Welcome to beautiful Dana Point for the first Council for National Policy meeting of 2022!





Media and Publicity

CNP meetings are closed to the media. If a reporter contacts you to obtain information about CNP, its members, or conferences, including speakers, please refer them to a CNP staff member with a green nametag.

Membership List and Contacting Members

The CNP membership list and membership directory is a benefit of membership and should remain within the organization to maintain the quality of membership communications. Members may disclose their own membership in CNP but not the names of fellow members. Members may use the membership list and directory to correspond with other members, with the following courtesy guidelines in mind:

- Recurring mailings and emails must have an unsubscribe mechanism.
- Bulk emails must be sent in a manner that keeps a member's email address private from other recipients.
- CNP should not be referenced in the mailing or email without prior approval.

Book Sales and Signings

- CNP and CNP Action, Inc. speakers may arrange with the staff to host a book sale and signing.
- Book sales and signings during or after evening receptions and dinners are reserved for speakers addressing those events.




