

**AFFIDAVIT**


JAYME L. BOWMAN, [REDACTED] STATES THE FOLLOWING:

- 1) I was a witness in the homicide investigation of Alex Schaffer, which occurred on October 26, 1996, in Kaukauna, Wisconsin.
- 2) After providing a statement to the Kaukauna Police Department on October 28, 1996, members of the Kaukauna Police Department obtained a room for me at the Settle Inn Hotel. I do not know the name of the person who secured the room, nor do I know who paid the bill when I left approximately two weeks later.
- 3) Upon leaving the Settle Inn Hotel, I moved to an apartment on Roeland Avenue in Appleton, Wisconsin. I believe that members of the Kaukauna Police Department paid a security deposit of approximately \$300 but I don't recall the exact amount, nor do I know the names of those officers.
- 4) After being fired from my job at Electronic Assembly because of the homicide investigation, unknown member(s) of the Kaukauna Police Department explained to management the case I was involved in. A day or two after being fired, I was contacted by management at Electronic Assembly and told to return to work.
- 5) I am submitting this affidavit by my own free will and have not received any type of compensation nor have I received any promise for compensation.


