PURPLE VRI

How it Works







Sign language interpreter voices conversation of the deaf/hard-of-hearing person via PC or tablet.

Hearing individual talks to deaf/ hard-of-hearing person while the video interpreter (VI) signs what is being said. Communication continues to be relayed back and forth among video interpreter, deaf/hard-of-hearing and hearing persons for a seamless conversation.

Video Remote Interpretation (VRI)

- Access to VRI has been implemented as part of the City's compliance with all applicable provisions of Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA).

 - The ADA Effective Communications Policy (9/1/17) is on PowerDMS and can be referred to for further details.
- VRI is intended to assist deaf/hard-of-hearing persons who interact with City of Oakland employees including both sworn and non-sworn personnel.

Ease of Use

- Available 24/7/365
- Can be used on any desktop with a camera such as the all-in-one computers
- Can be used on Department issued cell phones and tablets after the application is downloaded

Using VRI

- Login Everyone uses the same user name and password
 - User Name: OaklandPDVRI
 - Password: purple74538
- Click on the box to allow the program to access the microphone
- An interpreter should show up on the screen. They will ask for your:
 - First and last name
 - Serial number
- Confirm the interpreter can see and hear you
- You are now ready to begin the session
