Updates and Response

SFDPH

Summary of actions

- SFDPH engaged with SF Unified School District (SFUSD) recently to discuss COVID-19 in school settings and to start development of a FAQ sheet for SFUSD
- Community outreach and relationship building is occurring with SFUSD and the NICOS Chinese Health Coalition
- SFDPH continues to monitor return travelers from China, with a goal of contact within 72 hours. DPH is working to identify challenges and collaborating with partner agencies to remove barriers
- DPH is focusing in on 2 major areas of work: community outreach and preparation of appropriate housing for a variety of PUI patients (i.e. high risk vs. medium risk PUI cases)
- DPH Medical/Health trained staff are conducting site visits to major SF hospitals (Kaiser, CPMC, ZSFG) to assess preparedness for potential COVID-19 patients and provide recommendations and support through collaboration
- Department leadership are strategizing around PUI/return traveler access to N95 masks, to ensure equity to all
- DPH DOC is preparing to rotate in new DOC staff and leadership, including new Incident Commander (IC) Dr. Naveena Bobba. Current IC (Tomas Aragon) will continue his involvement in the activation as Health Officer
- DPH plans to distribute CDC guidance on the re-use of N95 respirators to SF healthcare facilities and hospitals this week
- SFDPH is prepared to start COVID-19 testing, in line with CDC testing guidelines. Awaiting CDC approval to move forward <https://www.sfdcp.org/infectious-diseases-a-to-z/coronavirus-2019-novel-%20-%20coronavirus/>

CDC-

- Under the Health and Human Services (HHS) Public Health Emergency, enhanced screening continues at 11 designated airports. CDC reports it has conducted 32,434 screenings at these airports as of 2/10/20
- CDC released their guidance for EMS providers and re: re-use of N95 respirators

Summary of actions

- DPH is tracking and following up with return travelers from China by phone and/or community outreach if needed. Children under 19 years of age (and their respective family members) and other populations who frequent congregate spaces are being prioritized for follow up.
- DPH and Department of Emergency Management (DEM) are working to address growing staffing needs for clinical consultation and non-clinical inquiries from the public.
- DPH is creating a DOC "Community Branch" to expand community presence, messaging, and outreach to SF residents and the Chinese community.
- DPH DOC Supply Unit is working with community agencies to access a cache of isolation (mask) respirators for use in hospitals.

Summary of actions

- DPH collaborated with other Bay Area counties to finalize a policy in regards to SF residents who returned from travel to China before 02/03/20 (before Federal Quarantine Orders were issued). <https://www.sfcdcp.org/wp-content/uploads/2020/02/Interim-Guidance-on-Monitoring-and-Movement-for-San-Franciscans-and-Travel-Before-Feb-3rd-SFDPH-FINAL-02.07.2020.pdf>
- A comprehensive and extensive plan has been developed with multiple DPH and CCSF inter-agency partners to provide guidance, consultation, and instruction to healthcare providers, hospitals, outpatient healthcare facilities, and field teams to prepare them for potential nCoV patients, as DPH starts follow up with returned travelers from mainland China.
- DPH OSH developed guidance for clinics regarding environmental and infection control requirements and requirements to wear N95 respirators. Available soon.
- DPH working to expand staffing of the DOC, requiring collaboration and coordination across CCSF agencies.
- DPH Public Health Labs received the 2019-nCoV test reagents from the CDC on Friday 02/07/20 and have been working throughout the weekend to make testing possible within SF.
- Approximately 15 SF clinic staff members have been trained to perform respirator fit tests, resulting in approximately 50 staff members being fitted.

- WHO reported- On 02/09/20 a Japanese cruise ship was harboured in Yokohama, Japan for a 14-day quarantine period following confirmation of a case of 2019-nCoV. 64 individuals on board were found to have been infected with 2019-nCoV. All individuals testing positive were disembarked and admitted for medical care in infectious disease hospitals in the Yokohama area. Close contacts of the infected passengers are asked to remain in quarantine for 14 days from last contact with a confirmed case. Thus, the quarantine period will be extended beyond the 19 February as appropriate only for close contacts of newly confirmed cases. Epidemiological and environmental investigations are ongoing.

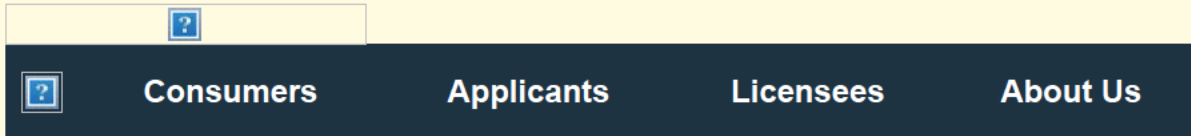


The California Department of Public Health announced today that 16 laboratories, including the state's Viral and Rickettsial Disease Laboratory in Richmond, California, will soon be able to perform testing for the novel coronavirus. This service will provide more rapid results than currently available and help to inform public health action and medical care for people who may have been exposed to novel coronavirus. Results from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention currently take between two to seven days. The Public Health Department lab anticipates it will be able to conduct testing beginning Wednesday, February 12, and report results within two days of specimen receipt. Meanwhile, our local partners are also expected to be able to conduct tests within a couple of weeks.

