

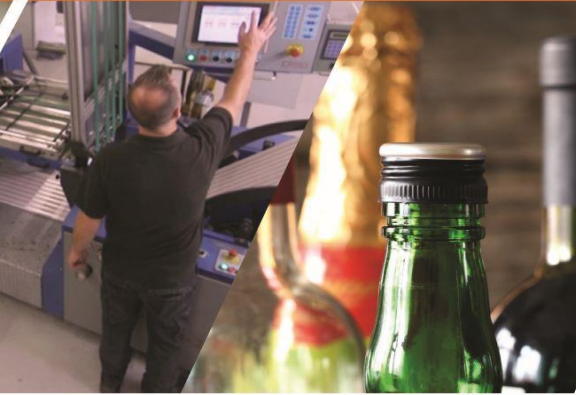

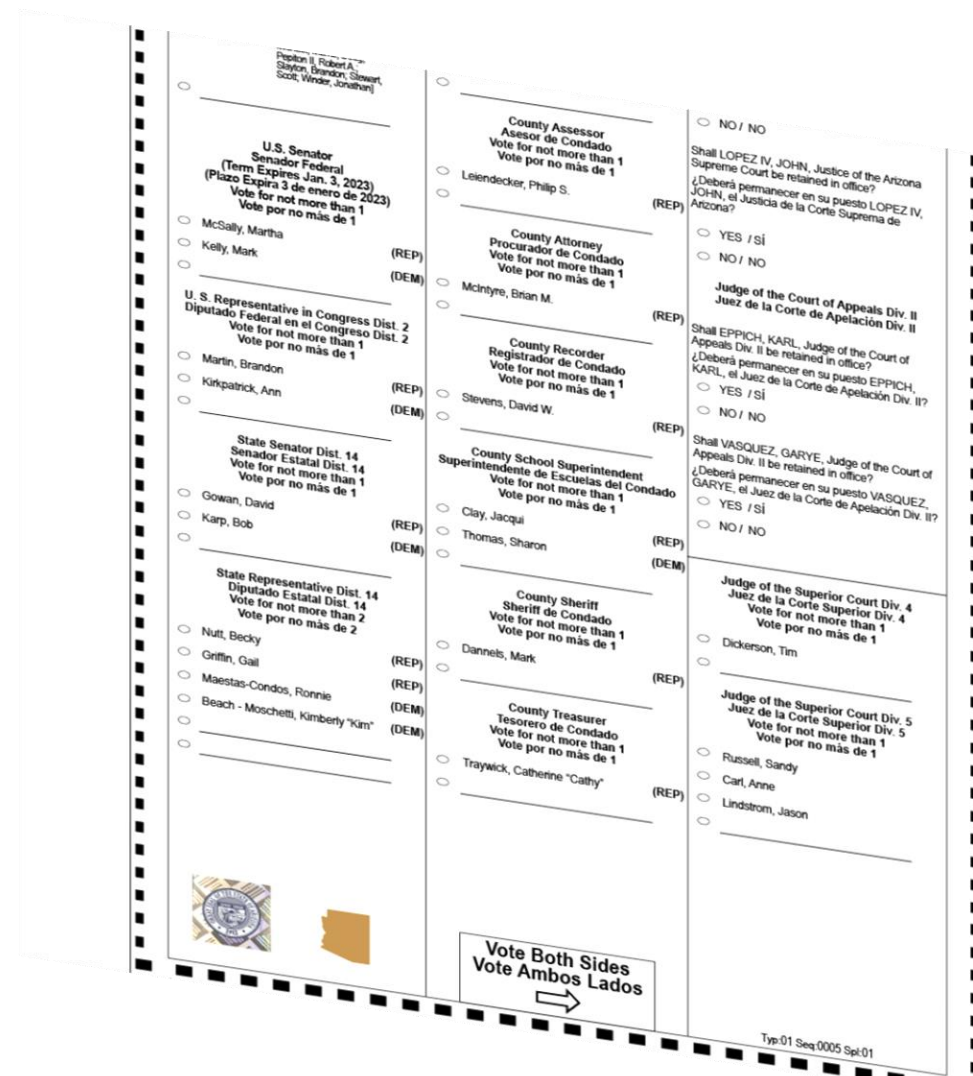

- Confirm that only state authorized ballots are sent to voters, used in voting locations, counted, and stored
- Eliminate the chance for unauthorized ballot forms to enter anywhere in voting ecosystem, including those to be machine read
- Aggregated chain of custody tracking from:
 - Authentix > State Storage > Digital Printers > Precincts
 - Authentix > State Storage > Mail-Out > Precincts
- Serialized ballots could enable each voter to keep a ‘receipt’ of unique ballot submission but also be anonymous
- Securitized ballot paper supplied directly to third-party digital printing vendor for controlled distribution and tracking

