while interacting with the public and don advanced PPE gear when there is a known or suspected COVID-19-positive person. Even when able to effectively socially distance, employees should wear a mask when requested by a complainant or other member of the community, when possible.

All full-duty, sworn employees must keep a uniform ready to supplement Operations in case mandatory minimum patrol staffing cannot be maintained.

Employees come into daily contact with an at-risk population and are reminded to take the following additional preventative measures:

- Wash and/or disinfect hands frequently.
- Clean and disinfect commonly touched surfaces and equipment.
- Mark off and seek testing/medical care when experiencing Covid-19 or Flu symptoms.

Covid-19 and flu symptoms include:

- Fever or feeling feverish/chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Fatigue
- Sore throat
- Runny or stuffy nose
- Muscle pain or body aches
- Headache
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Loss of taste or smell

Suspected COVID-19 exposures should be documented on the IMPD Admin App.
