OVERVIEW.

- The “**WILD PROTEST**” was a protest planned to take place at Los Angeles City Hall, on **Wednesday January 6th 9am-12pm**. Protest was expected to bring a moderate sized crowd with expectation of possible counter protesters.
- This protest was part of a National Protest taking place in protest of Presidential Election results.
- After organized portion of program concluded, fringe attendees and counter protestors engaged in various acts of lawlessness and civil disobedience forcing Department personnel to take a limited amount of enforcement action to maintain/restore civil order, and eventually contact between Dept personnel and some protestors occurred.
- (6) Arrests were made.

- On Monday, January 4th, OCB personnel received the flyer for the “Wild Protest” and became aware of the event. [REDACTED]

- On Tuesday, January 5th and 6th, OCB spoke with the Organizer (Sarah Stevens) who advised she was not sure of exact number of anticipated protesters, however (3) different organizers from multiple locations were working together.
- January 6th- The 201 (ICS Incident Briefing) was completed, Incident commander and Operations Chief briefed, before protest began.

OUTREACH & INTERACTION WITH PROTEST EVENT ORGANIZERS

- On Tuesday, January 5th, Sarah Stephens (event Organizer) reached out to OCB Special Events. She provided details regarding the “Wild Protest”.
- On Wednesday, January 6th, at approximately **0800 hours**. Ms. Stephens met with OCB Special Events by the City Hall - South Lawn. Conversations with Ms. Stephens and OCB Special Events continued to actively communicate throughout the planned event.
- On January 6th, at approximately **1200 hours**, the Organizer advised her event was over and she would announce it over the microphone and by bull horn
- On January 6th, at approximately **1220 hours**, the Organizer put away sound equipment & **the organized portion of the event concluded.**

Volunteer Protest Intel that was unknown

- Other than initial flyer and follow-up to social media sites, nothing was volunteered about protest until event organizer (Sarah Stephens) reached out to OCB Special Events staff on January 5th.

➤ **Anti-Trump Protestors**

- Anti-Trump protestors continually entered south lawn area to confront pro-Trump group. Although completely legal for them to enter south lawn, it was very clear to Stabile that their intent was to cause a confrontation.
- Trump supporters would surround the counter demonstrator, and the counter protestor would be forced to leave the south lawn when a large group would surround them and begin yelling, [Antifa get out].
- Stabile watched countless times specific counter protestors re-enter the south lawn (5-10 times).
- Stabile had a few different female counter protestors yell at me, asking when I was going to declare the Trump protestors and unlawful assembly.

De-Escalation efforts.

- The Dept's initial posture of keeping our officers staged near the event should be considered a de-escalation attempt.
- Capt Stabile spoke with both sides, multiple times in attempt to get voluntary compliance to keep the groups separated.
- Capt Stabile would estimate there were 5-6 times throughout event, he deployed squads of LAPD officers to separate the groups. Deploying these officers timely and immediately when scuffles broke out was an effort to provide a visual presence and ensure both sides we would not tolerate unlawful behavior.

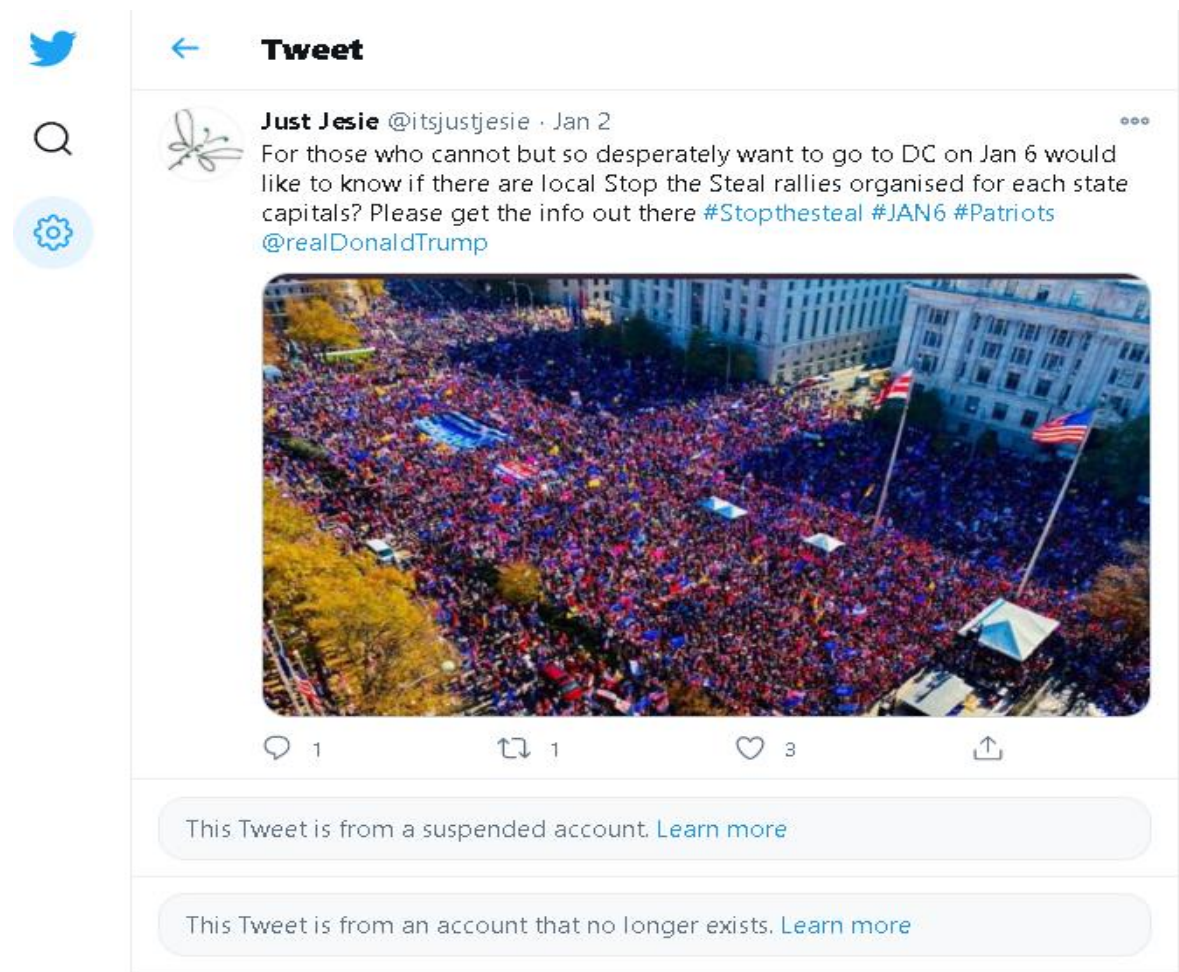
