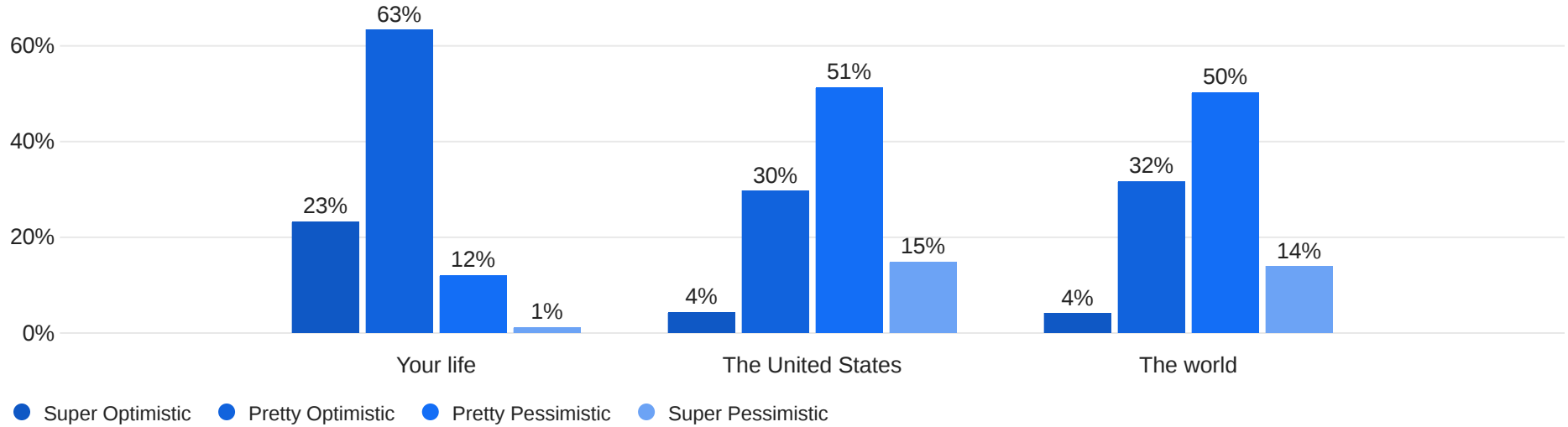

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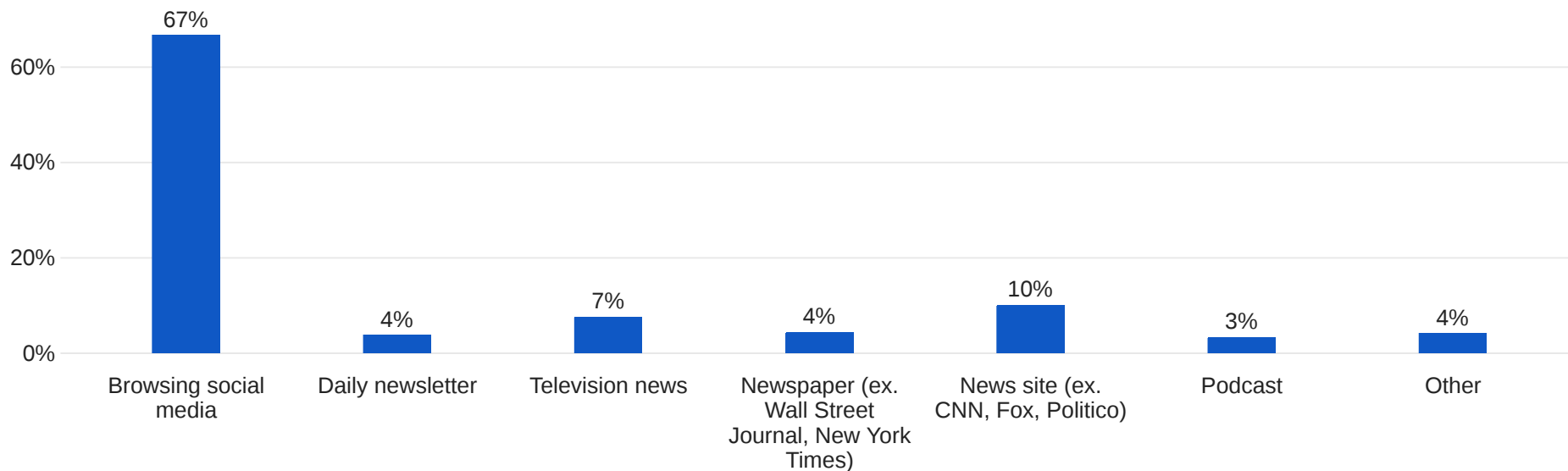

