

Public Disclosure: Ohio Valley University Voluntary Resignation of Accreditation Effective: June 30, 2022

Ohio Valley University in Vienna, West Virginia, has provided official notification that it will voluntarily resign accreditation with the Higher Learning Commission as a result of closing. The voluntary resignation is effective June 30, 2022.

The institution has informed the Higher Learning Commission that Alderson Broaddus University will house the college's student records after closing.

Current Ohio Valley University students who cannot complete their studies at the institution may transfer to other institutions. Any questions about student loans should be directed to the U.S. Department of Education.
