To respond to your public records request, we completed a search of the legislative email accounts of Sen. Winder and Sen. Lodge using the search terms specified on your Public Records Request Form. We also asked Sen. Winder and Sen. Lodge to provide our office with all responsive written records, emails from any other email account, and text and voice messages.

Attached please find records responsive to your request. Some records are not included in this response because they are exempt from public disclosure pursuant to Idaho Code Section 74-109(1). Personally identifying information relating to private citizens has been redacted, pursuant to Idaho Code 74-109(3).

To the extent this response is considered a denial or partial denial of a request for public records, you have the right to appeal such denial pursuant to Idaho Code section 74-115. Under that code section, you have 180 days from the date of denial to petition a district court for an order compelling the production of the public records to which you believe you have been denied access. Pursuant to Idaho Code section 74-103, an attorney has reviewed this public records request and response.

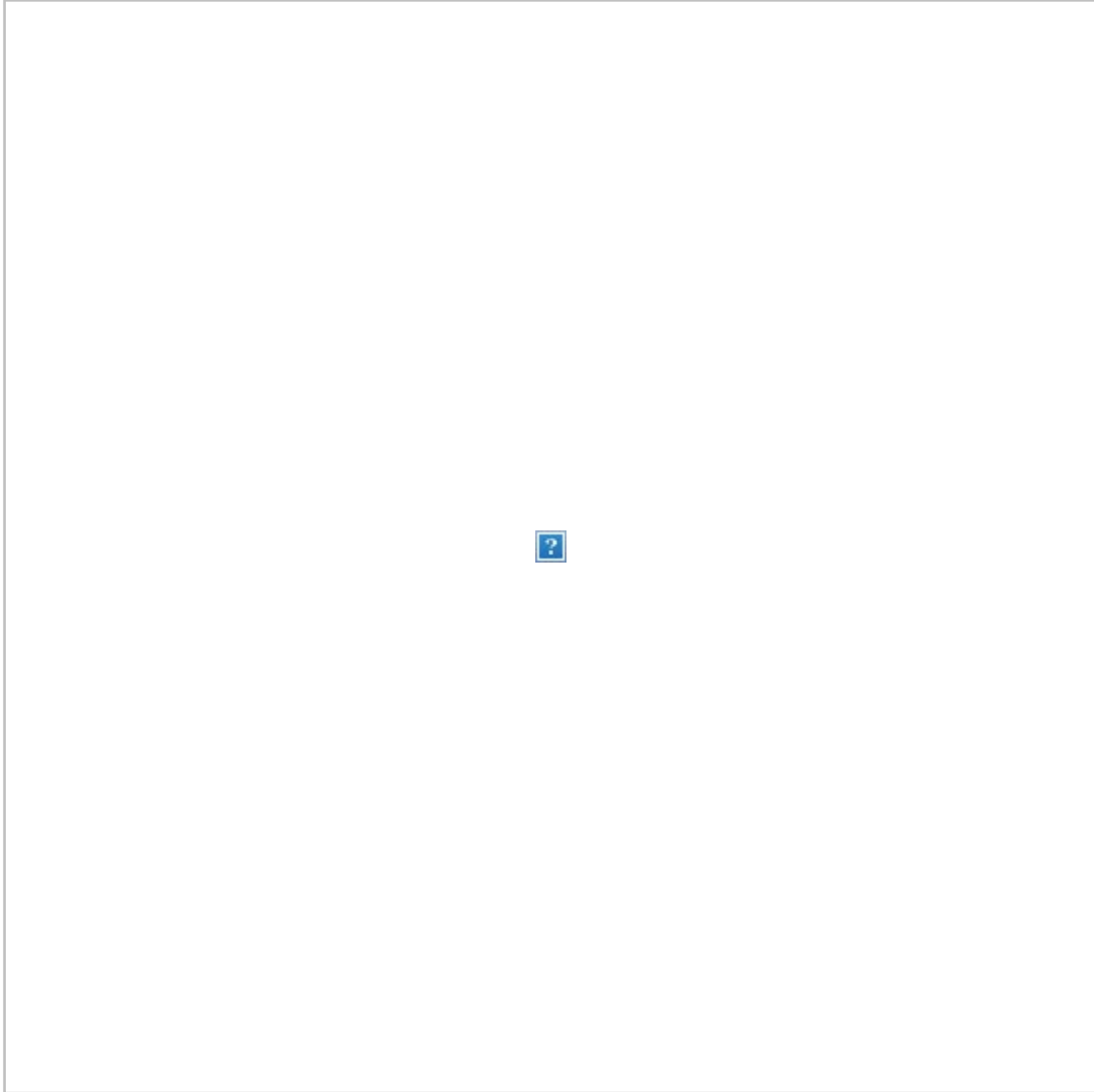

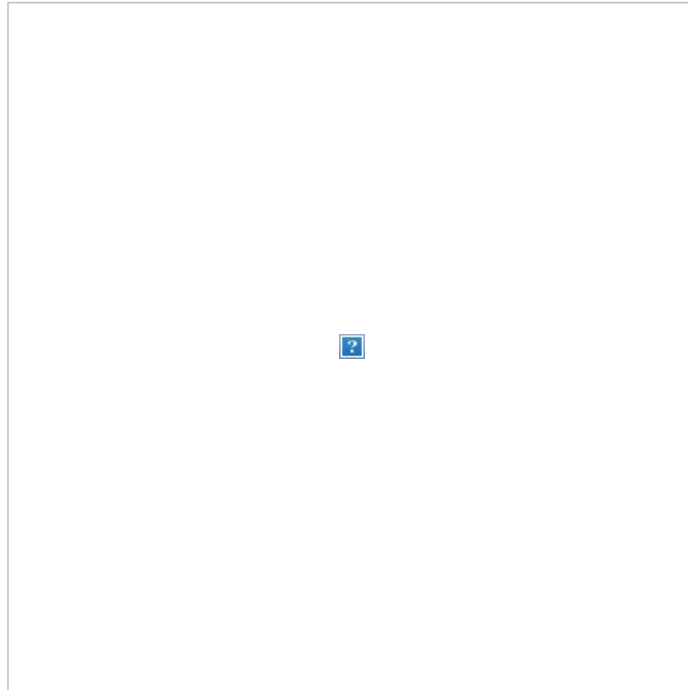

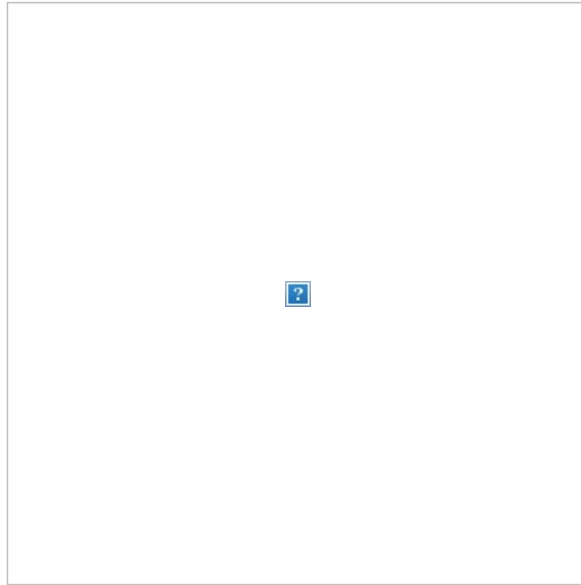

### **It's Time for National Repentance (Devotion)**

*"If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land" (2 Chronicles 7:14).*

Thomas Jefferson recognized that slavery, as it was practiced in the American South, posed an existential threat to the fledgling new nation for which he and so many others had sacrificed so much.

It wasn't just the regional divisions caused by slavery or the moral corruption that resulted from a class of aristocratic farmers becoming dependent on the labor of enslaved men. What he feared the most was the judgment of God.