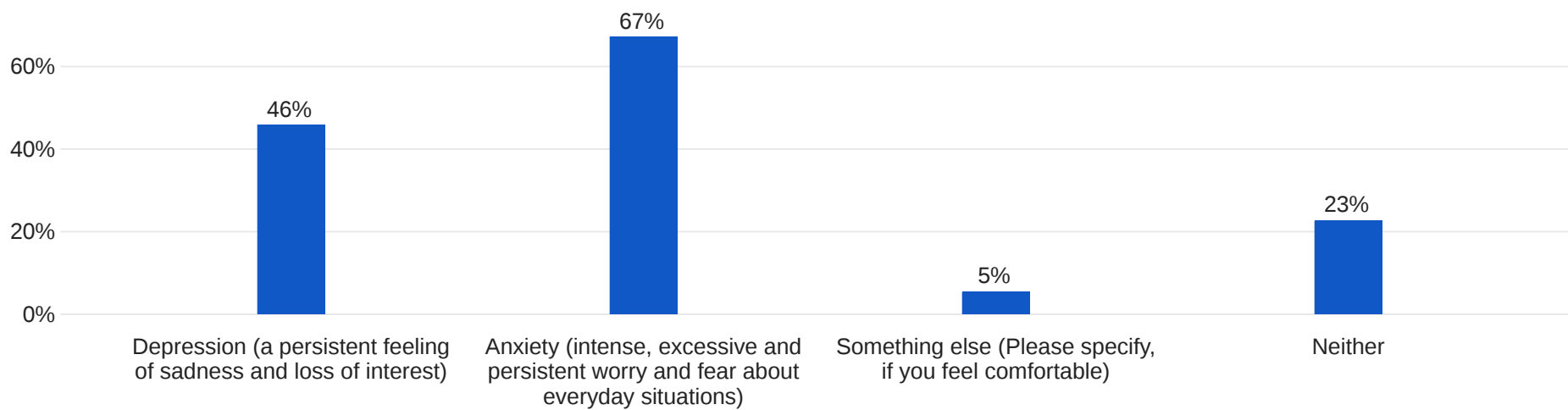

## 2.2 - How do you get the majority of your news?



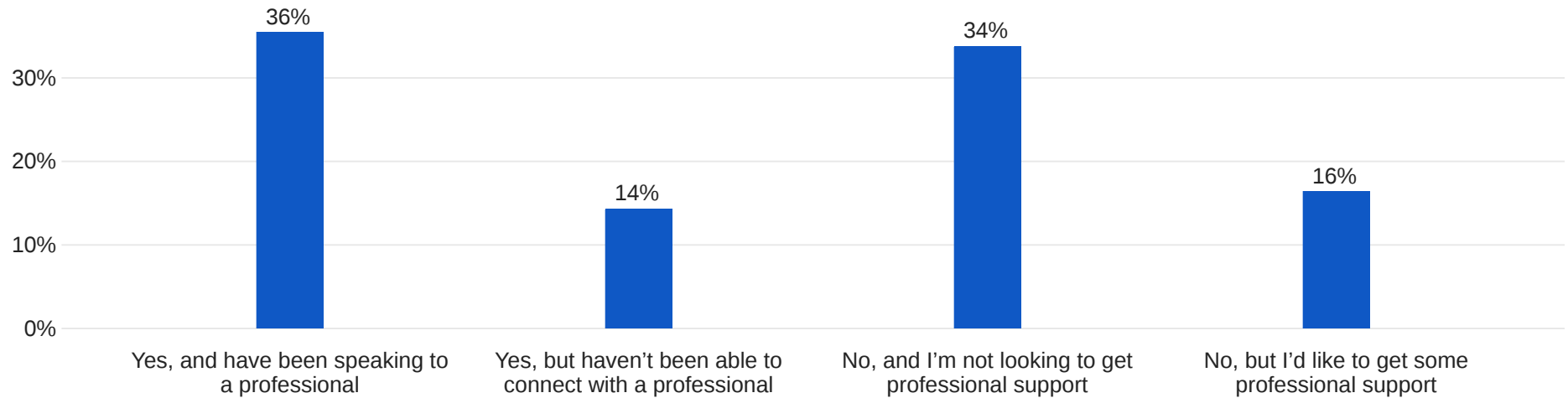
## 2.3 - Which of the following have you experienced in the last year? (Select all that apply)



