On May 30, 2012, DMB Redwood City Saltworks (Saltworks) submitted a request for a formal, legally binding, and final jurisdictional determination (JD) under the Rivers and Harbors Act (RHA) and the Clean Water Act (CWA) for the 1,365-acre Redwood City Salt Plant (Salt Plant) in San Mateo County, California. According to a March 19, 2015, memorandum from Major General John W. Peabody, transmitting the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) RHA Section 10 approved JD for Redwood City Saltworks to Mr. David Smith, Corps Headquarters also prepared a CWA JD for the Redwood City Saltworks. On or about March 18, 2015, after being informed that Major General John Peabody intended to sign and issue the Corps' CWA JD, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) intervened, asserting special case authority to issue its own CWA JD for the site.

This is a request pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552, and EPA's FOIA regulations, 40 C.F.R. Part 2, for the Corps' "final" CWA JD (with attachments) and/or "final" combined RHA and CWA JD (with attachments) for Redwood City Saltworks.¹ By "final," we mean the version of this document² that was prepared for signature by Major General Peabody (whether or not the document was ever actually signed), and sent to EPA. This FOIA request for this specific document is not intended to narrow or change the scope of prior FOIA requests we have submitted. This specific request stands on its own without any implication for previous FOIA requests.