In a popular book of his, Jefferson lamented over the existence of slavery in his home state: "Indeed I tremble for my country when I reflect that God is just; that his justice cannot sleep forever."

Jefferson would have been heartbroken, although unsurprised, when the United States of America

devolved into a civil war in the middle of the nineteenth century. As brother took up arms against brother in what would become the deadliest conflict in American history, Abraham Lincoln followed Jefferson in seeing God's providential hand in all of it:

“Fondly do we hope, fervently do we pray, that this mighty scourge of war may speedily pass away. Yet, if God wills that it continue until all the wealth piled by the bondsman's two hundred and fifty years of unrequited toil shall be sunk, and until every drop of blood drawn with the lash shall be paid by another drawn with the sword, as was said three thousand years ago, so still it must be said ‘the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether’ [Psalm 19:9].”

The Bible offers an unequivocally direct warning describing what happens to nations that depart from God: “The wicked will go down to the grave; this is the fate of all the nations who ignore God” (Psalm 9:17). This sanction applies to Christian nations especially, as we are told that “to whom much is given, much will be required” (Luke 12:48).

With this in mind, we need to make an honest assessment of the state of our nation today. To be sure, America historically was one of the leading Christian nations in the world. But in recent decades, we have progressively drifted from those firm foundations, deserting and rebelling against the triune God who has so long given us relative peace and prosperity.

What must we do? All of this should drive us to our knees, remembering the promise given in 2 Chronicles 7:14. God assures us that if we humble ourselves and repent of our national sins, then he will hear from heaven, forgive our sin, and heal our land.

Because of God's goodness and redemptive mercy, there is still hope for America. And that hope is found only in Jesus Christ.

**PRAYER.** Heavenly Father, please help this nation recognize the extent to which our corporate faithlessness has displeased you. As a Christian nation, we have dishonored your name. Yet even despite our failings, you have promised to forgive our sin and heal our land if only we come to you with repentant hearts. Forgive us for our transgressions against you, and may you once again be honored among us. In the name of Jesus we pray, amen.

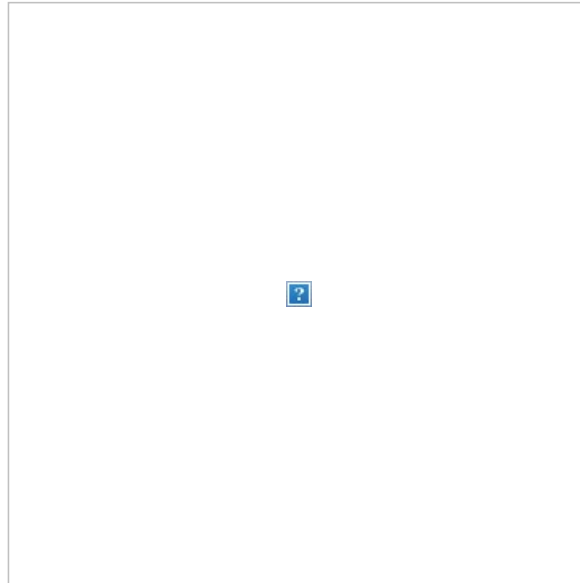

### **Assisted Suicide and Euthanasia**

*“Then he begged me, ‘Come over here and put me out of my misery, for I am in terrible pain and want to die.’ So I killed him, for I knew he couldn’t live” (2 Samuel 1:9-10, NLT).*

King Saul was experiencing intense agony. God had rejected him, promising to take his kingdom from him. To make matters worse, he was fatally wounded in a stunning battlefield defeat on the slopes of Mount Gilboa by an arrow sent flying from a Philistine archer.

Suffering from his wounds and fearing that he would be tortured by the Philistines, the disgraced king directed his armorbearer to end his life. But the young man was afraid and rightly refused to play any part in the king’s death.

Seeking to hasten his end, Saul took matters into his own hands. He attempted suicide by falling on his own spear. It was all in vain; his foolish and faithless suicide attempt only exacerbated his misery instead of ending it.

Even still, King Saul soon found his ticket to death. When an Amalekite man who was fighting for Israel as a sojourner stumbled upon the king, Saul begged the man to put him out of his misery. The man obliged.

But when David learned what the Amalekite man had done, he gave orders for the man to be executed. Then David told him, “You have condemned yourself, for you confessed that you killed the Lord’s anointed one.”

Notice that Saul was terminally injured. Recovery was hopeless. He was even insisting that others help him end his suffering. Yet David condemned the Amalekite man to death for murder.

As the Christian theologian and ethicist Wayne Grudem persuasively articulates, “If it is wrong to actively murder another person, then the fact that a person would choose to be murdered does not nullify this moral conclusion.” The sixth commandment does not say, “You shall not murder unless the person is suffering, or unless the person wants to die.” It says, and definitively so: “You shall not murder.”

The Bible teaches that actively causing death to a terminally ill person is still murder, even if that person is feeling unbearable pain and is begging for death. Therefore, euthanasia and physician-assisted suicide are unequivocally wrong, and should never be given the color of law.

A better course of action would be to alleviate pain while compassionately caring for the person’s physical, emotional, and spiritual needs. Thankfully, God in his providence has allowed for modern medical care, which often makes this possible.

Because mankind is created in the image of God, our lives are sacred and valuable. Ultimately, our lives belong to him. The Lord told Moses, “I am the one who kills and gives life; I am the one who wounds and heals” (Deuteronomy 32:39). He alone has written every day of our lives before even one of them came to be. May we trust him, even in the waning days of our lives.

**PRAYER.** Creator God, show us the value of human life and its beauty. We know that you want the aged, the sick, and the terminally ill to be treated with compassion and righteousness. May the Holy Spirit turn hearts and illuminate your truth so that unjust laws that permit murder, like euthanasia or physician-assisted suicide, will be repealed and life will be protected. In Jesus name, amen.