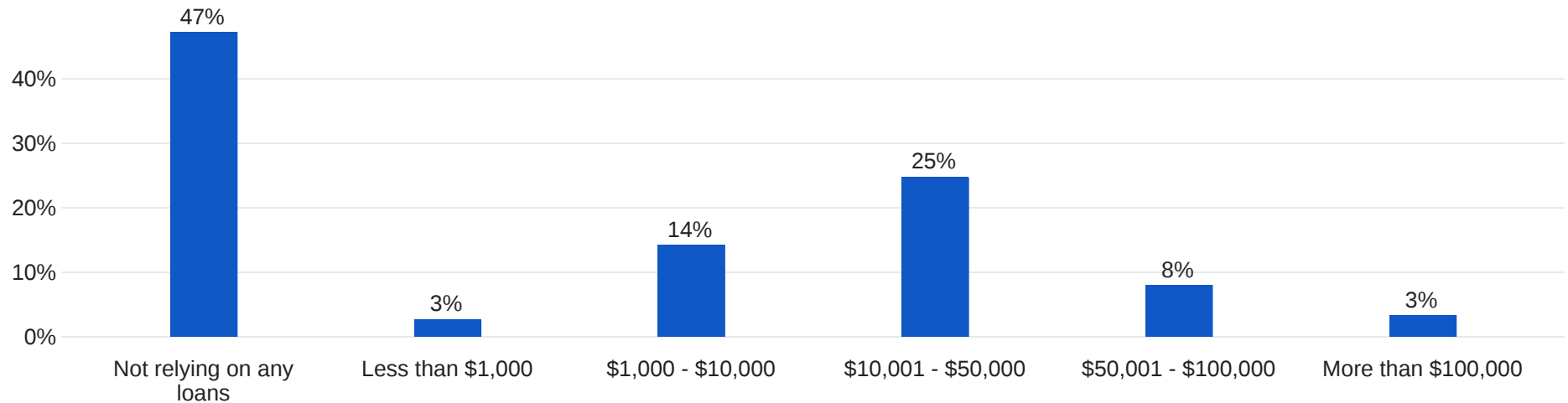


## 2.4 - [Among those who have experienced any mental health condition] Have you sought help?

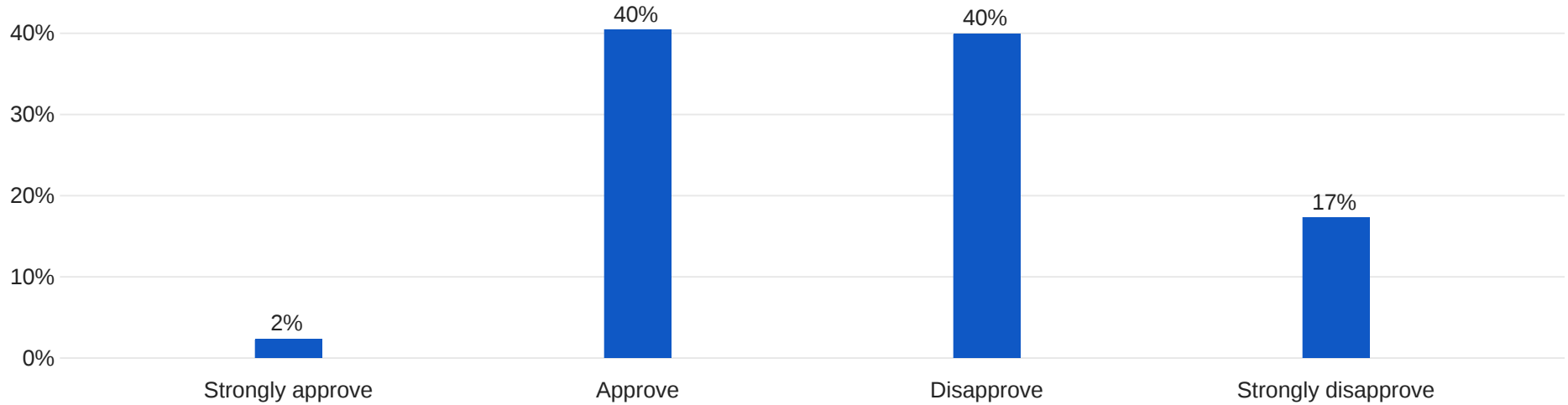


## 2.6 - If relying on loans in part or in full to pay for you education, how much do you expect to owe at graduation?

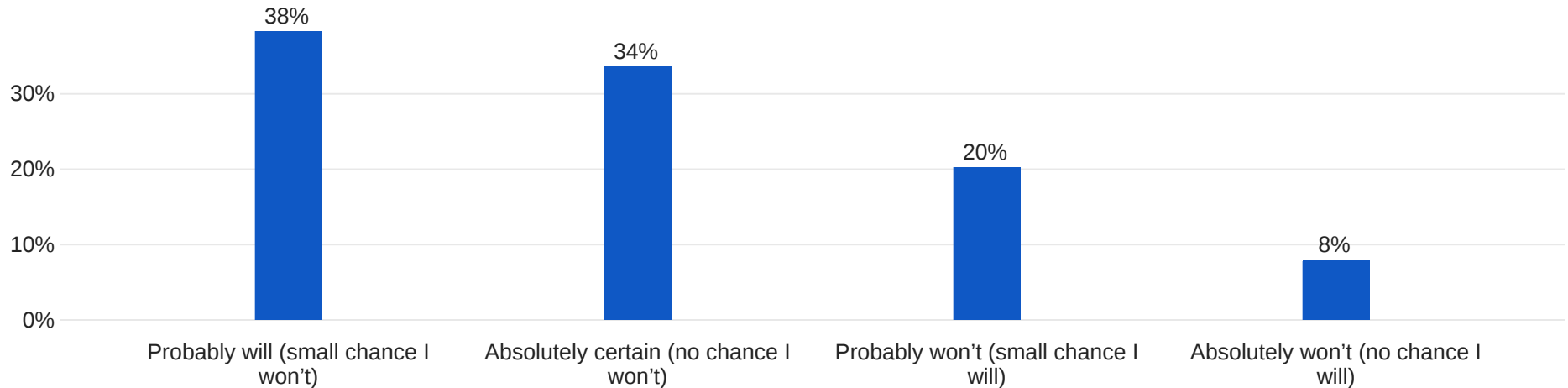




