Number of deployed traffic and or speed cameras currently in use, street or cross street locations if applicable

Number of red light , liscense plate readers or speed camera "citations or infractions" which may have been captured in error from January 1st, 2021- March 2022

Number of red light , liscense plate readers or speed camera "citations or infractions" objected or contested January 1st, 2021- March 2022