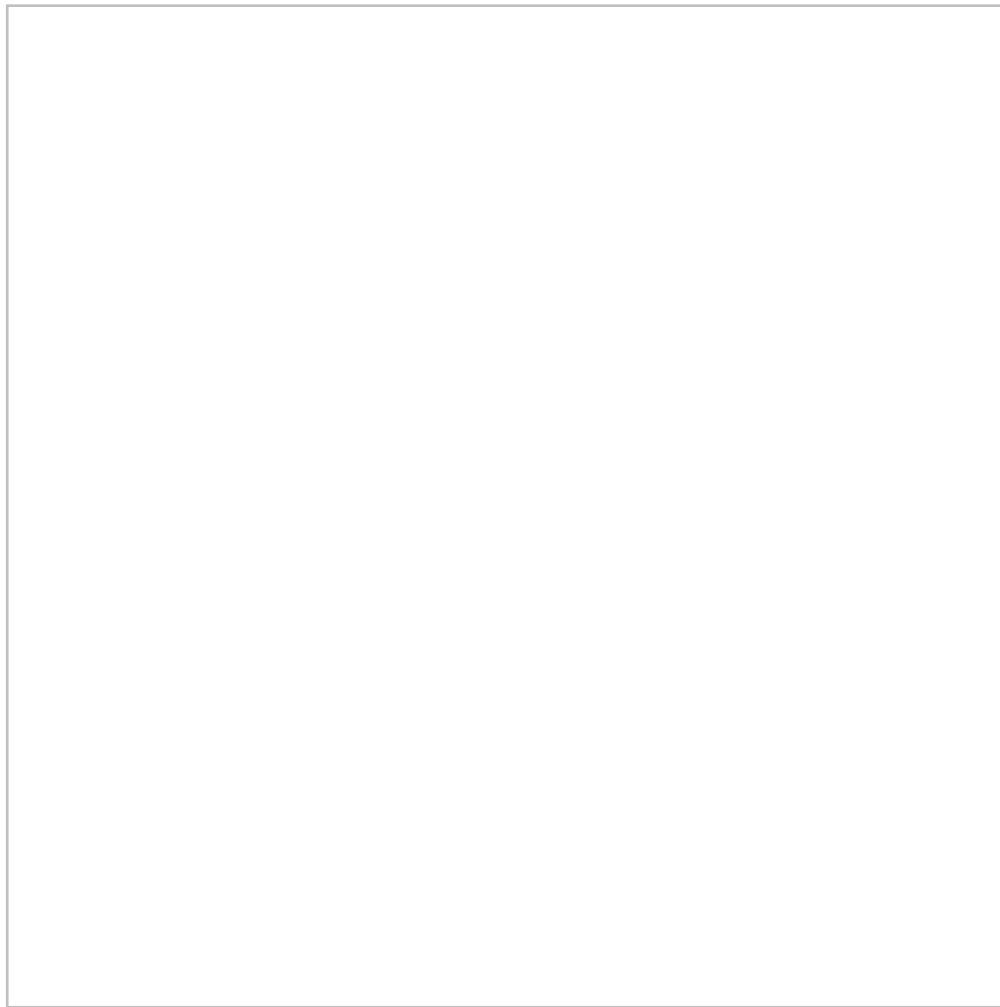

In his first Thanksgiving Proclamation, President George Washington unequivocally answered: “It is the duty of all nations to acknowledge the providence of Almighty God, to obey his will, to be grateful for his benefits, and humbly to implore his protection and favor.”

That, indeed, was the unanimous opinion of the founding fathers who appended their names to the Declaration of Independence exactly 245 years ago. **In fact, Independence Day in early America was celebrated as a day of national thanksgiving to God.**

Our founders attested to God’s intervention on our behalf during the War for Independence and His goodness in guiding them as they created a nation rooted in the idea of liberty under God’s law and built upon His unchanging Word. They believed the American people should come together to extend gratitude and worship to God for His protection, favor, and blessing.

Writing to his wife Abigail immediately after joining with his fellow delegates in voting for independence, John Adams presciently foresaw both the importance of the event in which he had just taken part and the traditions that would be celebrated by successive generations of Americans:

*“I am apt to believe that [Independence Day] will be celebrated, by succeeding generations, as the great anniversary festival. It ought to be commemorated as the Day of Deliverance by solemn acts of devotion to God Almighty. It ought to be solemnized with pomp and parade, with shows, games, sports, guns, bells, bonfires and illuminations [fireworks] from one end of this continent to the other from this time forward forever more.”*

Yes, John Adams predicted that Independence Day would be celebrated with fireworks, parades, sports, and guns! How’s that for a prediction come true?

But also notice that **John Adams says Independence Day ought to be celebrated by solemn**

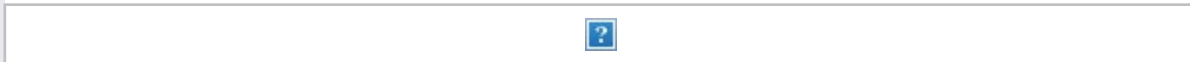
**acts of devotion to God Almighty.** God, who is the source of all blessings, deserves our worship and thanksgiving today. He has given us our liberty, and He has allowed us to live in a nation that has done better than any other in offering opportunity to all and empowering everyone to exercise their rights freely.

### **Governor Brad Little Signs Idaho Heartbeat Bill**

BOISE, Idaho – Family Policy Alliance of Idaho, a pro-family ministry, applauds Gov. Brad Little for signing the Heartbeat Bill (H366) just minutes ago. The bill passed both legislative chambers with veto-proof supermajorities earlier this month.

The Fetal Heartbeat Preborn Child Protection Act, which is sponsored by Senator Patti Anne Lodge (R-Caldwell) and Representative Steven Harris (R-Meridian), would protect the right to life of preborn children with a detectable heartbeat. Doctors can easily find a fetal heartbeat as early as six weeks of gestational age through commonly available medical technologies like ultrasonography.

The medical community has found that 95 percent of preborn children with a fetal heartbeat detected early in the pregnancy will survive to term. Obstetricians consider fetal heart activity to be an important milestone in prenatal development and routinely run tests to determine heart rate as an important indicator of a preborn child's health.

**A statement from Blaine Conzatti, Executive Director for Family Policy Alliance of Idaho:**

“Gov. Brad Little showed that Idaho recognizes the value of every preborn life when he signed the Heartbeat Bill this morning. We are proud that Idaho can be added to the list of pro-life states leading the charge in offering legal protection for our youngest and most defenseless residents. The action taken today by Gov. Brad Little will ultimately save thousands of precious lives.

“This Heartbeat Bill is constitutionally, scientifically, and morally sound. And thanks to modern medical technology, every new parent now knows the excitement of first hearing their son or daughter’s heartbeat during early prenatal check-ups. This explains why a reputable national poll found that nearly 70 percent of Americans – including 55 percent of Democrats – support this life-affirming legislation. Preborn babies with beating hearts deserve the same constitutional right to life accorded to any other living person.”

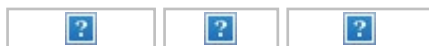

## Idaho Heartbeat Bill Passes House

Steven Harris Carries ID Heartbeat Bill



Friends,

Idaho is one step closer to legally protecting preborn babies with beating hearts! The Heartbeat Bill (H366), sponsored by Senator Patti Anne Lodge (R-Caldwell) and Representative Steven Harris (R-Meridian), passed the Idaho State House of Representatives last Friday with a veto-proof supermajority vote (53 for, 16 against, and 1 absent).

The floor debate lasted over one hour. Many pro-life legislators debated in favor of the bill. Below is a sampling of their comments:

**REP. STEVEN HARRIS (R-Meridian):** “We want to save baby lives. A preborn baby with a heartbeat has a 95% chance of reaching full-term. That sounds like viability... Let’s tell Idahoans that abortion stops a beating heart, something you can see and hear for yourself.”

**REP. BRENT CRANE (R-Nampa):** “You’re dead when you no longer have a heartbeat, so the inverse logic could apply that you are alive when a heartbeat [can be

detected].”

**REP. TAMMY NICHOLS (R-Nampa):** “I hope that in the future, we can bring forth even stronger legislation and try to save all babies, because I think all lives do matter. Although sometimes it is a sacrifice to bring them into this world, I can never say that I’ve met anyone who has regretted that choice. And so I’ll be supporting this piece of legislation.”

**REP. JULIANNE YOUNG (R-Blackfoot):** “We protect freedom when we protect the conditions that allow freedom to exist, and life is one of those conditions. I’m a mother. I have ten children. I know a little bit about what it is like to have a baby. I’ve felt [preborn] babies respond to light, to music, to touch, to my voice. There’s no doubt in my mind that they are individuals and intelligent. You can’t protect freedom without protecting life.”

**REP. JULIE YAMAMOTO (R-Nampa):** “When a mother and a father have the opportunity to actually hear the heartbeat of that child in the womb, the chances of them making a decision to let that pregnancy go to term are just better.”

**REP. KAREY HANKS (R-St. Anthony):** “We believe that life starts at conception. If this is a way we can save some of these beautiful little children, I’m all for that. This became more real for me when I read a story about a woman who had been a director at [Planned Parenthood]. She said that a lot of these young women feel very desperate and don’t know what to do. It’s so great that now we have places like Stanton Healthcare [and other pregnancy resources centers].”

**REP. RON NATE (R-Rexburg):** “[I support this bill] because we do need to protect all innocent human life... We have the responsibility to protect our little ones.”

