The 16 cases reported today raises the total number of COVID-19 cases to 53,824 in Cameron County. There have also been an additional 25 individuals who have recovered, raising the total number of recovered individuals to 50,724.

Cameron County Public Health has received notification of two (2) additional COVID-19 related deaths of Cameron County residents. The deaths reported today were unvaccinated. This raises the total of number of COVID-19 deaths in Cameron County to 2,002.