## 2.7 - Do you approve or disapprove of the way Joe Biden is handling his job as president?

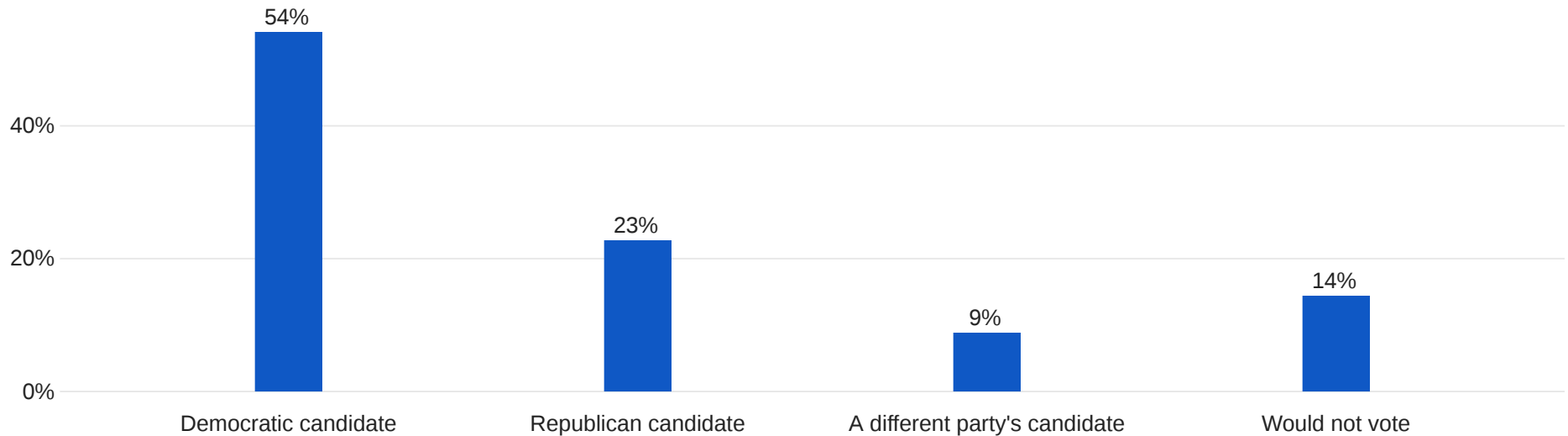

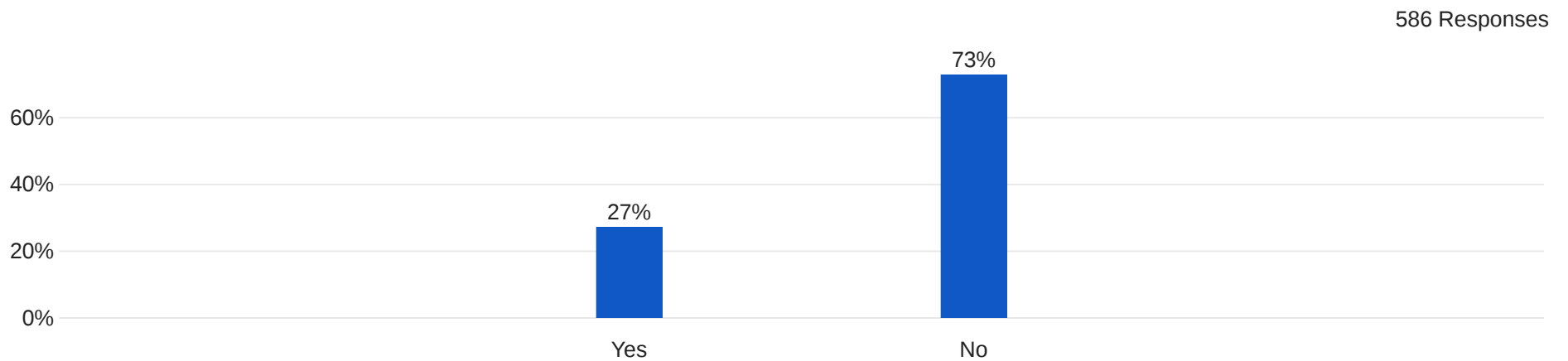

2.9 - If the election for U.S. Congress in your district was held today, which candidate are you most likely to vote for?

