Jackson County, Missouri Vaccination/Weekly Testing Safety Mandate Guidelines Effective March 4, 2022

This mandate is in place to improve the safety of our facilities for associates, their families, and the community.

Following closely the COVID-19 Community Levels provided by the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), Jackson County will use a LOW, MEDIUM, HIGH scale which will indicate weekly, the requirements for our Associates and visitors in our county buildings and workspaces. *An executive distribution email will be sent each Friday indicating the Jackson County COVID-19 Community Level which will be implemented for the following week*.

 Mask-Wearing: The County <u>does</u> <u>not</u> require associates and visitors to wear masks in County facilities/workspaces, regardless of vaccination status. Wearing masks is optional. Temperature screener machines at Jackson County building entrances: The use of these will <u>not</u> be required upon entering the building. Stay up to date with COVID-19 Vaccines.
