(2) A violation of subsection (1) of this section shall result in the termination of any disaster emergency or public health order, or both, in place when the state or a political subdivision engages in a prohibited action. This subsection shall not apply with respect to a violation by a private employer. (3) For purposes of this section: (a) "Official" means an officer or an employee of the state or a political subdivision. (b) "Political subdivision" means a county, city, public health district, school district, special purpose district, or other district or municipality organized under any general or special law of this state, except the term "political subdivision" does not include any hospital or health care facility.

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(c) "Private employer" means any person, partnership, limited liabil ity company, association, corporation, nonprofit entity, labor organi zation, or other private, nonpublic entity employing one (1) or more em ployees within Idaho. "Private employer" does not include any hospital
 or health care facility.

6 (d) "State" means the state of Idaho or any of its agencies, boards,

(4) The provisions of this section shall apply to any contractor oragent of the state, a political subdivision, or a private employer.

 passage and approval.
