We write to inquire on the status of our March 5, 2021 FOIA request that DOJ produce certain categories of documents relating to DOJ's drafting and publication of the "United States Department of Justice Statement on the PCAST Report: Forensic Science in Criminal Courts: Ensuring Scientific Validity of Feature-Comparison Methods," which was made available on DOJ's website on January 13, 2021.
