The Department publicly releases body-worn camera video of critical incidents within 30 calendar days of an incident. In some cases, it may take more than 30 days if the investigation is complex, a court issues an order delaying or preventing release of the footage, or additional time is needed to allow a civilian depicted in the video, or their family, to view the video in advance.

While the litigation was pending, the Department released a portion of the body-worn camera footage to public, at which point the Department released the complete body-worn camera footage with appropriate redactions to New York Lawyers with Public Interest.
