Dear Requester Chua,

This is the final response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Headquarters Privacy (HQ PRIV) and received in the Office of Intelligence and Analysis (I&A), on October 4, 2020. You are seeking records about:

I&A's support of other law enforcement efforts related to Protests occurring in New York City between May 25, 2020, and the date of this request.

While an adequate search was conducted by the Office of I&A, no records responsive to your request were found. You have the right to appeal this determination that no records exist within I&A that would be responsive to your request.¹ Should you wish to do so, you must send your appeal and a copy of this letter, within 90 days of the date of this letter, to: Privacy Office, Attn: FOIA Appeals, U.S. Department of Homeland Security, 245 Murray Lane, SW, Mail Stop 0655, Washington, D.C. 20528-0655, following the procedures outlined in the DHS FOIA regulations at 6 C.F.R. Part 5 § 5.8. Your envelope and letter should be marked "FOIA Appeal." Copies of the FOIA and DHS FOIA regulations are available at www.dhs.gov/foia.
