We are currently working on setting up our current student management system (PowerSchool) to have the ability to enter this information. The expected completion of the system set up is about 2 weeks, this will give us the ability to run multiple different reports to pull the following information:

- Call type
 - Bomb threat
 - Evacuation
 - Lock down
 - Other active threat
 - Not bomb threat
 - Specify nature of threat
 - Trespasser
 - Weapons violation
 - Illegal sale and/or distribution of controlled substances
 - Other substance use violation
 - Specify
 - Physical assault
 - Vandalism
 - Parking Violation
 - Education (e.g., class visit)
 - Event security/Communication regarding community events
 - Communication regarding critical student information
 - Support with home visit due to safety concern
 - Other
 - Specify
- Date and time of call
- Who made the call
- Who is the call in reference to
 - *Student(s) name if applicable*
- Location (school)
- Response Time
 - *Time of call to time of arrival
OR indicate DLO was
unavailable to come to
location*
- DLO intervention provided
- Next steps by school

District Liaison Summary

August to October 2021

(Incident's key)

911 Hangup	911 call received from school and no answer upon return call from 911 operator
Accident - LSA	Motor vehicle crash in which at least one operator left the scene without providing the other his/her information
Alcohol Offense	Student under the influence (Drinking Alcohol in school)
Assist - Agency/other/Public	Ranges from school requesting assistance in locating parents because they did not pick child up to being asked to be in the area because of issues with parents.
Custodial Interference	Parent with no legal right to a child attempting to take child from school
Directed Patrol	Police presence was requested for a specific reason. In these cases, it was the neighbor issue with SACS drop off and pick up times
Disorderly Conduct	ranges from swearing to mutual fighting
Drugs - Possession	Possession of a drug. This is your Prescription pills, cocaine, Ecstasy, Meth, Marijuana
Found/Lost Property	Property was located and turned over to the Police
Informational	Case punch as student wanted to report a social media incident, however parents did not want to cooperate with police
Juvenile Problem	Juvenile Problems are not necessarily criminal but are a safety issue to themselves and others
Mental Health Issue	Imbedded NCSS crisis worker was utilized to assist school staff and or students
Missing Person	Person is missing from school
Motor Vehicle Complaint	Passing school bus with lights on/acting recklessly on school campus
Parking	unauthorized parking on property
Public Speaking	Teaching classes
SRO Detail	30 September and earlier, combination of when the SRO was in school and when the SRO's provided security details for after school events. 1 October and Later, Security details only.
Stalking	unwelcomed events which occurred more than once
Subpoena Service	Court paperwork served on a person. In this case it was a staff member
Suspicious Event	Examples are unknown male walking in around school to staff hearing possible gun shots
Threats/Harassment	perceived or actual threat made to another
Trespass	Person or person on property or in the building with no legal right to be on property or in the building
Vandalism	Vandalized property
Weapons Offense	Possession of a deadly or dangerous weapon on a school bus or in a school building.
Welfare Check	School requesting a welfare check on a student for various reasons (truancy or mental health are examples)

MRUSD had 27 incidents in **August 2021** that an SRO was needed. Below are the totals by incidents.

- Accident: 1
- Assist: 1
- Custodial Interference: 1
- Juvenile Problem: 2