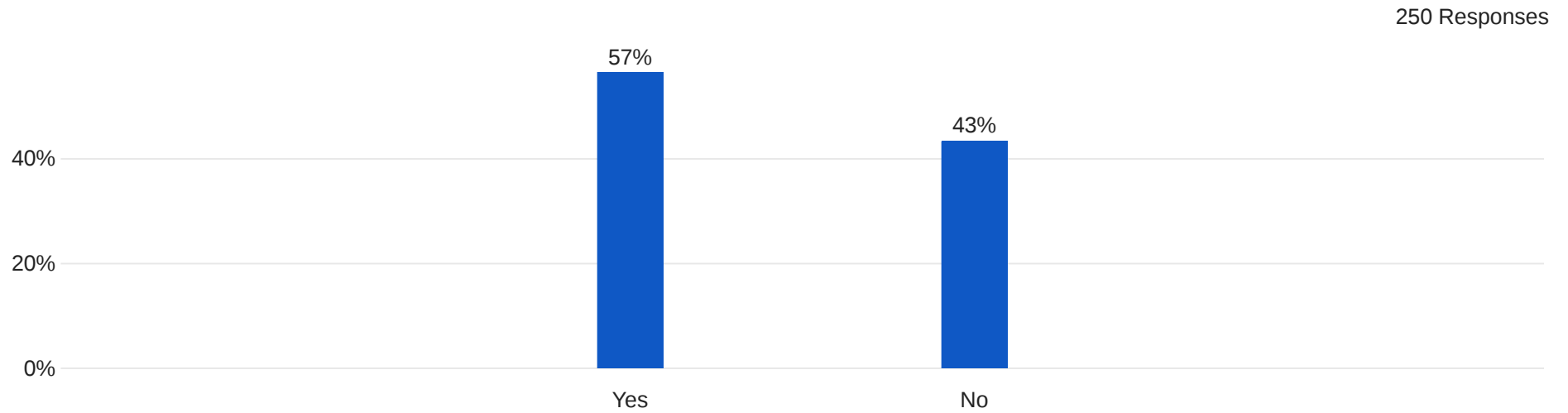


2.10 - [Among Democratic voters] Do you believe Joe Biden should run for president in the 2024 election?



