Civil, Family, Housing and Small Claims Case Display

Case information is generally shown on this website for a period of one to ten years after the disposition date unless the Court Rules found in Sections 7 -10 and 7-11 of the **Connecticut Practice Book** provide for a shorter period of time.

Cases are removed from the website one month before the end of the period found in the Court Rules. If a motion is filed in a case after its disposition date, the time a case is displayed may be extended for 11 more months.

Cases for relief from physical abuse, foreign protective orders, and motions that would be likely to publicly reveal the identity or location of a protected party may not be shown on the website under the Federal Violence Against Women Act of 2005, but may be available only at the court.

Criminal/Motor Vehicle Case Display

Conviction information is generally shown on this website for no more than 10 years after the date of sentencing unless Section 7-13 of the Connecticut Practice Book provides for a shorter period of time in which case this information will be shown for the shorter period of time. Please note that conviction information will be removed from the website one month before the end of the period you might find in the Connecticut Practice Book. Also:

• Each criminal and motor vehicle charge which resulted in a conviction within the past 10 years is shown, including convictions resulting from unvacated (still valid) forfeitures of bail or collateral deposited to secure a person's appearance in court in *motor vehicle cases*. **Note:** Unvacated (still valid) forfeitures of bail or collateral deposited to secure a person's appearance in court in *non-motor vehicle cases* are *not* shown.

• Youthful Offender cases, Juvenile Cases; and Infractions and violation convictions are not shown.

Criminal history record information shown on this site may change daily due to erasures, corrections, pardons, and other modifications to individual criminal history record information. The Judicial Branch cannot guarantee the accuracy of the information except with respect to this date.
