#### **Civilian Complaints (Not Internal):**

160 civilian complaints were received in 2021. Of those 160 civilian complaints, 11 were sustained. (These are for all agency members, certified and civilians)

#### **Bias-Policing:**

Three complaints received alleging bias-policing, as well as one that remained open from 2020. All four were cleared with no findings of bias-policing.

#### **Excessive or Unnecessary Use of Force:**

Seven complaints of excessive or unnecessary use of force; no sustained violations- one complaint is pending at the time of this request.

Two total; with one sustained. \*\*Please note- this number is included in the above total number of civilian complaints.

#### **Officer Involved Shooting:**

Total of three Officer Involved Shootings, involving five agency members. Two resulted in a fatality as a result of the agency member discharging their agency issued weapon; the third was a fatality as a result of suicide.
