- (a) In 2020, the general assembly enacted Senate Bill 20-048, which bill required the executive director of the department of natural resources to convene a work group to explore ways to strengthen current water anti-speculation law;
- (b) On August 13, 2021, the work group published a report that provides a discussion of the background, risks, and related concepts regarding water speculation;
- (c) The report indicates that water speculation includes the practice of investment water speculation and defines investment water speculation as "the appropriation or purchase of water rights followed by the use of those water rights, where the appropriator['s] or purchaser's primary purpose is profiting from increased value of the water in the subsequent transaction such as sale, lease, or payment for nondiversion";
- (d) The report further describes investment water speculation as "violat[ing] the intent of Colorado's anti-speculation doctrine because the investor's primary goal is profit from the water value rather than beneficial use of the water (and the profit that comes from the use)"; and
- (e) The report notes that because investment water speculation "requires a determination of intent, it is inherently difficult to identify."
- (2) Therefore, the general assembly declares that the issue of investment water speculation should be studied during the 2022 interim.
- **SECTION 2.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 37-98-103, **add** (9) as follows:
- **37-98-103.** Annual recommendations bill limitation deadlines for introduction repeal. (9) (a) The committee shall study the issue of investment water speculation during the 2022 interim and, in conducting the study, may consult with experts and interested stakeholders.
- (b) THE STUDY MAY INCLUDE AN EXAMINATION OF THE SCOPE OF INVESTMENT WATER SPECULATION, ANY NEGATIVE IMPACTS THAT INVESTMENT WATER SPECULATION HAS ON VARIOUS TYPES OF WATER RIGHTS IN THE STATE, AND RECOMMENDATIONS ON HOW BEST TO ADDRESS ANY SUCH NEGATIVE IMPACTS.
