From: Assembly Chair LaFrance 1 2 3 Subject: AN ORDINANCE OF THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY AMENDING ANCHORAGE MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 2.30.010 TO CODIFY THE 4 5 ASSEMBLY'S PROCESS FOR SELECTION REPRESENTATIVE AND ALTERNATE TO THE ANCHORAGE ASSEMBLY AND 6 7 TO AMEND SECTION 4.60.275 TO CONFORM TO THE ASSEMBLY'S PROCESS. 8 9 Anchorage Municipal Code was amended in 2017 to establish a Youth Advisory 10 Commission and a youth representative and alternate to the Anchorage Assembly. 11 The youth representative and alternate positions were established in Title 4. Boards 12 and Commissions although the positions are part of the Assembly. This ordinance 13 will move the qualifications and duties of the youth representative and alternate to 14 the assembly in Title 2, Legislative Branch, similar to other positions that work 15 directly with the assembly. As the legislative branch is home to the youth 16 representative and the alternate, this ordinance brings these positions into the 17 legislative branch's governing code. 18 19 Additionally, this ordinance will widen the pool of potential participants for the 20 position, allow the assembly to set the term based on schedule and workload, and 21 reduce the time a youth representative may be absent from the state before the 22 position becomes vacant automatically, unless the absence is approved by the 23 assembly chair for extraordinary circumstances. 24 25 Title 4 is amended in this ordinance to reflect modifications made in the language 26 added to Title 2, to avoid redundancy in the code. 27 28 I request your support for the ordinance. 29 30