CDPH Provides Health Update and Interim Guidance for Health Care Providers Regarding 2019 Novel Coronavirus (nCoV)

The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) has issued a health update on the coronavirus situation in California and has provided infection control guidance, criteria for evaluation of Patients Under Investigation (PUIs), and recommendations for reporting, specimen collection, and testing. It is likely that the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) will update its guidance in the coming weeks, so please check for updates on [CDC's 2019-nCoV webpage](#).

To date, CDPH has identified two cases of coronavirus in Orange and Los Angeles counties. Testing was requested on 23 potential cases in California and 10 have been ruled out, with the 13 remaining cases pending results. CDPH asserts that the coronavirus situation is rapidly changing, and efforts to screen travelers who arrive in California from Wuhan, China, which is said to be the source of the coronavirus outbreak, are underway. CDPH requests California health facilities to [voluntarily complete a state-wide infection control resource assessment](#) for coordinated emergency response planning. CDPH has also [provided materials for facilities to prepare for the 2019 Novel Coronavirus \(2019-nCoV\)](#)

Summary of actions

- Drs. Grant Colfax, Tomas Aragon, and Sunny Pak will be attending the Chinese New Year Parade Public Safety Press Conference.
- DPH and multiple CCSF agencies are developing an advanced planning strategy to meet the expanding need for resources and support in the nCoV-2019 response.
- DPH is working to provide additional education to CCSF staff, hospital visitors, and patients to address concerns of nCoV-2019 infection in health care settings.
- DPH is working closely with SF Urgent Care and outpatient facilities to mitigate potential medical surge to hospitals.
- DPH Epidemiologists are leading efforts to systematically track and monitor PUIs.
- DOC Supply Unit is working to address shortage of N95 and surgical masks. An emergency cache of masks has been accessed to support normal

operations. Supply Unit is reaching out to the Office of Contracts Administration (OCA) for their support.

- DPH is not recommending that CCSF staff wear additional Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) outside of their normal job requirements. Guidance on proper method to request and receive PPE is being developed and will be communicated to health care facilities.
- EMS actively working on transport procedures for inner city transfers of confirmed or suspected cases, as designated Infection Control Ambulances are in short supply in the region.
- CCSF Department of Human Resources (DHR) will send out guidance for CCSF employees who are returning from travel to mainland China within the last 14 days.
- DPH recommendation for travelers returning from mainland China 1-14 days before the Federal Quarantine Orders were announced on 02/03/20: if you feel sick with fever, cough, or shortness of breath, seek medical care right away. Before you go to a doctor's office, clinic, or emergency room, call ahead and tell them about your recent travel and your symptoms so that they can prepare for your visit (see link below)-

Summary of actions

- Chinese community stakeholder “round table” on 02/04/20 (hosted by the Mayor’s Office, DEM, and DPH) was a great success! CCSF plans to continue robust outreach to the Chinese community to ensure up-to-date public information is accessible.
- CCSF is not recommending the need for Chinese community or cultural events to be cancelled as SF remains at low risk for nCoV-2019 transmission in the community.
- DEM/DPH/HRC have developed anti-discrimination messaging and are working with the Mayor’s Office to plan for dissemination.
- DPH developing protocols for operationalizing traveler quarantine orders in SF, to promote safety and in anticipation of growing needs for travelers returning from China and in need of evaluation, including travelers returning from China pre-Federal Quarantine orders (before 02/03/20).
- SF and regional partners identified the need for ongoing Federal support in execution of quarantine orders, as collaboration and coordination across larger regions may be required.
- SF and regional acute care hospitals have identified a critical resource gap for accessing N95 and surgical masks. DPH Supply Unit is actively working on this issue and will provide updates.
- CCSF Laboratories ordered nCoV-2019 testing supplies and instruction kits to enable 7-day a week testing on site. Turn around time for test results will drastically reduce to same day or (maximum) 2 days wait time! Lab is fully staffed, available off hours, and have equipment and supplies to run multiple tests, multiple times a day.
- DPH revisiting protocols for field responders around Corona viruses vs. Novel Corona viruses and providing education and support where needed.
- DEM and DPH are working together to streamline communications and notifications, by identifying a “Health Liaison” to work with the EOC.