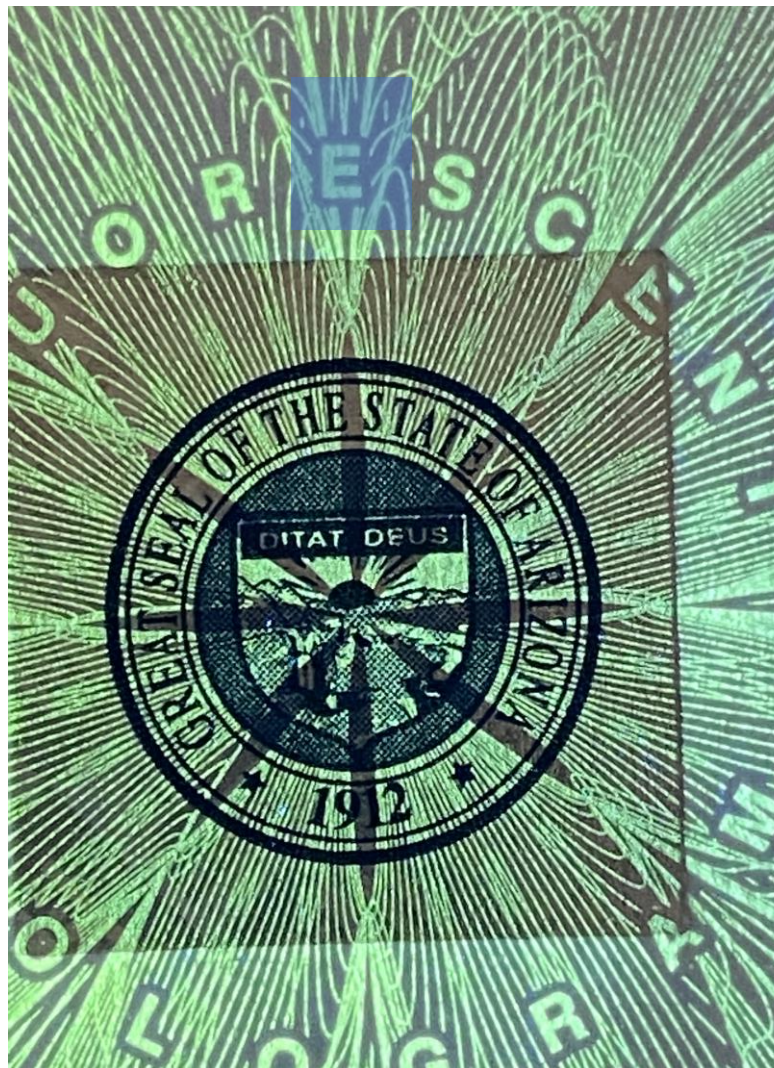

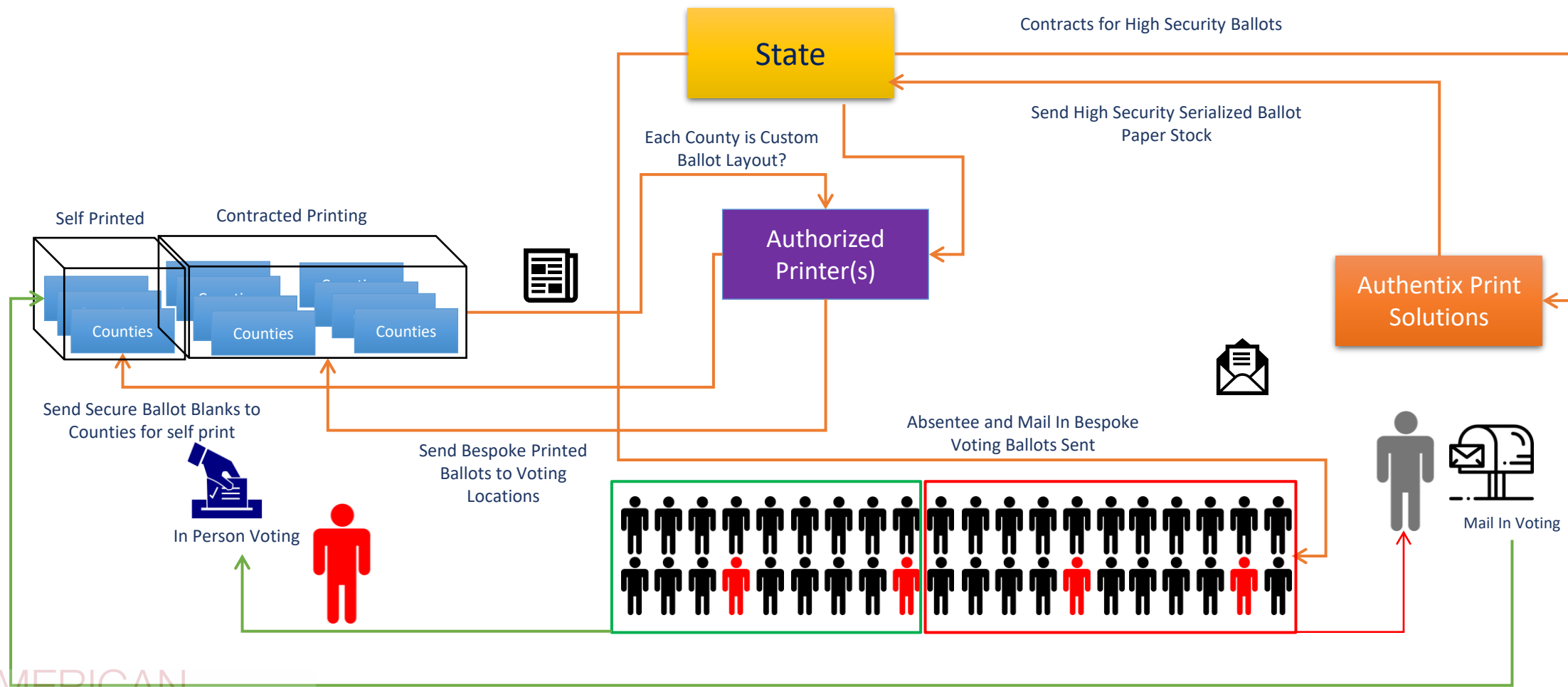
Ballot Validation

Secure QR Code on Ballot with Unique Serial Number

- Voter can scan variable QR code and anonymously retain ballot serial number (state has no record of individual's personal information after scan)
- After Election is closed/tabulated/certified, voter can confirm ballot was received and counted by making inquiry using previous registration info. – possibly see image of ballot if imaging system can be implemented on intake points.
