



HOUSTON CARBON CAPTURE AND STORAGE HUB CONCEPT

SCOPE

- CAPTURE CO₂ FROM ~50 LARGE EMITTERS
- ~350 MILES OF CO₂ PIPELINE, USING EXISTING CORRIDORS
- MULTIPLE OFFSHORE WELLS

TIMELINE

- 50MTA BY 2030
- 100MTA BY 2040
- HELP MEET HOUSTON'S GOAL TO BE CARBON NEUTRAL BY 2050



WHAT'S NEEDED

ENHANCE NON-EOR CCS PRODUCTION TAX CREDIT (45Q)

- Initially increase value to \$100 per metric ton from current \$50
- Extend eligibility period to 30 years from current 12 years
- Eliminate deadline for starting construction

PROVIDE FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR CCS INFRASTRUCTURE

- Provide a \$10 billion grant to help develop infrastructure in Houston by extending current DOE programs beyond RD&D
- Expand DOE Title XVII program to include the deployment of existing CCS technologies at scale
- Amend TIFIA to add CCS projects, or create a program dedicated to CCS

ENSURE GOVERNMENT APPROVAL FOR CO₂ STORAGE

- Specifically allow offshore storage of CO₂ from sources other than coal
- Authorize the BOEM to issue leases, rights of way and pore space
