We wanted to let EHA know that RPPR issues has been resolved and summarize the sequence of events. On 9/16/2020 the signing official contacted the eRA service desk about filling out the Inclusion Enrollment data. During the call the eRA service desk agent responded by reviewing the RPPR which automatically updated the RPPR inadvertently in eRA Commons. eRA has regenerated the RPPR in eRA Commons and restored the RPPR to the original submission.
