[Proposed] ORDER RE: DISCLOSURE SCHEDULE

19 This is an action under the Freedom of Information Act (“FOIA”) brought by Plaintiff,
20 the Center for Biological Diversity (the “Center”) to compel Defendant, the Bureau of Land
21 Management (“BLM”) to release records requested under FOIA.

22 The Center submitted the FOIA request at issue to BLM on March 3, 2021. On September
23 8, 2021, having not received a response from BLM, the Center filed the instant case. *See*
24 *Complaint*, ECF No. 1.

25 On April 11, 2022 this Court held a status hearing at which it requested that the Parties
26 meet and confer to agree upon a schedule for disclosure of all responsive, non-exempt documents.

1 See ECF No. 24. The Court also Ordered BLM to produce 4,800 documents no later than May
2 11, 2002. *Id.*

3 During the hearing, counsel for BLM stated that processing and releasing the volume of
4 documents requested by the Center would be unduly burdensome to BLM, and asked if the Center
5 would be willing to discuss narrowing the scope of the FOIA request. Counsel for the Center
6 responded that the Center would be open to discussing and clarifying the intended scope of the
7 request.

8 BLM released 4,800 documents to the Center pursuant to the Court's Order on May 6,
9 2022.

10 Between April 11, 2022 and May 11, 2022, the Parties met and conferred pursuant to the
11 Court's Order. The Parties agreed that BLM will release 1,000 or more responsive pages every
12 30 business days. However, the Parties have been unable, as of the date of this Order, to reach an
13 agreement concerning the scope of the request. Discussions regarding the scope of the request are
14 continuing.

15 Therefore, it is now ORDERED that Defendant BLM will release to Plaintiff the Center
16 for Biological Diversity 1,000 or more responsive pages every 30 business days until BLM has
17 satisfied all of its obligations under FOIA to provide the requester with responsive, non-exempt
18 records. Should the Parties reach further agreement as to the scope of the FOIA request or the
19 date on which BLM's disclosures will be complete, they shall file a joint status report and
20 proposed order with the Court.


