He advised that he was presently receiving disability benefits from the Social Security Administration; however, he felt that he had been placed in peril by a Government appointed doctor who insists that he run on a treadmill, although this caused him to allegedly bleed internally. He felt this was a deliberate plot on the part of the Government to kill helpless people receiving disability benefits so the Government would not have to pay their pensions. He stated he had tried unsuccessfully to fight this matter in court and cited Civil action number plaintiff, versus MARGARET M. HECKLER, et al, defendent. The United States District

On November 8, 1985, AUSA referred a letter from the subject to USSS, WFO. The subject indicated in the letter that he had filed a complaint against President Reagan, House Speaker Tip O'Neill, Attorney General Edwin Meese and Secretary Margaret Heckler. The subject's complaint was the discontinuance of his social security disability payments.

In his letter the subject stated that "He Begged God To Make Him A Murderer So That He Could Murder Their Children Like They Tried To Murder Him". He continued that he would not sit by and let the President murder anyone else. The subject also indicated that he and his family would go to the Russian Embassy on November 11, 1985 to try and stop the President.

On November 8, 1985, the subject was interviewed by the USSS and stated that his only action would be through the courts.
