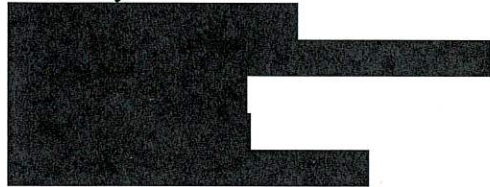

Select Committee to Investigate the January 6th Attack on the United States Capitol

Dear Ms. Fletcher:

Pursuant to the authorities set forth in House Resolution 503 and the rules of the House of Representatives, the Select Committee to Investigate the January 6th Attack on the United States Capitol (“Select Committee”) hereby transmits a subpoena that compels you to produce the documents set forth in the accompanying schedule by December 23, 2021, and to appear for a deposition on January 4, 2022.

The Select Committee is investigating the facts, circumstances, and causes of the January 6th attack and issues relating to the peaceful transfer of power, in order to identify and evaluate lessons learned and to recommend to the House and its relevant committees corrective laws, policies, procedures, rules, or regulations. The inquiry includes examination of how various individuals and entities coordinated their activities leading up to the events of January 6, 2021.

The Select Committee’s investigation and public reports have revealed credible evidence of your involvement in and knowledge of the events within the scope of the Select Committee’s inquiry. According to documents on file with the Select Committee, press reports, and your public statements, you were an organizer of and participant in, both individually and through your organization Moms for America, events held after the November 2020 election in support of then-President Trump and his allegations of election fraud.¹ This included the “March to Save America” events held on Freedom Plaza on January 5, 2021, and on the Ellipse on January 6, 2021, in Washington, D.C., for which Moms for America was identified as a participant.² You also obtained a permit on behalf of Moms for America from the United States Capitol Police (“USCP”) for an

event to be held on January 5 and 6, 2021, “to support election integrity.”³ Documents provided to the Select Committee also show that you were in communication with Stop the Steal (“STS”) organizer Ali Alexander (also known as “Ali Abdul Razaq Akbar” and “Ali Abdul Akbar”) during the application process, in an apparent attempt to coordinate your application with the application STS submitted for an event under the name “One Nation Under God.”⁴ After the January 6th attack on the U.S. Capitol, Mr. Alexander released a statement acknowledging that STS had obtained the permit for the protest under the name “One Nation Under God.”⁵ You also acknowledged knowing that Alexander and STS used the false name, and admitted receiving calls from law enforcement before January 6th “trying to find out who was who.”⁶

Staff with the Select Committee sought your voluntary cooperation with its investigation, but you declined. Accordingly, the Select Committee seeks documents and a deposition regarding these and other matters that are within the scope of the Select Committee’s inquiry.
