

Fee Category

We have classified you as a representative of the news media. As such, we may charge you for some of our duplication costs, but we will not charge you for our search or review costs; you also are entitled to up to 100 pages of photocopies (or an equivalent volume) for free. See 43 C.F.R. § 2.39. If, after taking into consideration your fee category entitlements, our processing costs are less than \$50.00, we will not bill you because the cost of collection would be greater than the fee collected. See 43 C.F.R. § 2.37(g)

Agreement to Pay

You have agreed to pay up to \$200.00 for the processing of your request. If we find that this will not cover the cost of processing your request, we will stop processing your request at the point this amount has been reached and will let you know before we incur additional charges. Fee Waiver

You have requested a fee waiver for this request. As a "news media" requester, we believe that your fee category entitlements will result in a fee less than \$50. We do not bill requesters for FOIA processing fees when their fees are less than \$50.00, because the cost of collection would be greater than the fee collected. See <u>43 C.F.R. § 2.37(g)</u>. Within each track, requests are usually processed on a first-in, first-out basis.

Format of Records

You have asked for copies of agency records. According to our regulations, you may choose the format of disclosure for such records. 10-Workday Extension

Because we will need to search for and collect requested records from field facilities or other units that are separate from the office processing the request, we are taking a 10-workday extension under 43 C.F.R. § 2.19.

This response is limited to those records that are subject to the requirements of FOIA. This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated March 8, 2022, which was received by our office on the same date. You requested the following information under the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552: All documents, investigative notes, reports, emails, email attachments, and other materials related to Complaint 21-337, Complaint 21-338, and Complaint 21-339 and as well as any investigations, probes or other actions taken in response to these complaints.

Your request has been assigned FOIA Control Number OIG-2022-00144. Please refer to this number in any future communications with our office regarding your request.

Under 43 C.F.R. § 2.15, the OIG is required to categorize each FOIA request based on the amount of time needed to process it. The five categories are: 1) Simple (1 -5 workdays); 2) Normal (6-20 workdays); 3) Complex (21-60 workdays); 4) Extraordinary (60+ workdays); and 5) Expedited (requests that have been granted expedited processing). Within each track, requests are processed on a first-in, first-out basis. Your request has been placed in the complex track. Please note that the OIG has a backlog of requests. Please be assured, however, that your request is being handled as equitably as possible and that all documents that can be released will be made available at the earliest date possible.

The FOIA provides for three levels of fees which may be assessed in response to FOIA requests according to categories of FOIA requesters. If records are requested for commercial use, requestors may be charged for document search, duplication and review. 5 U.S.C. 552(a)(4)(A)(ii)(I). If the request is made by an educational or noncommercial scientific institution, whose purpose is scholarly or scientific research, or a representative of the news media, the requester is charged only duplication fees, with the first 100 page provided free. 5 U.S.C. 552(a)(4)(A)(ii)(II). All other requesters are charged reasonable charges for search and duplication with two hours of search time and 100 pages of duplication provided free. See 5

U.S.C. § 552 (a)(4)(A)(iv)(I); see also Uniform Freedom of Information Act Fee Schedule and Guidelines, 52 Fed. Reg. 10,012, 10018 (Mar. 27, 1987).

For purposes of this request, you have been categorized as a representative of the news media. Pursuant to DOI regulations, as such you may be charged for some duplication costs but will not be charged for our search or review costs and are entitled to up to 100 pages of photocopies (or an equivalent volume) for free. *See* 43 C.F.R. § 2.39. Please note that documents will be provided electronically. You have not requested paper copies, however, if you require photocopy duplication, the charge will be \$0.15 per page with the first 100 pages free. *See* 43 C.F.R. § 2.39-2.41.

The following chart is an estimate of the fees for processing your request. Calculated as follows:

Search - 1 Hour Professional Employee @ \$12.00 per Quarter Hour = \$48.00 (1st 2 hours free) Duplication - 0 Pages @ \$0.15 per page = \$0 (1st 100 pages free) **Total** = \$48.00

If, after taking into consideration your fee category entitlements, our processing costs are less than \$50.00, we will not bill you because the cost of collection would be greater than the fee collected. See 43 C.F.R. § 2.37(g).

You may modify or narrow the scope of your request to reduce the estimated fees, obtain quicker processing in your currently assigned track or move the request into a faster track (which may have the effect of reducing the cost of processing your request).
