The Ohio Consumers' Counsel has asked the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio to audit and investigate FirstEnergy to see whether any money collected from the public was "improperly used" as part of an alleged \$60 million bribery scandal to pass House Bill 6, which gave a \$1.3 billion bailout to two nuclear power plants owned by a one-time FirstEnergy subsidiary. FirstEnergy officials have denied any wrongdoing, and no charges have been filed to date against the company or its leadership
