Canada's border measures during COVID-19

Canada has taken unprecedented action to limit the spread of COVID-19 in our country, based on the public health measures introduced by the Public Health Agency of Canada (PHAC). The Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) and PHAC have put in place enhanced health and safety measures to help prevent the spread of COVID-19 while continuing to support the movement of essential workers and goods across the border.

Summary of Quarantine Act compliance and enforcement measures

All travellers entering Canada must follow rules set out by the <u>emergency</u> <u>orders under the *Quarantine Act*</u>. This is to limit the spread of COVID-19 and variants in Canada.

Prior to arrival to Canada, all travellers by air and land are required to submit COVID-19-related information electronically using the ArriveCAN app. Unless otherwise exempt, these travellers are required to:

- confirm they have arrived at a government-authorized hotel or the address they provided for their place of quarantine or isolation within 48 hours of entering Canada; and,
- complete a daily COVID-19 symptom self-assessment during their 14-day quarantine period.

Travellers are informed upon entry of the compliance monitoring and verification activities, which include:

- emails
- calls from an agent
- interactive automated calls
- in-person visits

Travellers are also informed upon entry of the possible consequences of non-compliance, and the enforcement actions and penalties they could face.
