

1 3. At this time, the parties agree and jointly stipulate that this Court's ruling on the pending
2 Summary Judgment Motion is likely to impact how this case moves forward and any potential
3 future motions practice. Therefore, the parties jointly request that any further summary judgment
4 briefing deadlines be extended until after this Court rules on the pending motion. Following this
5 Court's ruling, the parties propose to meet and confer on any future briefing schedule, as
6 necessary.

7 4. Based on the good cause identified above, and in order to try to conserve judicial resources,
8 the parties agree and stipulate that there is good cause to extend the current summary judgment
9 deadlines set forth in the Case Management Order, Dkt. # 7.
