Good Afternoon,

On May 1, 2021, Virginia's new Collective Bargaining Law (HB 582/SB 939) takes effect and will permit local school boards to decide whether to engage in collective bargaining with its employees. Under provisions in the law, local school boards can:

- 1. Pass a resolution authorizing collective bargaining with its employees.
- 2. If a local school board does not adopt such a resolution, employees may initiate this process by forming a unit and request the local school board vote on a resolution to allow collective bargaining. The local school board then has 120 days to vote on whether to adopt a resolution authorizing collective bargaining.
- Local school boards also have the option of not adopting a resolution to allow collective bargaining as the new law leaves the decision of whether to engage in collective bargaining entirely up to local school boards.
