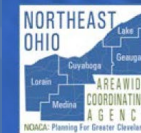

BACKGROUND

Reason: Allow up to Five (5) Homes to Connect to Sanitary Sewers

Applicant: Village of Moreland Hills

Transfer Area: Five (5) Parcels (21.2 acres) in Moreland Hills

FPA Boundary Change: None

Prescription Change: From “areas served by on-site systems” to “limited sewers expected within 20 years

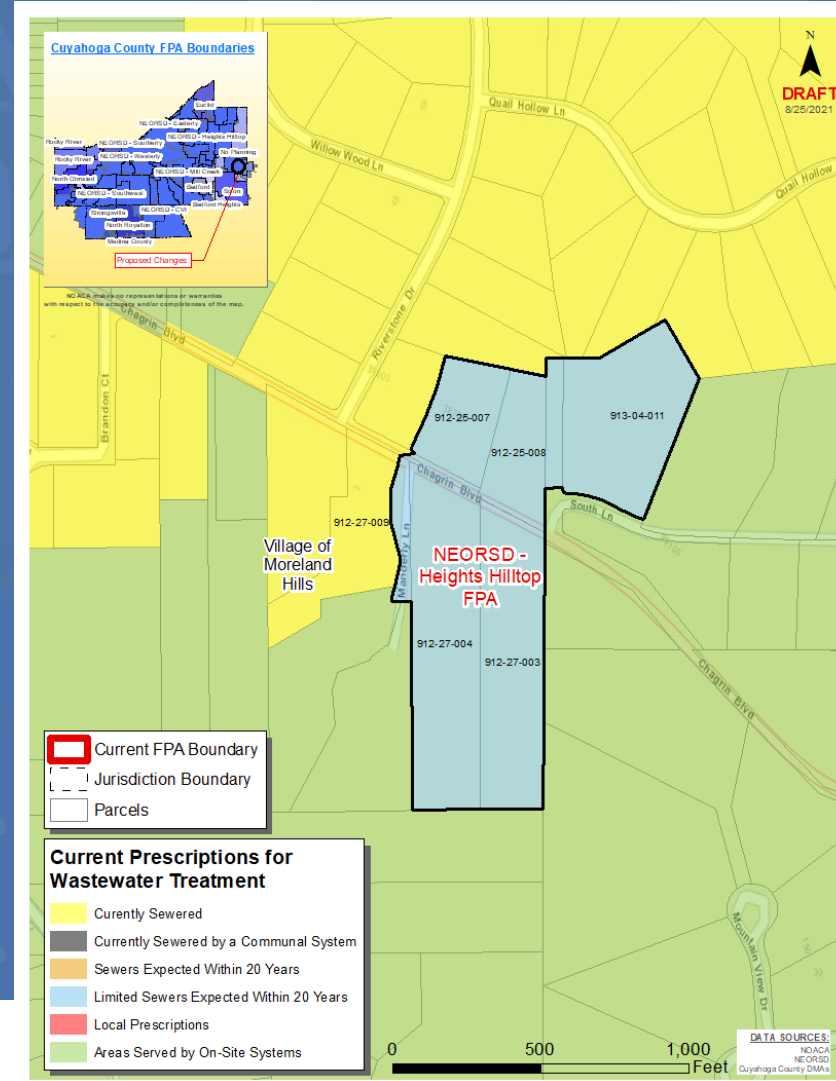
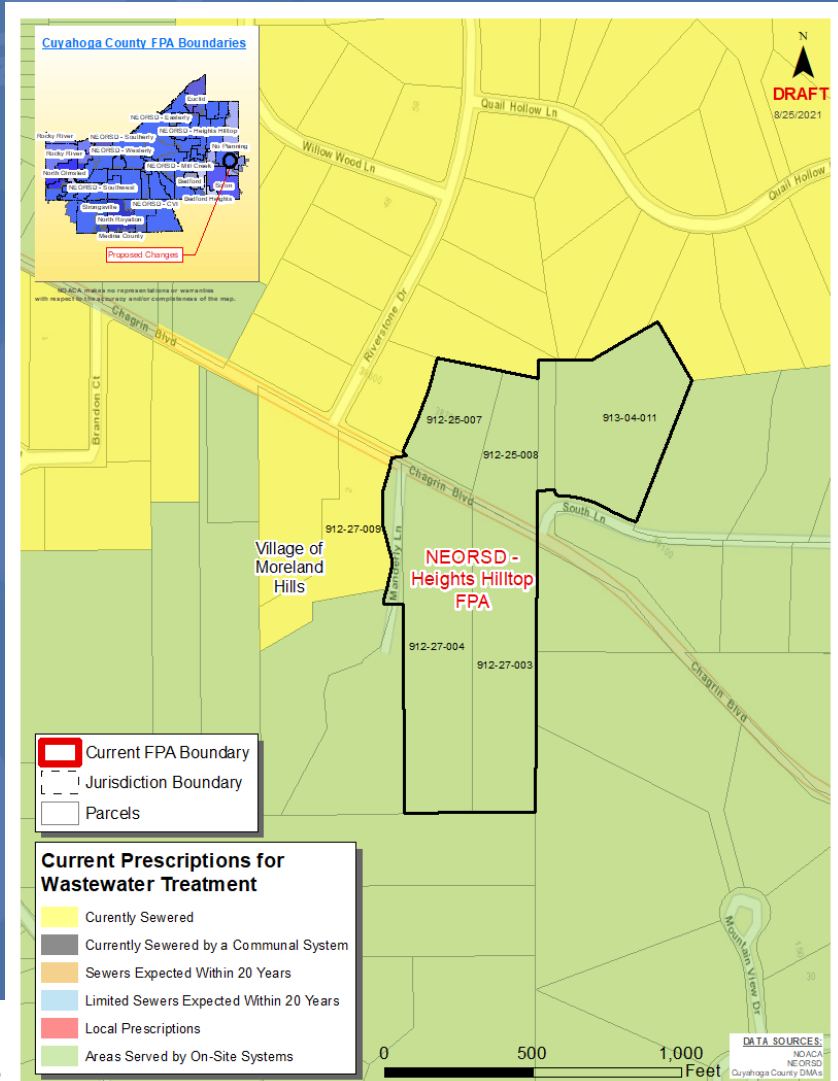