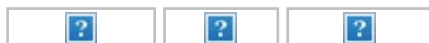

## Legislative Update -- Day 95

Conzatti Heartbeat Rally



Friends,

**Here's a quick update on where we are at this point in legislative session:**

1. The **Heartbeat Bill (H366)** is making its way through the state legislature. This legislation would protect a preborn child with a detectable heartbeat from abortion violence. It is sponsored by Rep. Steven Harris (R-Meridian) and Sen. Patti Anne Lodge (R-Caldwell).
2. The **No Public Funds For Abortion Act (H220)** would cut off taxpayer dollars to abortion providers and ban public schools, colleges, and universities from promoting or referring students for abortion services. The bill overwhelmingly passed the State House of Representatives and is waiting for a vote in the State Senate. It is sponsored by Rep. Bruce Skaug (R-Nampa) and Sen. Christy Zito (R-Hammett).
3. **House Joint Resolution 4 (HJR4)** is a proposed constitutional amendment that would raise the threshold that must be met before controlled substances like marijuana could be legalized in Idaho. It is sponsored by Rep. Gayann DeMordaunt (R-Meridian) and Sen. C. Scott Grow (R-Meridian). Family Policy Alliance of Idaho sent a letter to state legislators encouraging their

support (you can read it [here](#)).

We will keep you updated as these bills move through the legislative process. Please be praying that the legislature passes, and that the governor signs, these pieces of legislation. We expect session to continue for at least one more week.

### Heartbeat Bill Prayer Rally

Around 150 people joined Family Policy Alliance of Idaho on the Idaho State Capitol steps last week to offer praise and worship to our Lord and pray for the passage of the Idaho Heartbeat Bill.

The battle to end abortion in our state is a spiritual battle. For this reason it was a blessing to gather with other believers as we waged spiritual warfare with prayer and worship!

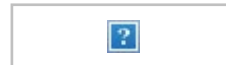

## The Great Mystery of Easter

He Is Risen



*“God was manifested in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen by angels, preached among the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up in glory.” (1 Timothy 3:16, NKJV)*

Friends,

As we approach the holiest day of the year, let us not forget the “Great Mystery” written about by the Apostle Paul in 1 Tim. 3:16:

1. Jesus Christ, fully God, took on human flesh and dwelt among us
2. He lived a sinless life, entirely fulfilling all the obligations of God’s law on behalf of those who would have faith in Him
3. After giving His life as a sacrifice for those deserving death because of their sins, Jesus conquered death and was resurrected bodily
4. He then appeared to hundreds of people before ascending into Heaven to sit at the right

hand of God the Father, where He awaits the full inauguration of His Kingdom

5. Many people, recognizing the impossibility of the resurrection apart from a divine miracle authenticating the identity of Christ as the Son of God, believed in Him as their Lord and Savior

For years I taught theology and apologetics at a Christian high school. Unbelieving students would sometimes tell me that Jesus was nothing more than a great moral teacher.

But here's the thing: good moral teachers don't rise from the dead after resting in the grave for three days. It is because of the resurrection that we know our faith is reasonable and set upon a firm foundation. As the Apostle Paul told the church at Corinth, "And if Christ has not been raised, then our preaching is in vain and your faith is in vain" (1 Cor. 5:14).

We worship a risen savior. When a group of women went to the tomb of Jesus only to find his body missing, two angels calmed their fears and told them:

"He is not here, but is risen! Remember how He spoke to you when He was still in Galilee, saying, The Son of Man must be delivered into the hands of sinful men, and be crucified, and the third day rise again.' And [the women] remembered His words" (Luke 24:6-8, NKJV).

Let us celebrate this good news — the good news that invigorates our hope and verifies our faith.

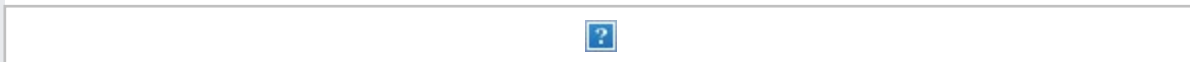

## Liberty Bell (Wednesday Devotion)

Liberty Bell



*“Proclaim liberty throughout the land to all its inhabitants” (Leviticus 25:10).*

The Liberty Bell is an enduring national symbol for the freedom we enjoy in this nation. Originally hung in the steeple of the Old Pennsylvania State House, it was used to commemorate important events and was rung to invite Philadelphians to gather around for important public meetings and announcements.

Embossed on the bell is a bible verse: “Proclaim liberty throughout all the land to the inhabitants thereof” (Leviticus 25:10). Early Pennsylvanians intended the inscription as a reminder that liberty comes from God. And if God gives us our rights, no government can ever take them away.

The message of freedom as a gift from God was especially appropriate for the occasion of July 8th, 1776, when the Liberty Bell famously tolled to announce the first public reading of the Declaration of Independence. Not coincidentally, our national birth certificate affirms that our

Creator has endowed all people with certain rights which every government must protect.

An exact replica of the Liberty Bell hangs just in front of the Idaho State Capitol steps. Visitors who read the informational plaque, which celebrates our founding principles, are offered the following invitation:

“In standing before this symbol, you have the opportunity to dedicate yourself, as did our founding fathers, to the principles of the individual freedom for which our Nation stands.”

The message of the Liberty Bell should inspire us to vigorously defend our freedom and preserve our birthright of liberty for future generations. May we be found faithful—by God’s grace.

*Heavenly Father, we give thanks to you for the freedoms you have given us—freedom from the bondage of sin, the freedom to live out our faith, the freedom to raise our families, and freedom from undue government influence in our lives. ## This Bill Would DESTROY Religious Freedom

Silence in the rainbow



Friends,

We recognize the existential threat for religious freedom posed by the **Equality Act** legislation that is making its way through the U.S. Congress.

That's why **Family Policy Alliance of Idaho** has joined other pro-family organizations – in expressing our concerns to U.S. Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer (D-NY) and Minority Leader Mitch McConnell (R-KY).

Representatives from nearly fifty national and state-based organizations including **Family Policy Alliance of Idaho**, Alliance Defending Freedom, Heritage Action, and the American Association of Christian Schools – signed on to the joint letter last week.



The letter affirms that “all people have inherent dignity and should be treated with respect” but explains how the Equality Act “creates greater inequality, hurting not only women, people of faith, religious organizations, employers, and medical professionals, but especially children and their parents.”

**What makes the Equality Act so dangerous? This radical legislation adds “sexual orientation” and “gender identity” as protected categories in civil rights law. This would mean:**

- Punishing **doctors, counselors, and therapists** who offer medically and biblically sound treatment to patients struggling with same-sex attraction or gender dysphoria
- Preventing **private Christian schools and universities** from enforcing sex-specific dress codes or employee and student honor codes that reflect biblical sexuality
- Eradicating **athletic opportunities for girls and women** by empowering men to play in girls’ high school and college sports
- Endangering church and parachurch ministries like **domestic violence shelters, gospel rescue missions, and pregnancy resource centers** with sex-specific facilities and programs
- Potentially requiring professional discipline for **public and private school teachers** who use scientifically correct pronouns for students struggling with gender dysphoria
- Fining and shutting down **Christian businesses** with sincerely held, conscientious objections to participating in same-sex wedding ceremonies—including **photographers, independent florists, mom-and-pop bakers, and family-owned wedding venues**

We cannot let the Equality Act decimate our religious freedom. It is vitally important that we defeat the Equality Act and strengthen religious freedom protections at both the state and federal level.

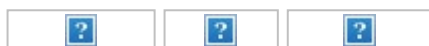

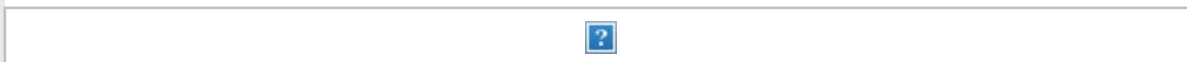

## The Cultural Commission (Thursday Devotion)

***“Go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age” (Matthew 28:19-20, NIV).***

Most Christians think of the Great Commission in terms of evangelism. These marching orders, given by Jesus to his disciples just before his ascension, provide the foundation for church missions and for sharing the “reason for our hope” with family, friends, and coworkers.

