07:52 B33 observes B30 on location with GBF148 roadside on Tunnel Mtn Rd on the Coastline Trail. B33 hazes the bear off the trail.

July 20 - 07:45 OR1358

07:45- B30 meets with B33 and will assume monitoring responsibilities. Grizzly #F148 located on east side of Tunnel Mtn. Road, approx. opposite G-Loop of Village I. As bear approaches road moving toward campground, hazed back east with siren (flees initially then walks).

08:20- #F148 crosses to campground side of the road, very close to perimeter of G-Loop. B30 hazes east with 3X squib/'blank' rounds from cracker pistol and 'hey bear' (flees). Continued monitoring with telemetry etc.

09:00- Bear appears at powerline on east side of Tunnel Mtn. Rd., foraging on grasses/sedges and some shepherdia bushes. Small jam (approx. 6 vehicles) managed/dispersed, and then bear hazed approx. 40m into cover with 1X squib/'blank' cracker pistol round and 'hey bear' (flees). Continued monitoring to prevent entrance to campground area and to manage further potential jams.

09:15- Continue hazing bear east when it approaches roadway moving toward campground (squib/'blank' rounds and 'hey bear'). Disperse another small jam (approx. 6 vehicles).

09:45- Bear crosses to west (campground) side of Tunnel Mtn. Road near the Peyto Pit corner. Village I campground staff notified and updated. Monitor signal and disperse bear jams (some large, approx. 20 vehicles) as #F148 travels north on west side of road.

10:45- B30 hazes bear NE from west side of Tunnel Mtn. Road near perimeter of G-Loop using 1 banger shell (flees). Continued monitoring of signal.

11:30- #F148 emerges high on grassy slope on west side of road at King George corner (approx. 50m from road). B30 monitors bear and manages traffic to prevent stopping on dangerous corner. Bear eventually moves into cover and telemetry signal indicates that she is travelling west toward Rocky Mtn. Resort, away from campground facilities etc.

13:00- Village I kiosk staff (Jeremy Greenberg) is informed/updated on situation, and asked to pass information along to campground supervisor. Signal for #F148 remains stationary in forest well north of campground.