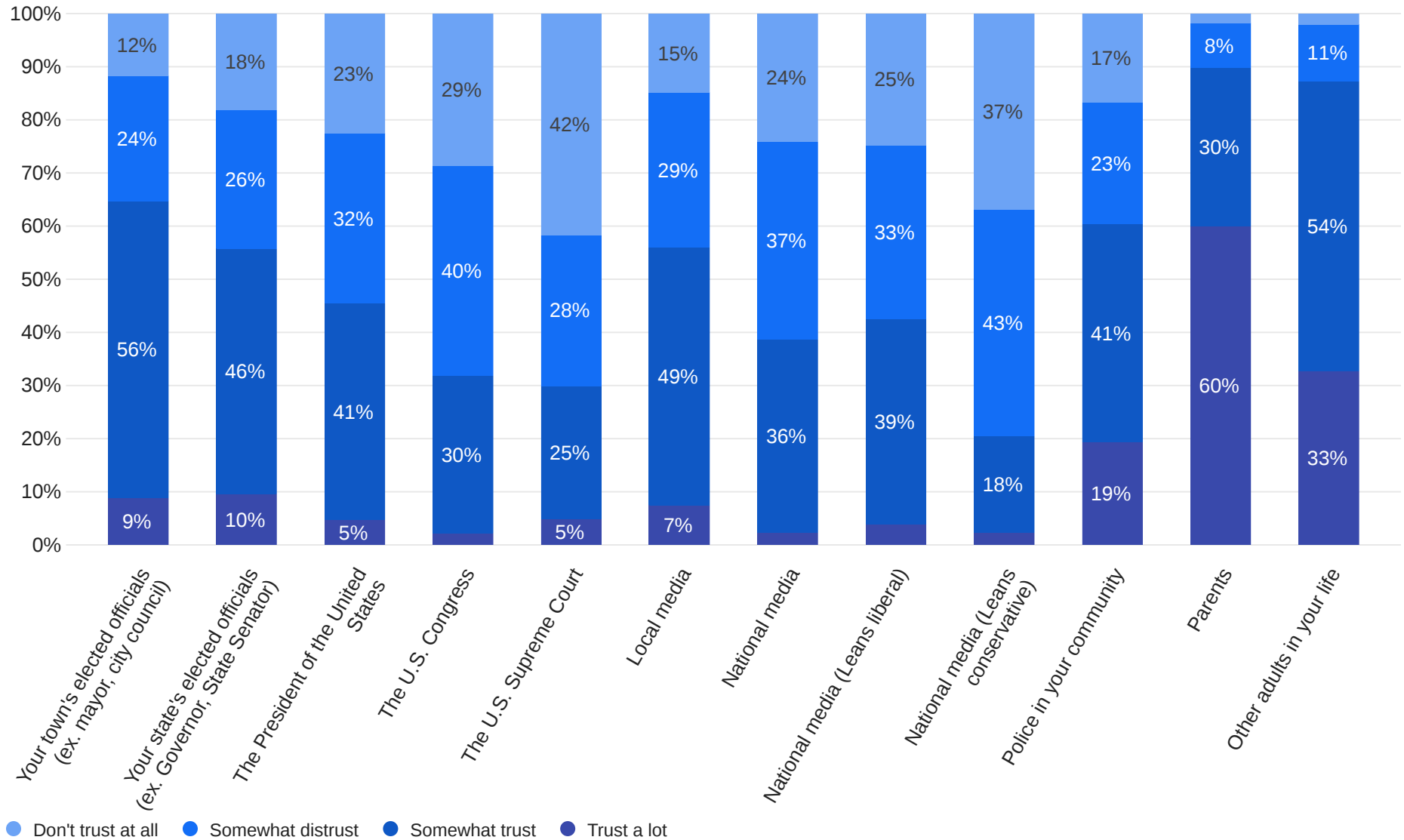


## 2.11 - [Among Republican voters] Do you believe Donald Trump should run for president in the 2024 election?



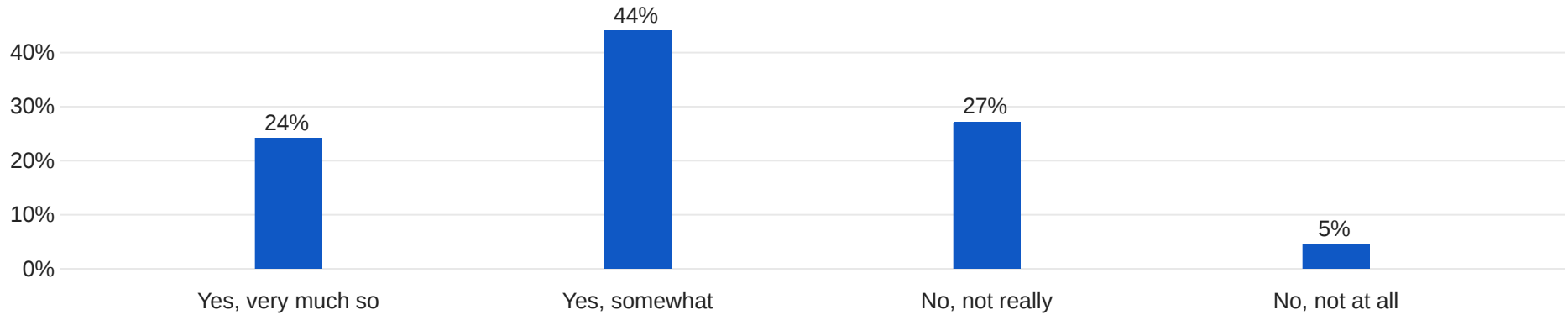


## 2.12 - To what extent do you trust the following people or institutions in your li...





### 2.13 - Do you think the outcome of this year's midterm elections will have a direct impact on your life or your family's life?