But one essential component of the Great Commission – *teaching the nations to obey everything Jesus has commanded* – is often overlooked and neglected by Christians today.

This mandate is called the **Cultural Commission** by theologians. Jesus Christ has been inaugurated as Lord over all things. He rightfully stakes claim over our families, churches,

businesses, schools, and even government—indeed, his lordship covers every part of human life and culture (Colossians 1:20).

It is our responsibility to bring everything under His authority and into accordance with His revealed will. In the earliest days of human history, God charged human beings to exercise dominion “over all the earth” (Genesis 1:26). This includes raising families and building civilization to the glory of God, carefully following the “instruction manual for life” given to us in the Bible.

Sin is destructive to the goals of the Cultural Commission. But one of the benefits of the new birth in Christ is our liberation from sin and our restoration to do what we were originally created to do. Our redemption empowers us to “knock down the strongholds of human reasoning and to destroy false arguments” as we “capture their rebellious thoughts and teach them to obey Christ” (1 Cor. 10:5, NLT).

Christianity is a total life system. The Bible has lots to say about every part of life, including civil government. The Cultural Commission provides a sacred mandate to apply these biblical principles to civil government, which we call “exercising biblical citizenship.” This entails being “salt” and “light,” contending for truth in the so-called culture wars and carrying out our responsibilities as citizens in our constitutional republic.

The Cultural Commission means Christians have no excuse for avoiding the mandate to engage culture. Throughout the centuries, faithful Christians have sought to obey and fulfill this cultural mandate. Our nation was founded by such people. We have inherited blessings that flow from the fruit of their efforts—just like our children will be blessed by our faithfulness, even to a thousand generations (Deut. 7:9).

**Prayer:**

*Lord, you have commanded us to impact our communities, our state, our nation, and our world with your truth. Help us to grow in our understanding of your lordship over all of life. Empower our efforts to renew our culture as we teach the nations to obey all you have commanded. Thank you for redeeming us in Christ and restoring us to our original purpose of exercising dominion under your lordship. In the precious name of Jesus Christ we pray. Amen.*

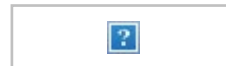

John the Baptist prepared the way for the public ministry of Jesus Christ, telling hardened Jews that they needed to “repent and believe, for the kingdom of God is at hand.”

The two men had known each other for decades. Their mothers, Elizabeth and Mary, were cousins.

After Mary was visited by the angel Gabriel and told that she would bear “the Son of God,” she set out to visit Elizabeth, who at the time was six months pregnant with John the Baptist:

“And when Elizabeth heard the greeting of Mary, the baby leaped in her womb. And Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit, and she exclaimed with a loud cry... ‘Behold, when the sound of your greeting came to my ears, the baby in my womb leaped with joy’” (Luke 1:41, 44).

What a beautiful picture of preborn life in the womb! The baby “leaps with joy” at the sound of Mary coming to visit, making clear that he is fully human. Amazingly, science reveals that developing babies feel pain in the womb, recognize the voice of their mother, and learn the

sounds of what will become their native language.

Even the Greek word that Elizabeth uses to describe her preborn baby (“brephos”) is the same word used for newborns and infants. It is worth noting that she used this word while under the influence of the Holy Spirit, offering divine revelation that the preborn child is considered equal with a newborn or infant.

Sadly, more than 62 million babies have been slaughtered in this nation since the *Roe v. Wade* decision in 1973, including upwards of 1,500 babies annually in Idaho. The testimony of the blood of the innocent cries from the ground. Let us recommit to the quest for justice for these precious babies.

*Heavenly Father, we praise you for your wonderful works. We know that you knit together life in the womb, creating unique and irreplaceable human beings from the moment of conception. 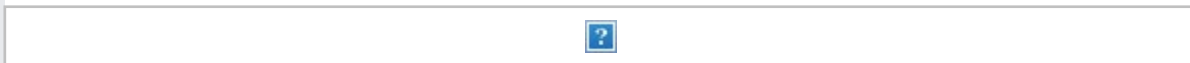

## Pro-Life Bill Clears Idaho House

It is the eighth week of legislative session, and things are really beginning to heat up. The legislature may stay late this year, possibly until mid-April even later (legislative session is usually adjourned the last week of March).

Here are a couple updates:

1. **The “No Public Funds For Abortion Act” cleared the State House of Representatives today.**

This legislation (HB 220) would prevent abortion providers from accessing state and local money. It would also make sure abortion is not promoted in our public schools, colleges, and universities.

The bill is sponsored by Rep. Bruce Skaug (R-Nampa), Rep. Brent Crane (R-Nampa), and Sen. Christy Zito (R-Hammett). It passed the House this morning and is now on its way to

the Senate.

Do you want to help get this bill across the finish line? **Please sign our petition right now to ask state lawmakers to protect our hard-earned tax dollars from organizations that provide or promote abortion!**

2. **The “Abortifacient and Contraceptive Mandate” was killed in the State Senate yesterday.**

This Planned Parenthood-supported legislation (SB 1089) was defeated on the Senate floor yesterday. It would have required insurance companies cover twelve-month prescriptions of contraception, and was sponsored by Sen. Melissa Wintrow (D-Boise).

A more radical version of the bill, which would have mandated coverage of abortifacients, was pulled earlier in the session after hundreds of you answered our “Action Alert” and contacted key senators. Abortifacients are drugs that can end a pregnancy after fertilization.

Even with the removal of abortifacient mandate from the bill, Family Policy Alliance of Idaho remained opposed to the legislation, voicing concerns about religious freedom and unnecessary regulation of private insurance companies. We are thankful that you exercised biblical citizenship, which proved instrumental in stopping this flawed legislation!

We will keep you updated as the legislative session keeps progressing!

## '40 Days For Life Meridian' Begins This Month!

*"So He said to them, 'This kind can come out by nothing but prayer and fasting'" (Mark 9:29, NKJV).*

Dear Friends,

40 Days for Life Meridian begins this month—and you have the opportunity to get involved as a pro-life prayer warrior!

The movement began in 2004 when concerned residents of Bryan, Texas, came together to pray and fast for an end to abortion after seeing an abortion clinic open in their community. Soon after, other communities began imitating the prayerful and peaceful approach modeled by those faithful witnesses standing for life outside the Bryan abortion clinic.

The first nationwide 40 Days for Life campaign began in 2007, and its annual campaigns have been remarkably successful. As a result of campaign efforts, over 18,000 women have decided not to get an abortion and more than 100 abortion centers have closed.

Nearly 200 abortion workers have quit their jobs, too—most notably, Abby Johnson, the director

of the Planned Parenthood clinic in Bryan, Texas, who now prays with other 40 DFL volunteers outside of the clinic she left. Abby Johnson is the subject of the blockbuster movie, **Unplanned**, which has touched the hearts of millions of Americans and changed the minds of untold numbers of people who were formerly pro-abortion.

Last year I spoke with Emily Naugle, who shares the coordinator role for the Meridian campaign with her husband, Scott. Emily recalled a heartwarming encounter she had a few years back while participating in the 40 DFL vigil outside the Meridian Planned Parenthood clinic.

As Emily tells it, a woman driving down the adjacent road pulled over and approached Emily. The woman shared that when she was in high school, she had made an appointment to receive an abortion at a Planned Parenthood clinic in California. She arrived at the clinic, only to see 40 DFL volunteers praying outside. The woman couldn't bring herself to go ahead with procedure. Now, years later, she was showing pictures of her six-year-old son to Emily—a reminder that all the praying and fasting was not in vain.

