Re: Recovery of Damages Incurred Due to Chargers' Relocation

Dear Mayor Gloria:

As set forth in the attached legal commentary, there is established legal precedent for the City of San Diego to recover taxpayer losses from the NFL and the Chargers, as was done under similar circumstances by the City of St. Louis and the St. Louis Regional Convention and Sports Complex Authority.

We write to confirm that you, as Mayor of the City of San Diego, have decided not to take any legal action to recover damages the City suffered as a result of the Chargers' relocation to Los Angeles starting in the 2017 football season.

For these reasons, on January 21, 2022, a taxpayer lawsuit will be brought to recover damages for the 2017 Chargers' relocation.

If the City of San Diego intends to bring such legal action, please inform us on or before January 20, 2022.
