Re: The Air District's Failure to Curtail Green Sage's Egregious Violations of Federal Law and District Regulations

We the undersigned would like to express our concern about the Board's hearing process for the Green Sage matter. The process has been incredibly slow and completely ineffective. We feel like we have been misled. We understood, if we prevailed, that the Board would issue an "immediate abatement order" and the District would shut down the generators. Instead, the Board allowed Green Sage to continue to operate for over a week while the District and Green Sage "finalized" the abatement order. "Abatement" shouldn't imply a continuance as negotiations about the order's language are conducted. While the District's counsel "finalized" the abatement order's language with Green Sage—which has no intention of ever complying with the order—we were literally being poisoned. We placed faith in this system and were extremely patient. We've spent hundreds of hours on the Board's abatement process because Green Sage's conduct is so obviously at odds with the District's regulations. After all that investment of our time, it seems that we were misled into believing that the District would actually shut the generators down. Instead, Green Sage has been afforded every opportunity to appeal, delay, and ignore the law without consequence. That isn't fair. The District's decision to take over a year to get an abatement order, and subsequent failure to immediately enforce the order, allows Green Sage's violations to continue indefinitely. The District's handling of this case sets a horrible precedent for how others in this industry can skirt the law without consequence.

We understand there are procedures that must be followed. We have followed the District's procedures exactly as instructed. Green Sage has not. We are baffled by how the Board's process is heavily slanted in favor of companies, like Green Sage, that make calculated business decisions to intentionally violate the law. After ten months of engaging in the Board's enforcement process, there has been no measurable progress. All we have is a non-final abatement order, which District appears in no hurry to enforce. There has been no change in our situation. Trucks are delivering diesel to keep those generators running as we write. We were told that an abatement order would remedy our situation, but it has not.

We respectfully demand that the Board instruct District counsel to immediately enforce the abatement order and levy substantial civil penalties against Green Sage. Green Sage has no intention of following the law. The District must not continue to risk our lives by delaying meaningful enforcement action against Green Sage.