### **How Can I Get Involved?**

**Participate in the prayer vigil.** The 40-day prayer vigil runs from February 17th through March 28th on the public right-of-way outside the Planned Parenthood clinic on Franklin Road in Meridian. Sign up for hour-long shifts (between 7am and 7pm) on the **40 DFL Meridian page**.

The 40 DFL Meridian coordinators are praying for full coverage during all hours this campaign, so please consider participating! For those who haven't done something like this in past, feel free to contact the campaign coordinators. They can set you up with experienced prayer warriors if schedules allow.

**Pray and fast wherever you are.** For those unable to attend the prayer vigil, don't worry—your prayers and fasting will be used of God wherever you are! 40 DFL publishes **daily devotionals** to help guide your prayer time. And consider committing to some type of fast during the duration of the campaign. "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much" (James 5:17).

### **Governor Brad Little Signs Idaho Heartbeat Bill**

BOISE, Idaho – Family Policy Alliance of Idaho, a pro-family ministry, applauds Gov. Brad Little for signing the Heartbeat Bill (H366) just minutes ago. The bill passed both legislative chambers with veto-proof supermajorities earlier this month.

The Fetal Heartbeat Preborn Child Protection Act, which is sponsored by Senator Patti Anne Lodge (R-Caldwell) and Representative Steven Harris (R-Meridian), would protect the right to life of preborn children with a detectable heartbeat. Doctors can easily find a fetal heartbeat as early as six weeks of gestational age through commonly available medical technologies like ultrasonography.

The medical community has found that 95 percent of preborn children with a fetal heartbeat detected early in the pregnancy will survive to term. Obstetricians consider fetal heart activity to be an important milestone in prenatal development and routinely run tests to determine heart rate as an important indicator of a preborn child's health.

**A statement from Blaine Conzatti, Executive Director for Family Policy Alliance of Idaho:**

“Gov. Brad Little showed that Idaho recognizes the value of every preborn life when he signed the Heartbeat Bill this morning. We are proud that Idaho can be added to the list of pro-life states leading the charge in offering legal protection for our youngest and most defenseless residents. The action taken today by Gov. Brad Little will ultimately save thousands of precious lives.

“This Heartbeat Bill is constitutionally, scientifically, and morally sound. And thanks to modern medical technology, every new parent now knows the excitement of first hearing their son or daughter’s heartbeat during early prenatal check-ups. This explains why a reputable national poll found that nearly 70 percent of Americans – including 55 percent of Democrats – support this life-affirming legislation. Preborn babies with beating hearts deserve the same constitutional right to life accorded to any other living person.”

## Idaho Heartbeat Bill Passes House

Steven Harris Carries ID Heartbeat Bill



Friends,

Idaho is one step closer to legally protecting preborn babies with beating hearts! The Heartbeat Bill (H366), sponsored by Senator Patti Anne Lodge (R-Caldwell) and Representative Steven Harris (R-Meridian), passed the Idaho State House of Representatives last Friday with a veto-proof supermajority vote (53 for, 16 against, and 1 absent).

The floor debate lasted over one hour. Many pro-life legislators debated in favor of the bill. Below is a sampling of their comments:

**REP. STEVEN HARRIS (R-Meridian):** “We want to save baby lives. A preborn baby with a heartbeat has a 95% chance of reaching full-term. That sounds like viability... Let’s tell Idahoans that abortion stops a beating heart, something you can see and hear for yourself.”

**REP. BRENT CRANE (R-Nampa):** “You’re dead when you no longer have a heartbeat, so the inverse logic could apply that you are alive when a heartbeat [can be

detected].”

**REP. TAMMY NICHOLS (R-Nampa):** “I hope that in the future, we can bring forth even stronger legislation and try to save all babies, because I think all lives do matter. Although sometimes it is a sacrifice to bring them into this world, I can never say that I’ve met anyone who has regretted that choice. And so I’ll be supporting this piece of legislation.”

**REP. JULIANNE YOUNG (R-Blackfoot):** “We protect freedom when we protect the conditions that allow freedom to exist, and life is one of those conditions. I’m a mother. I have ten children. I know a little bit about what it is like to have a baby. I’ve felt [preborn] babies respond to light, to music, to touch, to my voice. There’s no doubt in my mind that they are individuals and intelligent. You can’t protect freedom without protecting life.”

**REP. JULIE YAMAMOTO (R-Nampa):** “When a mother and a father have the opportunity to actually hear the heartbeat of that child in the womb, the chances of them making a decision to let that pregnancy go to term are just better.”

**REP. KAREY HANKS (R-St. Anthony):** “We believe that life starts at conception. If this is a way we can save some of these beautiful little children, I’m all for that. This became more real for me when I read a story about a woman who had been a director at [Planned Parenthood]. She said that a lot of these young women feel very desperate and don’t know what to do. It’s so great that now we have places like Stanton Healthcare [and other pregnancy resources centers].”

**REP. RON NATE (R-Rexburg):** “[I support this bill] because we do need to protect all innocent human life... We have the responsibility to protect our little ones.”

As the Biden era began yesterday, I was reminded of an old football maxim: "The quarterback gets too much credit and too much blame." He's the focal point, yes, but the outcome is determined by the whole team.

There's a related maxim in politics – one that was drilled into my head as a 20-something working in D.C.: "Personnel is policy." Who we elect is critical, but who that leader puts in positions of power makes an enormous difference in the outcome.

So as we heard President Biden give a speech that focused on unity – a welcome theme after all the anger and turmoil – the natural reaction was to wonder how long that refrain will last. A big hint came in the afternoon with his one-sided executive orders.

**But the best clues as to how this new administration will play out are his picks for the Cabinet. And when it comes to the issues of life and religious freedom, all eyes first go to Health and Human Services (HHS).**

HHS is a sprawling bureaucracy that now has the largest budget of any federal agency, and its jurisdiction covers many of the issues that Family Policy Alliance is most engaged in. During the Trump Administration, it was led by an extraordinary number of outstanding leaders who were committed to life, religious liberty and the centrality of the family.

But it appears that Joe Biden intends for HHS to do an abrupt U-turn, based on his choice of California Attorney General Xavier Becerra to lead it.

Before he was AG of California, Becerra served in the U.S. House for 24 years. His record was staunchly pro-abortion, earning him a 100 percent rating from Planned Parenthood. He opposed all protections for the preborn, even up to the moment of birth. **Even the liberal *Vanity Fair* magazine described him as a “strident supporter” of abortion rights.**

Likewise, in his more than two decades in Congress, he got 100 percent marks from the leading LGBT lobbying group and from the anti-religious freedom ACLU.

Four years ago, he was chosen by Gov. Jerry Brown to succeed Kamala Harris as California Attorney General. In that powerful post, his extreme ideology ran rampant.

**And he sued the Little Sisters of the Poor** to force them to pay for services that directly violate their religious convictions. Now, he is litigating to remove their religious exemption in the state of California.

This nominee has no medical background. His passion and his experience are in the area of imposing his progressive social agenda, and he has been handpicked for the very agency that touches these issues the most.

We need more unity in America, to be sure. But nominations like this will not, and must not, bring unity.

