Homicide: Unit Block of Forrester Street, Southwest

(Washington, DC) – Detectives from the Metropolitan Police Department’s Homicide Branch are investigating a homicide that occurred on Friday, January 21, 2022, in the Unit block of Forrester Street, Southwest.

At approximately 6:43 pm, members of the Seventh District responded to the listed location for the report of the sound of gunshots. Upon arrival, members located two adult male victims, seated in a vehicle, suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. The victims displayed no signs consistent with life. The victims remained on scene until transported to the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner.

The decedents have been identified as **21 year-old Terrance Brown**, of Laurel, MD., and **22 year-old Ezra Beyene**, of Burke, VA.

The Metropolitan Police Department currently offers a reward of up to **\$25,000** to anyone that provides information which leads to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for each homicide committed in the District of Columbia.
