It is the document that most clearly lays out our objections to the conduct of the Regency that resulted in the citations being issued.

As for the meeting, can you please tell me who you would expect to be there from DHS and/or the Division of Quality Assurance?

It would be my expectation that I would attend alone. but I would like Diane to

participate remotely via FaceTime. Would that be okay?