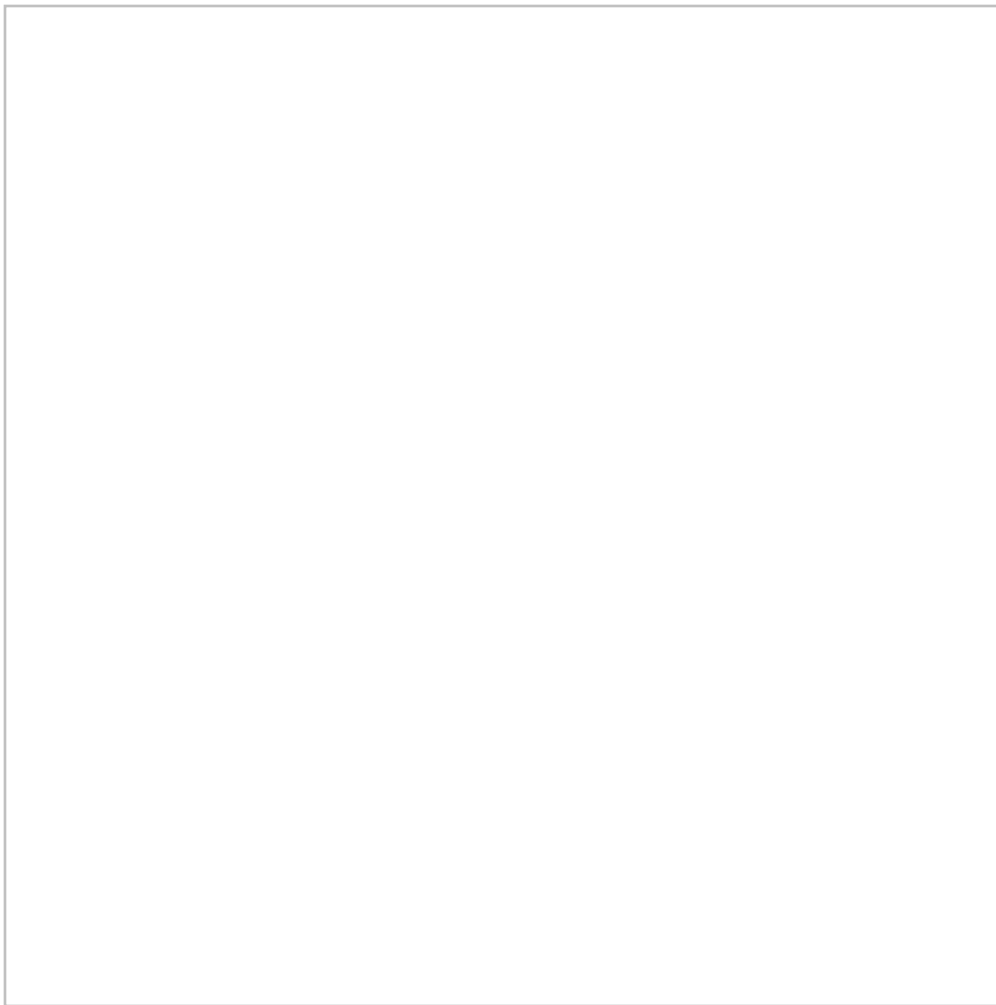

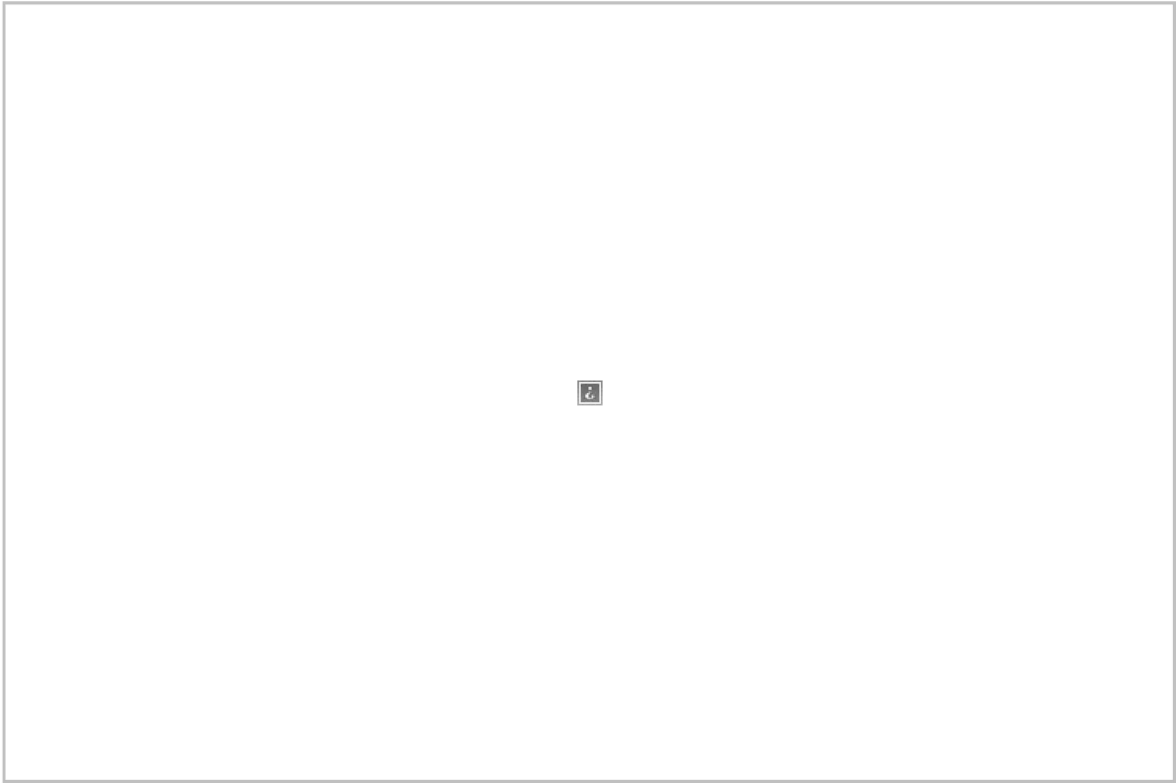

Dear Senator Lodge,

Thank you for your opposition to murder by abortion.

As you know, senate bill 1085 is presently on the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading calendar in the senate and will be before you to debate and vote on shortly. I am 100% against abortion, am good friends with Blaine Conzatti and consider abortion murder in every case, but if I were a senator, I would oppose the heartbeat abortion ban S1085. Here is why:

3) On page 3, lines 13-17, if an abortion is done after a heartbeat is detected, the abortion is not even a crime in this bill. In 2012, Jeremy Swanson killed his pregnant wife in my county and was sentenced to two life terms at IDOC, including a life sentence for killing his preborn child. How can it not even be any crime in S1085 to kill a child if it is “banned”? What about equity in law?

2) EVEN IF a heartbeat is detected when the fetal heartbeat ban is in effect, some children may still be killed as permitted by S1085. Page 2, lines 46-47, rape and incest conceived children may be put to death for the crimes of their fathers. If life is an unalienable right in Article I of the Idaho Constitution (section 1), why can it be alienated from the rape and incest conceived child? Isn't it immoral to allow the killing of some children because their fathers were criminals?

1) S1085 is a trigger bill like a similar pro-life law from last year (Pg. 3, lines 18-23). It will only go into effect IF any United States appellate court upholds any state's heartbeat abortion ban. So far, the 5<sup>th</sup> and the 8<sup>th</sup> Circuit Courts of Appeal have rejected heartbeat abortion bans based on the false opinion of the Supreme Court in their 38 decisions over 48 years that mothers have a 5<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> amendment right to kill their preborn children. But, where does SCOTUS even get supremacy over the question of murder in the states? Is control over the

outlaw of murder an enumerated power of the federal government, or is the right to outlaw all murder a right possessed only by the states?

Idaho's abortion numbers are at a 10 year high (29 are killed in the state every week!). 31 years ago, the Idaho legislature passed a near total ban on abortion with criminal penalties, except they too allowed exceptions for rape and incest, and they too would have allowed the federal courts to strike down their law (Cecil Andrus vetoed that bill in 1990).

Here we are 31 years and dozens and dozens of Idaho pro-life abortion regulations later, and we are still having the same rudimentary debate, and 1,513 children are still being killed in Idaho every year.

