COVID-19 Prevention Order – Mask Requirement

Issued by City Health Director Dr. Lindsay Huse

WHEREAS, pursuant to City of Omaha Municipal Code §12-1, the Director of the Douglas County Health Department acts as the Health Director for the City of Omaha (“Director”) and the Director has such powers as are detailed in Chapter 12 of the Omaha Municipal Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Director issued a COVID-19 Prevention Order – Mask Requirement (“Order”), dated January 11, 2022; and,

WHEREAS, the Order states that it shall be reviewed at a minimum every four (4) weeks for a determination of the Director on extension or expiration; and,

WHEREAS, the Director has reviewed the seven (7) day total number of cases per 100,000 population and finds that it is currently 344.6 persons per 100,000; and

WHEREAS, the Director has reviewed the Metro Omaha Hospital Occupancy Rate and finds that hospital capacity has not been maintained below 85% for seven (7) consecutive days.

THEREFORE, the Order will remain in effect until positive case counts for the City of Omaha are below 200 persons per 100,000 on a seven (7) day total and hospital capacity is maintained at or below 85% for seven (7) consecutive days, unless renewed, extended, or terminated by subsequent order. The Director will review the Order within one (1) week for a determination of the Director on the extension or expiration the Order.
