Congratulations to Mary Peltola on winning the special election to fill the final few months of the late Congressman Don Young's term in Congress.

While, the majority of Alaskan voters do not agree with her on most issues, particularly those policies she shares with President Biden and Speaker of the House Nancy Pelosi, I hope she will remember that Alaska's working families rely on resource jobs, that our lands must be opened for development, and that our nation desperately needs Alaskan energy, minerals, timber, and fish in order to prosper.

Peltola's Alaska endorsements came from the most liberal Alaskan political activists, which indicates where her votes in Congress are likely to align. Mary has stated that she will carry the torch of Congressman Young, a man staunchly opposed to the social and economic priorities of the left. The next few months will show whether or not that torch is used to help Biden and Pelosi continue to burn Alaska's economy to the ground.

The biggest lesson as we move into the 2022 General Election, is that ranked choice voting showed that a vote for Sarah Palin is in reality a vote for Mary Peltola. Palin simply doesn't have enough support from Alaskans to win an election.

As I have introduced myself to Alaskans, I have steadily increased my percentage of the vote since the June 11 Special Primary election. I will continue traveling the state, making the case that this election is about a choice between Mary Peltola and Nick Begich; a choice between more government control or less; a choice between less resource development or more; a choice between "get-woke-go-broke" ideology or prosperity for those ready to work for it.

This result is consistent with what pollsters have been telling us for months; Sarah Palin cannot win a statewide race because her unfavorable rating is so high. These same polls have consistently shown that Alaskans are looking for a less polarizing alternative to Mary Peltola. As we look forward to the November election, I will work hard to earn the vote of Alaskans all across the state.