Isn't it time we abandon the traditional pro-life abortion regulation that appeases the courts, reject the long train of usurpations by SCOTUS and instead oppose the federal courts on this question through the exercise of constitutional state authority over murder?

This year's H056 in the House is the type of bill we ought to debate, and we ought to get off the 48 year treadmill of pro-life abortion regulation bills that are not solving the problem for the dead children.

Hello. I hope this finds you well.

I would like to share a story with you. My story. My baby's story. Please read in it's entirety, and work with, and talk to our Idaho Law Makers about the reality of Senate Bill 1085, and how it will affect the lives of Idahoans.

.....

I was born and raised in Idaho, and eventually was married in 2016 to an amazing man. In 2018 we welcomed our first child into this world. My pregnancy was perfect; textbook if you will. My water broke spontaneously at 35 weeks gestation, and at that moment, I knew I would not be coming home again without a baby. It was scary, and nothing we had planned for. We were lucky, with only a 24 hour NICU stay. But it certainly did open our eyes and thrust us into a world of knowledge and understanding we never would have known, otherwise.

When our son was turning one, we were talking about trying for our second. We knew we wanted 2 children together. But thinking about the idea of having another pre-term baby was terrifying. While we were lucky, I still faced, and was dealing with the trauma of having a pre-term, NICU baby, and all the grief that comes with losing the delivery story I had imagined. We

decided to wait.

In January of 2020 we decided we were finally ready to try again, knowing there was an increased risk of pre-term labor. We stopped our birth control methods and began trying for our baby. We conceived in early March, and somehow I just knew it had happened. I was ecstatic, and couldn't wait to get my first positive pregnancy test. I knew we were pregnant! Four weeks later, we got our positive test, and called to make our first OB appointment. I felt amazing. I was so excited to bring another baby into our family. This baby that we wanted, that we planned for.

We had our first ultrasound at 9.5 weeks gestation. I couldn't wait to see our little nugget. I was beaming. We took our 2 year old with us to see his sibling. The ultrasound tech took a couple images and measurements. I didn't actually pick up on how quiet she was, at first; I was so excited to see our baby. She walked out of the room after what I did notice, was a short period of time. She was gone for a bit, and when she came back, all she said to us was that we were going to go chat with the doctor, and she handed us a few of the ultrasound images. Odd. But I was still oblivious to what we were about to be faced with.

When the doctor came into the room, she smiled, and told us she had good news, and bad news. Our baby had a strong and healthy heartbeat, and was measuring at 9.5 weeks gestation. The bad news was that there was a large sack of fluid trapped under the baby's skin; it stretched from the top of baby's head, down to the baby's rump. The suspected diagnosis at that time was Hydrops Fetalis.

I hope that you and your family are unfamiliar with this diagnosis. If you are familiar, unfortunately you know all too well what I am about to tell you.

Hydrops Fetalis is a condition in which there is a fluid build up around the baby's organs and tissues. It causes extreme swelling in the baby's body. The number of babies who survive until birth, if diagnosed in utero, is only about 20%. It occurs in 1 out of 1000 births. Survival after birth is about a 50% chance, and the chances of that baby living more than a few weeks to years after that are about 5%. We understood that the earlier in pregnancy that it is detected, the lower the chances of survival.

We were encouraged to make an appointment with a specialized clinic for a more thorough ultrasound and better answers.

Two weeks later, I went to the second ultrasound. Alone. Because of Covid

protocols. There, the diagnosis was changed from Hydrops, to Cystic Hygroma, which cut all of our odds in half. There was a 90% chance that our baby would die before birth, a 5% change that our baby would live to birth, a 50% change that the baby would die within hours or days after birth, and less than 2% chance that our baby would not be in pain and agony for their entire life, whether that be hours, weeks, months, or years.

I never, in my life, had ever thought I would be in a situation like this. I never wanted to be confronted with the possibility of having to make a decision like the one we were now faced with. We could wait for our baby to die a slow and painful death, or we could choose to end the pregnancy, saving our unborn child from the pain and agony they would suffer, and saving our family from the mental anguish and trauma. Maybe.

I prayed. And prayed. And prayed to God for guidance. As we looked at the science and evidence in front of us, and as I prayed for resolution, it became clear to us that the right thing to do, the loving and humane, and kind thing to do, for EVERYONE involved in and affected by this, was to terminate the pregnancy. This decision will certainly, and forever be one of the hardest decisions my husband and I will ever have had to make.

I can tell you, from experience, that this is a decision no mother (or father) ever wants to have to make, and never, would she make it lightly.

I grieve for my baby every day. As I sit writing this letter to you, I cry for the baby we wanted and planned for, but never got to hold. I would have been holding my 3-month-old baby today, had it not been for this unfortunate and heartbreaking experience.

But I am also very thankful that I had the opportunity to make the choice we did. Had we not had that opportunity, I would have had to sit and wait, knowing my baby was dying inside of me, waiting to miscarry, maybe, or waiting until the point where I had to deliver my dead baby.

Now, imagine your own family in this difficult position. Whether you would make the same choice we did, or not, is actually irrelevant. What matters, is that you have a choice.

Please consider my story, and so many other stories like mine, some far worse and more devastating, as you consider this "Heartbeat Bill." Please vote no on Senate Bill 1085.

Senator Lodge,

Today a "heartbeat" abortion ban was introduced to the Idaho senate. I am no fan of abortion, because it is indeed taking a human life, but I find this proposal to be unethical.

Assuming the AP has the details correct, this bill would have this effect: "If fetal heartbeats are detected, abortions would be prohibited unless a woman's life is in danger or if the pregnancy is due to rape or incest."

I see several problems with this proposal, but the primary problem is that this proposal leaves zero room for judgement calls. I present some situations that this proposal does NOT address:

1. Suppose a 12 year-old girl has sex with her 14 year-old boyfriend and the contact does not qualify as "rape" under Idaho law (<https://legislature.idaho.gov/statutesrules/idstat/Title18/T18CH61/SECT18-6101/>). The proposed ban would force her to carry the child to term regardless of her financial or emotional fitness and without concern for the impact this could have on her or her unborn child emotionally, mentally, financially, or socially.
2. Suppose a fetal examination shows severe developmental problems that

will cause the child to die very shortly after (or even during) birth. This ban would force the mother to continue the pregnancy (possibly for months) with the knowledge that her child will die (and likely suffer). My wife has struggled with difficult pregnancies, a still-birth, and the emotional challenges from those events. I shudder to think how forcing her to carry a doomed child to term against her will would psychologically harm her.

These scenarios may be rare (I pray that they are extremely rare), but even rare events do happen, which means this law will have victims if it is passed. I'm disappointed that the Idaho Senate did not learn from the legal challenges to similar bans in other states and at least include more exceptions.

Please consider some other means of achieving the worthy goal of reducing abortions. Some examples would be:

1. Simply require a doctor to certify that an abortion is "medically necessary" before prescribing the procedure. This allows competent medical professionals to evaluate each situation and make a judgement call. (Abuses of this system would of course be handled like any other type of malpractice.)
2. Begin and maintain an aggressive campaign of effective teen sex education and make effective contraceptives widely available, even to those with no health insurance. Preventing contraception prevents abortion. I recognize that this option is not popular in Idaho (I have reservations as well), but an effective sex education program can teach teens to be safe sexually AND emotionally (like not having sex outside of committed, long-term relationships).

If the Idaho Senate moves forward with this ill-advised abortion ban, I hope they are prepared to improve the mental health infrastructure in our state to help the victims that this ban WILL have.

2. Heartbeat is not when life begins.
3. Waiting for the courts to give Idaho permission to protect Idahoans is tragic.
4. Another 200+ babies in the womb will be aborted this year in my city and I need the legislature to act with compassion for all of these children.