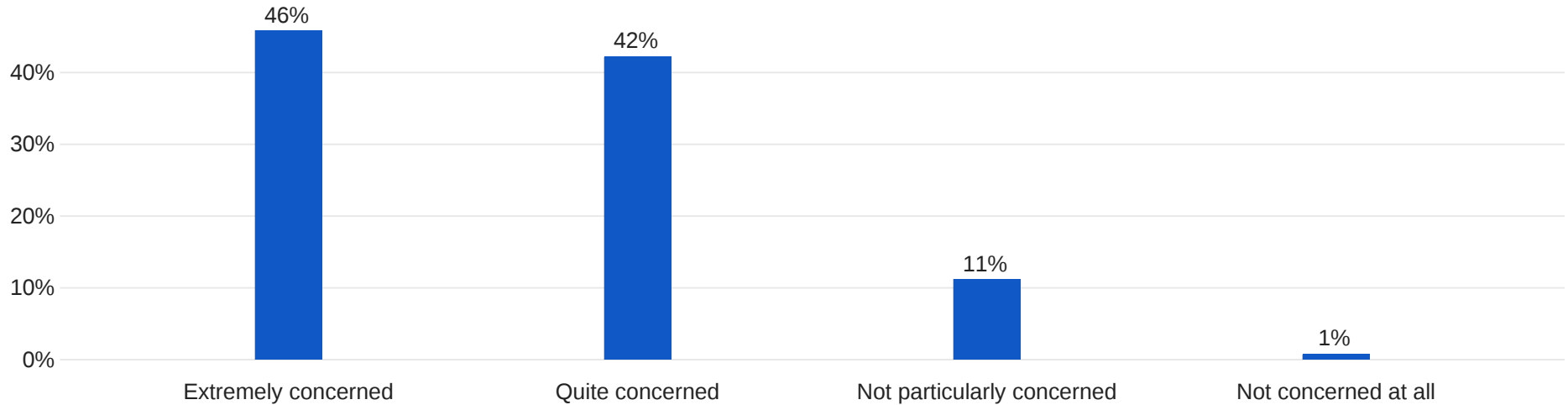

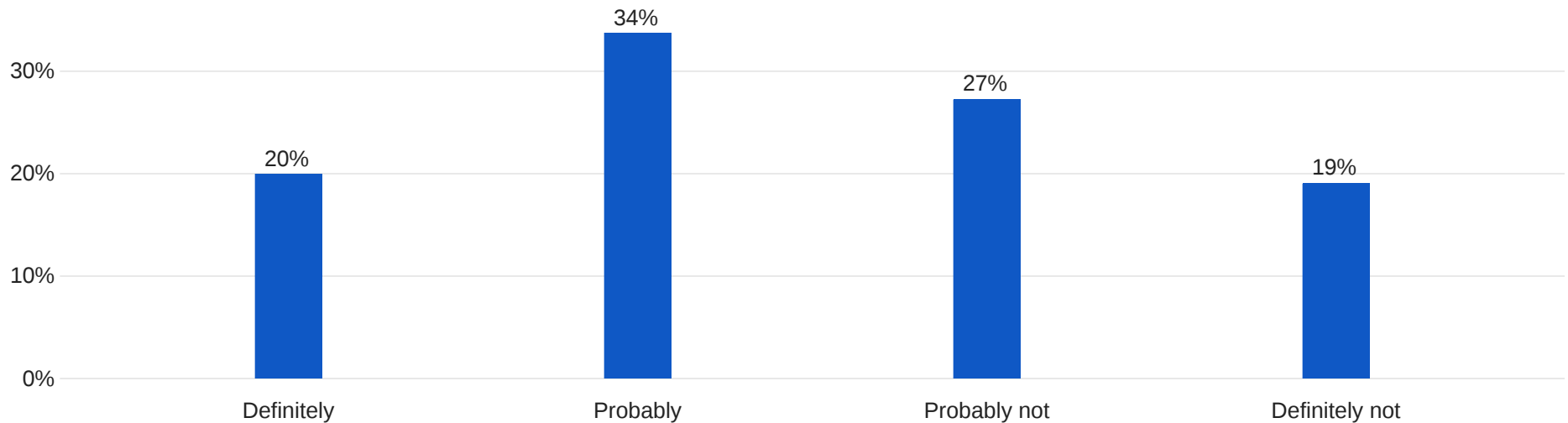




### 2.15 - How concerned are you personally about the price of gasoline, rent and food?

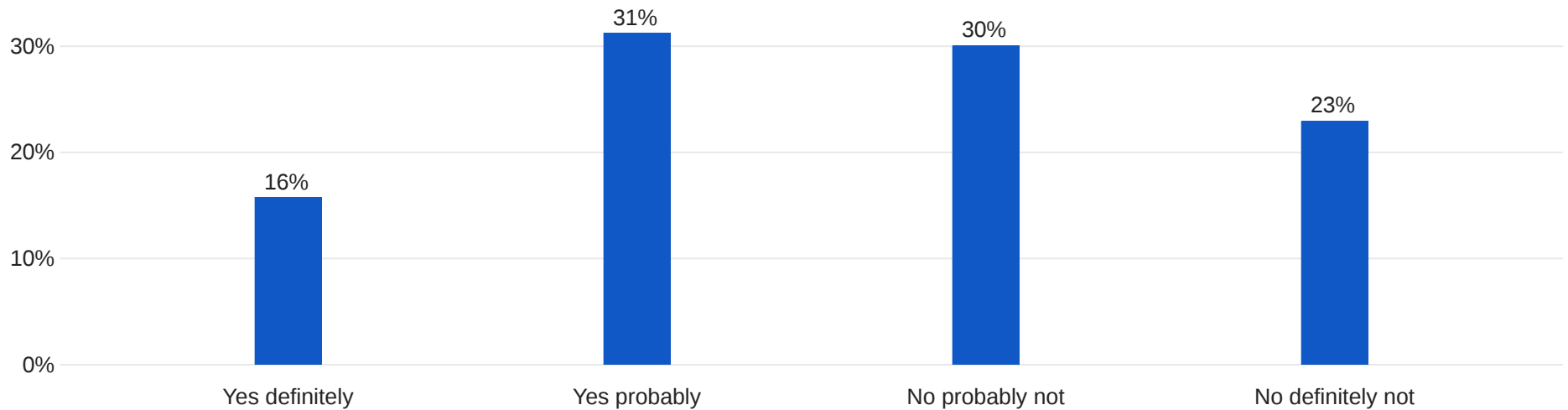

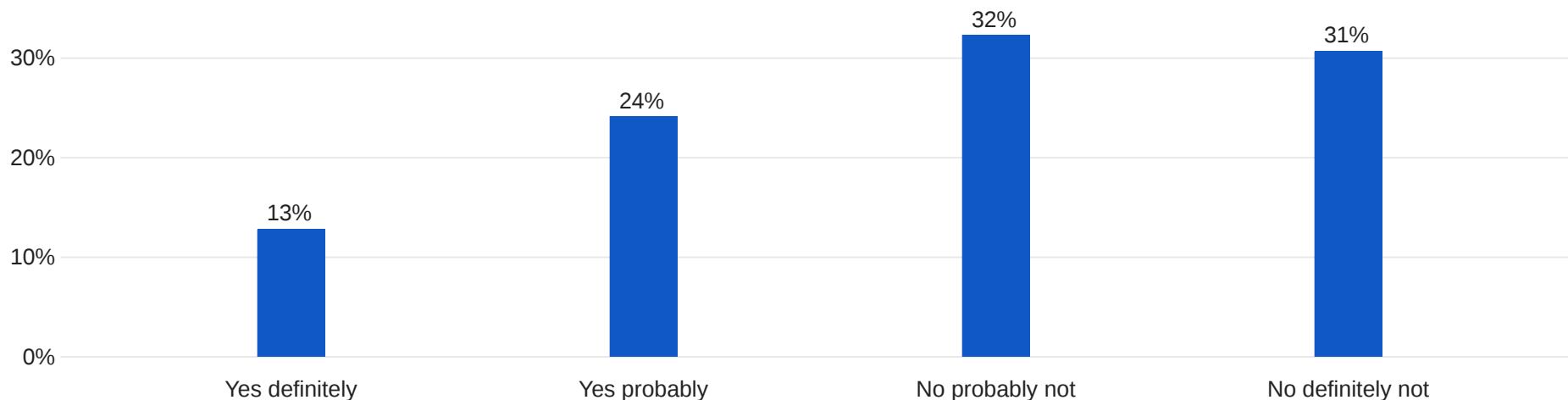

### 2.17 - Would you go on a date with someone if you knew they supported for the opposing presidential candidate as the one you supported in 2020?

