

In response to Harry S. Stonehill's Privacy Act request dated October 19, 1979, the Criminal Division of the Department of Justice referred his request to the Tax Division for processing. This referral was received by the Tax Division's Information and Privacy Unit on November 1, 1979.

Pursuant to 28 C.F.R. § 16.93, a regulation promulgated pursuant to subsections (j) and (k) of the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552a, Tax Division systems of records have been exempted from the access provisions of the Privacy Act. His request, however, has been processed under the standards of the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552. A search of the indices to the files of the Tax Division was conducted, and four (4) files responsive to his request were located. We have determined that one thousand one hundred forty-five (1,145) documents are releasable in their entireties.

Portions of one hundred fifty-one (151) documents have been withheld and one hundred three (103) have been withheld in their entireties. This material is exempt from disclosure pursuant to the exemptions set forth in subsections (b) (3), (b) (5), (b) (7) (C) and (b) (7) (D) of the Freedom of Information Act. A portion of one document is being withheld pursuant to a Court Order, prohibiting its release. Exemption 3, in conjunction with 26 U.S.C. § 6103, has been applied to material reflecting confidential tax return information of third parties. Exemption 5 has been applied to material which is predecisional in nature reflecting the give and take of the covernment's consultative process. Release of portions of some documents would constitute an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of third parties, and Exemption 7(C) has been applied to this material. Finally, Exemption 7(D) has been applied to portions of some documents to protect the identity of confidential sources.

Thereafter, judicial review of our determination, if upheld by the Assistant Attorney General, Office of Legal Policy, will be available in the District Court of the United States in the district in which your client resides or has his principal





This is in response to you letter of January 6, 1999, concerning our response to your Freedom of Information Act request of behalf of your clients, Harry S. Stonehill and Robert P. Brooks.

In an effort to clarify our original response, let me begin by stating that a through review was conducted of the five boxes of records under the jurisdiction of the Assistant Commissioner (International) that relate to your clients. I personally assisted with this review. These boxes contained the Collection Administrative file and documented all efforts to collect U.S. Income taxes assessed against your clients. We reviewed each page to determine if the subject matter related in any way to the list of entities that you provided and the time frame in question. The only documents we located were provided to you in full, with no deletions. There were no other documents under our jurisdiction responsive to your request.

I have reviewed the documents that you attached to your letter. They appear to be declassified documents obtained from the files of another government agency. We did not find copies of those documents in the files we reviewed. We have no knowledge of these documents, nor do we have any knowledge of where they can be located, if they exist. There were no classified documents in the files that we reviewed. The fact that the documents you provided suggest that they were authored by an IRS employee or refer to IRS activity does not provide us with information that would enable us to locate additional records, if they exist, that are not in our possession at this time. I'm sure that you are aware that this case was litigated by the Department of Justice for a number of years. It might be possible that the records in question would be in their files. I would suggest you direct any further correspondence concerning these records to the Department of Justice under a Freedom of Information Act request. Your FOIA request to the Internal Revenue Service dated July 10, 1998 and your letter of January 6, 1999, if directed to DOJ, will probably not meet the specific requirements of the Act. I suggest you resubmit a perfected request to DOJ at this time.

Enclosed is Notice 393 that explains your appeal rights should you wish to appeal our response.

I do not believe that this office can be of further assistance in your quest for these records.

Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. 552, the Privacy Act, 5 U.S.C. 552a, and 28 CFR 16.1 et seq., please consider this a request for a copy of all records, files, hearing transcripts, notes or memoranda of meetings or telephone conversations, and other data in your possession, custody, or control pertaining to Robert P. Brooks, Harry S. Stonehill and United States Tobacco Company including but not limited to:

- (1) all documents provided by or related to Menhart Spielman or to Menhart Spielman's meeting on December 18, 1961 with Robert Chandler, Internal Revenue Service representative in Far East, attached to the United States Embassy in the Philippines;
- (2) all correspondence between Robert Chandler and Office of International Operations of Washington, D.C. or the U.S. Department of Justice, relating to Menhart Spielman, Harry Stonehill, Robert Brooks or the United States Tobacco Company from January 1960 through January 1965, including but not limited to, January 10, 1962 memorandum from Robert Chandler, Revenue Service Representative, to Office of International Operations, Washington, D.C. and December 1961 memorandum regarding Harry S. Stonehill;
- (3) all notes or documents relating to January 9, 1962 meeting between Robert Chandler and Howard L. Parsons, Economic Counselor for the U.S. Embassy in the Philippines;
- (4) all documents relating to meetings or telephone conferences or conversations between Robert Chandler and Menhart Spielman and/or Colonel Lukban, Director of the National Bureau of Investigation of the Philippines, between December 1961 and June 1962;

- (5) all documents relating to meetings or communications between Robert Chandler and the National Bureau of Investigation regarding the investigation of Harry Stonehill and Robert Brooks and the raids of the United States Tobacco Company which commenced on March 3, 1962.
- (6) all notes or correspondence relating to February 11, 1962 meeting arranged by Robert Chandler, between Philippines Secretary of Justice Diakno and Executive Assistant to the Attorney General of the U.S. Robert Kennedy.

As you know, the FOIA requires that even if some material is properly exempt from mandatory disclosure, all segregable portions must be released. If any material covered by this request is withheld, please inform me of the specific exemptions that are being claimed. If material is being released with deletions, I request that each deletion be marked to indicate which exemption(s) is (are) being claimed to authorize each particular withholding. In addition, I ask that your agency exercise its discretion to release information that may be technically exempt but where withholding it would serve no important public interest. Also, please identify the person or persons responsible for the decision declaring an exemption.

My clients, Harry S. Stonehill and Robert P. Brooks, agree to pay any and all reasonable expenses incurred in connection with fulfilling this request.

Original Power of Attorney forms which were been endorsed by Messrs. Stonehill and Brooks (copies of which are attached hereto) were included in the FOIA request to the Department of Defense to which the instant FOIA request is a continuation. As provided under the FOIA, I will expect a reply within ten working days.
