











# 2022 West Virginia Republican Primary Election 2nd Congressional District






The West Virginia Poll is a non-partisan survey of public opinion conducted continuously since January 21, 1980 and reported by media outlets. For more than 40 years, The West Virginia Poll has been the source of public opinion about current issues, political races and pop culture.

#### Methodology



- April 27, 2022 May 4, 2022
- n=350 completed web/ phone interviews
- Respondents screened and qualified as registered voters in the 2nd Congressional District who are likely to participate in the May 10th, 2022 Republican Primary
- 27 counties in West Virginia 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional District are included in the sampling frame
- Confidence interval +/- 5.2 percentage points at a 95% confidence level




West Virginia 2nd Congressional District
