All of which is a class A Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.200(a)(1) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

COUNT II

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022, at or near Anchorage, BERNARD ISAICK JORDAN and MICHAEL ALEXANDER CORDO PATRICK, as principals and/or accomplices, discharged a firearm from a propelled vehicle while the vehicle was being operated and under circumstances manifesting substantial and unjustifiable risk of physical injury to a person or damage to property.

All of which is a class A Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.61.190(a)(2) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

COUNT III

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022, at or near Anchorage, BERNARD ISAICK JORDAN recklessly caused physical injury to 14 year-old KB by means of a dangerous instrument.

All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS11.41.220(a)(1)(B) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

COUNT IV

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022, at or near Anchorage, BERNARD ISAICK JORDAN recklessly placed Kijean Krause in in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

COUNT VIII

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022, at or near Anchorage, BERNARD ISAICK JORDAN recklessly placed 13 year-old GT in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022, at or near Anchorage, BERNARD ISAICK JORDAN recklessly placed 13 year-old AN in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

COUNT X

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022, at or near Anchorage, BERNARD ISAICK JORDAN recklessly placed 14 year-old AN in fear of imminent serious physical injury by means of a dangerous instrument.

All of which is a class C Felony offense being contrary to and in violation of AS11.41.220(a)(1)(A) and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

COUNT XI

That in the Third Judicial District, State of Alaska, on or about January 21, 2022, at or near Anchorage, BERNARD ISAICK JORDAN recklessly engaged in conduct which created a substantial risk of serious physical injury to another person.

All of which is a class A Misdemeanor offense being contrary to and in violation of AS 11.41.250 and against the peace and dignity of the State of Alaska.

The undersigned swears under oath this Information is based upon a review of police report 22-2389 submitted to date.

On Friday 21 January 2022 at approximately 7:40pm Anchorage Police responded to the area of Bliss and Thompson reference a minor shot in the head. Initial reports indicated a suspect vehicle, described as a gray pickup truck, fled the scene. At the scene there were multiple minors, several with apparent injuries, and a parked dark Jeep with the rear window broken out.

Occupants of the Jeep were driver 21 year-old Kijean Krause, 13 year-old AC, 14 year-old RB, 13 year-old SG, 14 year-old KB, 13 year-old GT, 13 year-old AN, 14 year-old AN, and 13 year-old SP. SP was transported to Providence Alaska Medical Center for treatment of a single gunshot wound to the head. As of 24 January 2022 SP remains hospitalized with significant life-threatening injuries.

All other occupants were taken to Anchorage Police headquarters.

In summary police learned that 16 year-old SY and 14 year-old MP are in a relationship but that MP was also talking with SP. SY and SP are cousins and this caused the two of them to argue. Krause drove the Jeep to Peck Avenue and everyone got into the Jeep. KB had been messaging MP who provided multiple addresses for SY and SP to fight. MP told KB that SY was with him but KB did not hear any female voice when speaking with MP on the phone. The Jeep drove around Mountain View for a short time and ended up at North Bliss. A gray truck drove up and one shot was fired from the truck and the truck then drove away. Police observed injuries to KB's shoulder from bullet fragments.

Police located a single .223 caliber spent casing in the center of the road north to where the Jeep was parked.

On Saturday 22 January 2022 at approximately 12:29am Anchorage Police contacted 16 year-old SY at the Alaska Military Youth Academy. Police confirmed she had not left the Academy since her arrival on 19 January 2022 and had not been with MP at the time of the shooting. SY said she had been dating MP for a few months but had never been to his house and did not believe MP had a car.

On Saturday 22 January 2022 at approximately 3:32am Anchorage Police located the suspect truck outside of Williwa and believed MP was inside the apartment. The 2011 Dodge Ram, Alaska plate , is registered to a Paul Patrick. Police knocked, were let inside by Dokmai Thinoi (MP's mother), and arrested 14 yearold MP. During a pat down of MP police located a shotgun shell in his possession. MP was taken to Anchorage Police headquarters, interviewed, and later remanded to McLaughlin Youth Center.

Also in the apartment was MP's older brother, 18 year-old SAMMY PHANHLY, and 18 year-old MICHAEL PATRICK. SAMMY PHANHLY, MICHAEL PATRICK, 20 year-old Visay Phanhly, and 21 year-old Camille Hickman were taken to Anchorage Police headquarters. Police secured a search warrant for the apartment. Inside SAMMY PHANHLYs bedroom police located a disassembled Benelli shotgun, marijuana pipes, marijuana grinders, and marijuana.

Hickman told police she was in the Dodge truck with MICHAEL PATRICK driving and MP as another passenger on Thursday 20 January 2022. Hickman said they went to pick up a black male known as "Sauce" who MICHAEL PATRICK referred to as his friend off Dimond. They stopped at a Holiday station where "Sauce" pulled out a gun which Hickman described as looking like an AK-47 but with no stock. Hickman further advised "Sauce" had a backpack with drugs inside. Hickman reported they all traveled to 7940 Williwa and went inside with "Sauce" bringing the gun with him. Hickman stated MICHAEL PATRICK, SAMMY PHANHLY, MP, and "Sauce" all left around 3:00am on 21 January 2022 and that was the last time she saw "Sauce" and she had never met him before. Hickman remained at the Williwa apartment with her boyfriend, Visay Phanhly, and that around 10:00pm MICHAEL PATRICK, SAMMY PHANHLY, and MP arrived back to the apartment. According to Hickman none of them said anything about a shooting.

Visay Phanhly told police "Sauce" showed up to the apartment with an AR but he did not see it because it was under a blanket. Visay Phanhly said "Sauce" was at the apartment for approximately 30 minutes before leaving with SAMMY PHANHLY and MP. Visay Phanhly stated SAMMY PHANHLY and MP got back to the apartment between 10:00 and 11:00pm but never said anything about a shooting

Police spoke with MP. MP said he and his brother SAMMY PHANHLY were dropped off at East High School in the morning by MICHAEL PATRICK and then picked up by him around 2:15pm. From there they ended up on Dimond where they picked up "Sauce". Afterwards MP got messages from KB reference SY and SP arguing. Ultimately MP agreed to meet everyone at the North Bliss address. MP said MICHAEL

PATRICK was driving, SAMMY PHANHLY was in the rear driver's side seat, "Sauce" in the rear passenger's side seat, and MP in the front passenger's seat. According to MP as they drove up to the Jeep SAMMY PHANHLY's window was rolled down and "Sauce" fired two shots at the Jeep. MP said they drove to Spenard and dropped "Sauce" off.

SAMMY PHANHLY said he was in the backseat sitting behind MICHAEL PATRICK with "Sauce" also in the backseat. According to SAMMY PHANHLY as they drove up to the Jeep "Sauce" fired twice from a rifle with a folding stock. They then dropped "Sauce" off and returned to Williwa.

MICHAEL PATRICK admitted to being the driver, provided the first name of "Sauce" as BERNARD, and also gave a phone number. MICHAEL PATRICK stated he was surprised when shots were fired.

Police identified "Sauce" as 19 year-old BERNARD JORDAN after putting the phone number, possible address for "Sauce", a previous police investigation for a "Sauce", and first name together. Surveillance footage from a nearby location off Dimond put a Dodge truck picking up a male from the possible address on Olympic on 21 January 2022 at 5:42pm.

On Sunday 23 January 2022 at approximately 1:00pm Anchorage Police located BERNARD JORDAN as a passenger in a red Ford driven by Jett Hiibner. BERNARD JORDAN was taken to Anchorage Police headquarters and then remanded to Anchorage Correctional Complex.