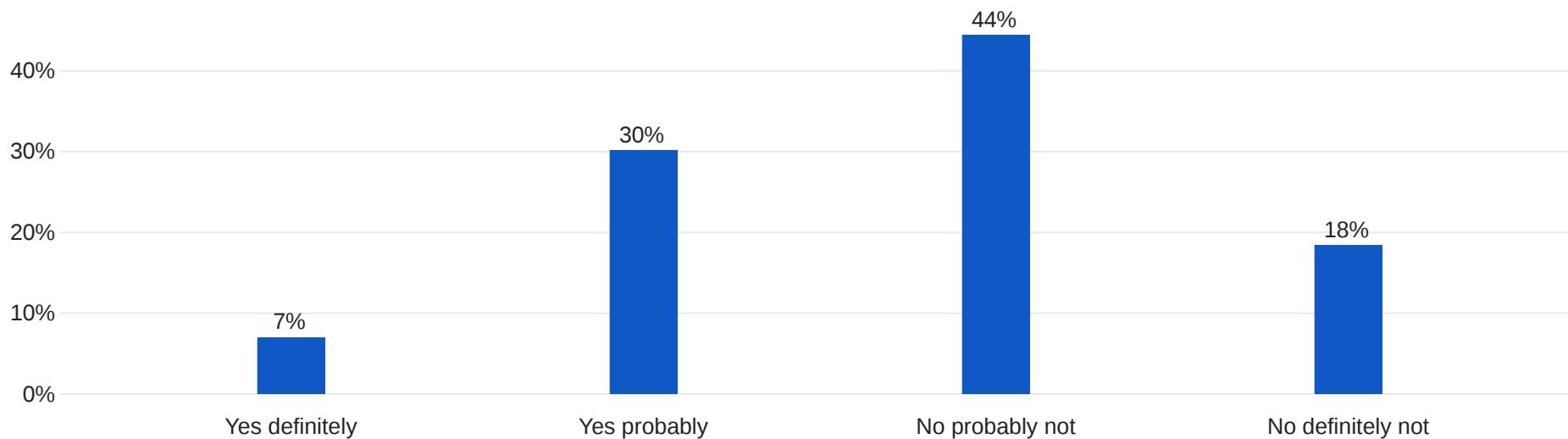




### 2.18 - Could you see yourself getting married to someone who supported the opposite presidential candidate as the one you supported?

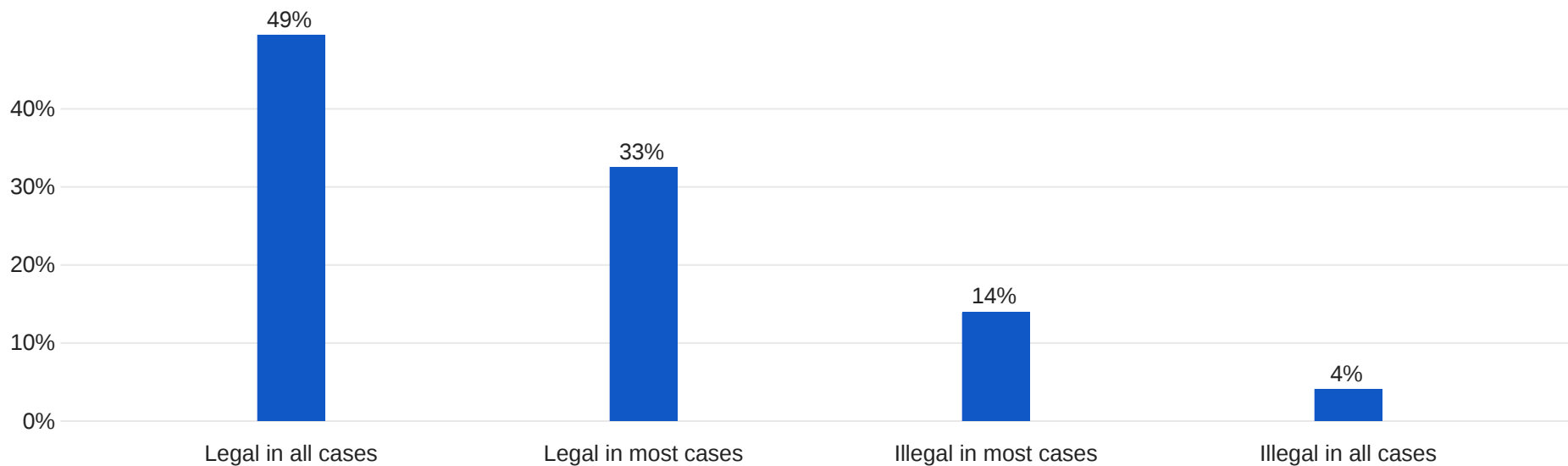
