Below is a timeline for WFO's response to the information provided from the DNC.

- 10/24: WFO CY3 gets the information from a contact at DNC. CY3 reaches out to several WFO entities regarding the information
- 10/25: WFO CI-1 takes the lead
- 10/25: WFO CI-1 speaks to contact at DNC, Mr. Sussmann, and gets the hard copy report prepared by private security firm.
- 10/26: WFO provides OTD (CTOG) and [REDACTED] copies of the report for review and assessment
- 10/27: SA Walters meets face to face with Mr. Sussmann. Mr. Sussmann agreed to allowing the FBI to conduct a sweep of the DNC offices but on the condition the sweep was done in a covert manner as to not alert the DNC employees.
- 10/27-29: SA Walters consults with [REDACTED] regarding report; [REDACTED] assesses no threat based on the data. [REDACTED] believes signal in question is USG first responder communication system. SA Walters conducts internal FBI checks of information provided by DNC.
- 11/2: WFO IS-1 is notified of the inquiry and a discussion of the fact that we are waiting on OTD's assessment.
- 11/9: OTD concurs with prior assessments; Assesses the signal is coming from a source external to the DNC; and is consistent with a USG COOP radio system. Assess no FIS threat. SA Walters speaks with DNC rep regarding findings.
- 11/15: Request submitted for analysis by WFO IS-1 to confirm above conclusions.
- 11/17: IS1 is seeking approvals to conduct the sweep. Sweep is expected to be completed in the next 1-2 business days. We will provide more info on a specific time when we have it.
