THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY CHARGES:

COUNT I

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022,  
at or near Anchorage, MICHAEL ALEXANDER CORDO PATRICK AND SAMMY  
ERIC PHANHLY recklessly caused serious physical injury to another by means of a  
dangerous instrument.

1 All of which is a class A Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of  
2 AS 11.41.200(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

3  
4 COUNT II

5 That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022,  
6 at or near Anchorage, MICHAEL ALEXANDER CORDO PATRICK AND SAMMY  
7 ERIC PHANHLY discharged a firearm from a propelled vehicle while the vehicle was  
8 being operated and under circumstances manifesting substantial and unjustifiable risk of  
9 physical injury to a person or damage to property.

10 All of which is a class A Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of  
11 AS 11.61.190(a)(2) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

12 COUNT III

13 That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022,  
14 at or near Anchorage, MICHAEL ALEXANDER CORDO PATRICK AND SAMMY  
15 ERIC PHANHLY recklessly caused physical injury to another person by means of a  
16 dangerous instrument.

17 All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of  
18 AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(B) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

19 COUNT IV

20 That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022,  
21 at or near Anchorage, MICHAEL ALEXANDER CORDO PATRICK AND SAMMY  
22 ERIC PHANHLY recklessly placed another person in fear of imminent serious physical  
23 injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

24 All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of  
25 AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

27 COUNT V

1 That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022,  
2 at or near Anchorage, MICHAEL ALEXANDER CORDO PATRICK AND SAMMY  
3 ERIC PHANHLY recklessly placed another person in fear of imminent serious physical  
4 injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

5 All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of  
6 AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

**COUNT VI**

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022,  
at or near Anchorage, MICHAEL ALEXANDER CORDO PATRICK AND SAMMY  
ERIC PHANHLY recklessly placed another person in fear of imminent serious physical  
injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of  
AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

**COUNT VII**

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022,  
at or near Anchorage, MICHAEL ALEXANDER CORDO PATRICK AND SAMMY  
ERIC PHANHLY recklessly placed another person in fear of imminent serious physical  
injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of  
AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

**COUNT VIII**

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022,  
at or near Anchorage, MICHAEL ALEXANDER CORDO PATRICK AND SAMMY  
ERIC PHANHLY recklessly placed another person in fear of imminent serious physical  
injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

1 All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of  
2 AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

3  
4 **COUNT IX**

5 That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022,  
6 at or near Anchorage, MICHAEL ALEXANDER CORDO PATRICK AND SAMMY  
7 ERIC PHANHLY recklessly placed another person in fear of imminent serious physical  
8 injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

9 All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of  
10 AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

11 **COUNT X**

12 That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022,  
13 at or near Anchorage, MICHAEL ALEXANDER CORDO PATRICK AND SAMMY  
14 ERIC PHANHLY recklessly placed another person in fear of imminent serious physical  
15 injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

16 All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of  
17 AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

18 **COUNT XI**

19 That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022,  
20 at or near Anchorage, MICHAEL ALEXANDER CORDO PATRICK AND SAMMY  
21 ERIC PHANHLY recklessly engaged in conduct which created a substantial risk of  
22 serious physical injury to another person.

23 All of which is a class A Misdemeanor offense being contrary to and in violation  
24 of AS 11.41.250 and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

26 The undersigned swears under oath this Information is based upon a review of  
27 police report 22-2389 submitted to date.

1 On January 21, 2022 at around 2000 hours, APD responded to a call for a  
2 shooting at [REDACTED] N. Bliss Street. When officers arrived they found victim S.P. had  
3 suffered a gunshot wound to the head. She was transported to Providence hospital.  
4 Witnesses on scene stated that they had observed a grey truck approach a Jeep (AK  
5 [REDACTED]) and that they heard one or two gunshots. Officers observed that the back  
6 window of the Jeep had been mostly shattered.

7 Detectives interviewed multiple witnesses and victims. They were told that one  
8 of the passengers in the truck, minor M.P. had been arranging for his girlfriend and S.P.  
9 to meet and fight or argue. The passengers in the truck were S.P. his brother SAMMY  
10 PHANLY, the driver MICHAEL PATRICK, and a man identified as "Sauce."  
11 Earlier in the day and the day prior, SAMMY PHANLEY, MICHAEL PATRICK, M.P.,  
12 and others had picked Sauce up. Sauce was in possession of an AR-style rifle, which  
13 both M.P. and MICHAEL PATRICK had wanted to see.

14 Later in the evening, SAMMY PHANLY, MICHAEL PATRICK, M.P., and  
15 Sauce went to meet up with S.P. and the passengers of the Jeep. M.P. called a passenger  
16 in the Jeep to ascertain their location. Just a few moments after that, the passengers in the  
17 Jeep observed the grey pickup drive by. As it did, Sauce, who was sitting in the rear  
18 passenger seat, fired his gun out the window at the Jeep, shooting S.P. in the head and  
19 placing the other passengers of the vehicle in fear.

20 At that point, the grey pickup drove away. No one in the vehicle stopped to offer  
21 assistance. No one in the vehicle called 911 or reported the incident.


